The Cedarville University Yellow Jackets host the Ohio Christian University Trailblazers in non-conference action tonight in the Callan Athletic Center.

Cedarville is 6-17 (4-7 G-MAC) having dropped five of their last six games including an 80-55 league loss at Salem International on Tuesday night.

Ohio Christian, an National Christian College Athletic Association II program, is 20-9 this season and is ranked #1 in the latest NCCAA national poll. The Trailblazers have won 14 consecutive games - they defeated Welch College 117-45 on Feb. 14 and received a forfeit over Morthland College on Feb. 15.

The Yellow Jackets are under the leadership of 6th-year head coach Pat Estepp (124-61, .670). He has guided his alma mater to an average of nearly 24 victories per season and five consecutive national tournament appearances.

Three players are hitting in double-figures for Cedarville led by junior guard Marcus Reineke who is tossing in 18 points per game. He also leads the long-range attack with 65 three-point field goals. Reineke has posted double figures in 12 straight games and has connected on his last 22 attempts from the charity stripe. He is a team-best .848 from the line on 56-of-66 shooting.

Senior center Brian Grant is adding 10.2 points to the CU offense and leads the squad in rebounding (5.8 rpg). Grant is newest and the 51st member of the Yellow Jacket 1,000 Point Club. He ranks eighth all-time at CU with a .581 field goal percentage (465-of-801) and is one of 37 Yellow Jackets to grab 500+ career rebounds.

Junior guard Jason Cuffee is averaging 10 points per game and is second on the team in rebounding at 4.6 boards per contest. Cuffee tops the Jackets with 79 assists.

Freshman J.C. Faubion is contributing 9.5 points and 4.3 rebounds per game. The rookie leads CU with 27 steals and is second from the free-throw line with a .775 effort.

Two other rookies are making significant contributions. Austin Pickett, a 6-1 guard, is second on the squad in assists with 63 while adding 5.8 ppg. Easton Bazzoli, a 6-6 forward, is scoring 6.3 points per game with a fourth-best 3.9 rebounds per contest.

The Trailblazers are led by second-year Head Coach Tony Stockman who has produced a 47-17 (.734) record at OCU. Stockman, Ohio's prep Mr. Basketball in 2000, played two years of collegiate basketball at Clemson before transferring to Ohio State. He led the Buckeyes in scoring as a junior (13.6 ppg) and helped lead OSU to a 20-12 record during his senior year.

Ohio Christian also features three players scoring in double figures this season. Pacing the offensive attack is guard Wesley Russell who is hitting 16.1 points per game. The 6-4 junior also leads OCU in rebounding (8.6), assists (186) and steals (82).

Ernie McCoy, a 5-9 senior guard, is second in scoring at 11 points per contest. The third Trailblazer in double figures is Evin Bartlett at 10.3 points per night. The top deep threat for OCU is Danny Schrock with 60 FG's from long range.

The Yellow Jackets lead the all-time series with Ohio Christian by a 3-0 mark including a 73-56 win against the Trailblazers on Dec. 8, 2012 in Cedarville.

February 18, 2014

We hope you cheer us on from home tonight and come out to support us on Thursday!

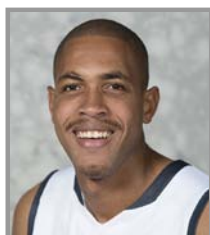

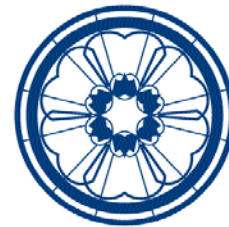

SALEM, W.Va. - It was a forgettable night for the Yellow Jackets, especially the second half, as they fell, 80-55, at Salem International in Great Midwest Athletic Conference action on Tuesday night.

Cedarville trailed 37-35 at halftime, but then the offense never returned from the locker room. The Jackets made just 3-of-20 shots from the field in the final 20 minutes, including an 0-for-7 effort from three point land, and was outscored 43-20.

The two teams sputtered from the opening tap and combined to score just 10 points combined in the first five minutes. However, CU opened up a 30-19 lead at the 7:55 mark.

The host Tigers, who improved to 11-10 overall and 2-7 G-MAC, outscored the Yellow Jackets 61-25 the rest of the way.

Marcus Reineke finished with 16 points for Cedarville, 6-17 and 4-7 G-MAC. Jason Cuffee chipped in 12 markers.

Coach Estep added, "We were outworked and they were the tougher team on the floor for the last 20 minutes of the game. Give Salem credit they just flat out wanted that game more than us."

The Yellow Jackets take the short trip to Central State University this Saturday, Feb. 22 for a Great Midwest Athletic Conference encounter with the Marauders at 4:15 p.m.

One week from tonight, Cedarville will host Ohio Valley University in a G-MAC contest at 7:45 p.m. against the Fighting Scots.

The 2013-14 regular season will end with a league home contest on Saturday, Mar. 1 versus Salem International University at 4:15 p.m.

The G-MAC Tournament will be held Mar. 6-8 at the #1 seed.

## Head Coach Pat Estep

Pat Estep has been the head men's basketball coach at Cedarville University since the 2008-09 campaign. He has guided his alma mater to an average of nearly 24 victories per season and five consecutive national tournament appearances.

The Yellow Jackets' first active season in NCAA Division II resulted in a 22-9 mark in 2012-13. Estep was voted the Great Midwest Athletic Conference Coach of the Year as his team claimed the G-MAC regular season title, the G-MAC Tournament trophy, and placed third in the NCCAA Championship.



Cedarville was 23-9 performance during their NCAA provisional year in 2011-12. They won the school's first NCCAA Championship banner in convincing fashion after entering the 2012 tournament as the No. 1 seed and winning their three games by an average of 18 points. Estep was tabbed NCCAA National Coach of the Year.

Cedarville finished strong again in 2010-11 by winning eight of their last nine regular season games including the last five in a row. The Jackets were ranked as high as 14th in the NAIA Division II poll and finished at 20-13.

Cedarville won 16 of its last 18 games in 2009-10 to finish 26-9 and 14-2 in the American Midwest Conference as the league runner-up. The Yellow Jackets, who were rated as high as 8th in the national poll, later won the AMC Tournament and advanced to the second round of the national tournament.

Estep's inaugural campaign at the helm was full of memorable accomplishments. He guided the Yellow Jackets to a 27-4 overall record and a share of the AMC title with a 12-1 league mark. Cedarville was ranked as high as No. 1 in the country, finished in a tie for the No. 2 spot in the final poll, and advanced to the national tournament.

The Jackets assembled a number of school records which included a 14-game winning streak. They also wiped out all of the previous marks for defense.

Cedarville led the country in field goal percentage defense with opponents shooting just 37.9 percent. They also ranked second nationally by allowing a stingy 60 points per contest which was 10 points per game lower than the old school record.

Estep's leadership did not go unnoticed. He was voted the AMC Coach of the Year as well as the NCCAA Midwest Region Coach of the Year.

Estep took on his current position after serving as an assistant coach for eight years under former head coach Ray Slagle. He played a key role during Slagle's successful tenure with the Yellow Jackets from 2000 to 2008.

Cedarville won 177 games during that timespan, averaged 24.1 wins over the last seven seasons, won three American Midwest Conference titles, and two AMC Tournament championships.

The Yellow Jackets made five trips to the NAIA Division II National Tournament where they never lost in the first round. They advanced to the semifinals once, the quarterfinals twice, and to the second round twice.

This is the first head coaching position for Estep. A 1997 graduate of Cedarville College with a degree in physical education, he was a student assistant at the school during his senior year and went on to acquire coaching experience at all levels of basketball.

Estep was the 8th grade coach at Cedarville Junior High School in 1996-97. He spent the next year at Clark County Christian High School in Kentucky where he was the varsity assistant boys basketball coach and the head coach in golf and tennis.

Estep spent the 1998-99 season as the junior varsity coach at Oak Hill (Ohio) High School. He held the same position in 1999-2000 at South Webster (Ohio) High School which is where he graduated from in 1993.

Estep comes from a rich basketball coaching heritage. His father, Dale, spent 27 years in the profession at Fairfield Union and South Webster high schools.

Estep also has a master's degree in education from Cedarville University that he earned in 2008. Pat and his wife, Melanie, reside in Cedarville with their three children: sons Isaiah, 12, and Grant, 9, as well as daughter, Merynn, 3.

Hayes led his team to two G-MAC wins this week over Cedarville and Central State to improve to 10-1 in conference play, holding a percentage advantage over Alderson Broaddus in the standings.

In the two games, Hayes averaged a conference best 30.5 points per game. In the win over Cedarville, Hayes scored a conference-high 35 points last week. He followed it up with a team-high 26 points and a conference best (last week) six assists against Central State.

For the week he scored almost half of his points from the free throw line, going 26-27 from the charity stripe. As of last week, Hayes ranked in the top-15 in the nation in free throw attempts and makes. His rankings should improve with his performances over the weekend.

Hayes improved his season scoring average to 18.0 points per game, ranking fifth - only 1.2 points behind conference leader Sequan Lawrence of Ohio Valley.
