As the game went on we started cutting the lead down and were tied at half. When we came back out we had complete control of the game from the beginning of the second half to the end. In large part to the performance of Colton Linkous. Colton had 16 points off the bench and played his best game of the year so far. It was special to watch because Colton is always in the gym working hard and shooting extra shots. It was definitely a breakout game for him, and I'm sure he will continue to have games just like that.







Last Time Out • 2/18/16



BLUEFIELD, W.Va. - Cedarville erased a 10-point deficit in the final three minutes of regulation and then used two overtimes for an 89-85 non-conference win at Bluefield State.

The Yellow Jackets registered their fourth straight victory to improve to 12-13 overall.

Evan Kraatz broke the game's 15th and final tie on a layup with 12 seconds remaining in the second OT for an 87-85 lead.

After the hosts called a timeout at midcourt, J.C. Faubion stole the ensuing inbounds pass and scored to account for the final.

However, it was in the last minutes of the second half where Cedarville stole the show. Kwenton Scott's three-point play with 2:43 remaining started the comeback to get the visitors within 66-59.

Easton Bazzoli's layup actually gave the Yellow Jackets a 68-67 advantage with 26 seconds to go, but the Big Blues netted one-of-two free throws with nine seconds left to force overtime.

Faubion's iumper at the end of the first OT tied it, 77-77. CU made all four of its free throws while outscoring Bluefield State 12-8 in the second extra session to win it.

All five starters scored in double figures led by Robert Okoro with a career-high 20 points. Faubion finished with 16 points and a career-high 16 rebounds

Patrick Bain tallied 16 points, Bazzoli scored 14 with a career-high 12 boards, and Scott chipped in 11 points.

Numbers Game:

- The Jackets had not played a double overtime game since opening the 2013-14 campaign at home with a 110-107 win over Saint Joseph's
- Bain scored 49 points in the two games played vs. Bluefield State.
- Cedarville's +14 margin on the boards tied for the second-highest this season (+15 at Central State on Jan. 21).
- · Okoro's previous career-high was 13 points at Ohio Valley.
- · Faubion accomplished his fourth double-double of the season. He had a then career-high 13 rebounds at Ferris State on Nov. 24.
- · Bazzoli's double-double was his second of the year (Davis & Elkins).
- The Jackets' streaky season continues 5 straight losses, 5 straight wins, 4 L's, 3 W's, 4 L's, and 4 W's.

Looking Ahead



The Yellow Jackets end the regular season with Great Midwest Athletic Conference road games at Alderson Broaddus on Thursday, Feb. 25 at 7:45 p.m. and Davis & Elkins on Saturday, Feb. 27 at 4:15 p.m.

Cedarville has secured a berth in the six-team 2016 G-MAC Men's Basketball Championship to be played March 3-5 at the league's #1 seed - opponents and times to be announced.

GREENWOOD, Ind. - Davis & Elkins junior guard Kevin Bracy-Davis was named the 13th Great Midwest Athletic Conference Men's Basketball Athlete of the Week for 2015-16.

Bracy-Davis earned his second G-MAC Men's Basketball

Athlete of the Week honor of the current season after being selected back in early December

The Senators (10-13, 4-5 G-MAC) enhanced their chances at playoff seeding in the six-team tournament field with a conference win against Alderson Broaddus at home in their lone game of the week.

Bracy-Davis posted an eye-opening line of 29 points, nine rebounds and five blocked shots against the Battlers while nailing 5-of-6 tries from deep and 7-of-10 attempts overall.

At the free-throw line, he sank 10 of his 11 tries, and added an assist and one steal in 37 minutes of work.

Bracy-Davis has been the leading scorer for Davis & Elkins in the Senators' late regular-season run. He returned from a near-seven game absence with a vengeance, scoring 20 points or more in five consecutive games.

D&E is winners in four of its last five and is currently fourth in the league stand-

Bracy-Davis has been limited to playing in 17 of his team's 23 games this season. He's averaging 20.9 points per game, a number that would be tops in the conference if he appeared in 75 percent of his team's games.

He's also averaging 6.5 rebounds per game and shooting almost 57 percent from the field. In five conference games, he's picked it up with a scintillating pace of 62.5 percent shooting (30-of-48).

Head Coach Pat Estepp

Pat Estepp has been the head men's basketball coach at Cedarville University since the 2008-09 campaign. He has guided his alma mater to an average of 20 victories per season and five national tournament appearances.

The Yellow Jackets' first active season in NCAA Division II resulted in a 22-9 mark in 2012-13. Estepp was voted the Great Midwest Athletic Conference Coach of the Year as his team claimed the G-MAC regular season title, the G-MAC Tournament trophy, and placed third in the NCCAA Championship.

Cedarville was 23-9 during its NCAA provisional year in 2011-12. They won the school's first NCCAA Championship banner in convincing fashion after entering the 2012 tournament as the No. 1 seed and winning their three games by an average of 18 points. Estepp was tabbed NCCAA National Coach of the Year.

Cedarville finished strong again in 2010-11 by winning eight of their last nine regular season games including the last five in a row. The Jackets were ranked as high as 14th in the NAIA Division II poll and finished at 20-13.

Cedarville won 16 of its last 18 games in 2009-10 to finish 26-9 and 14-2 in the American Mideast Conference as the league runner-up. The Yellow Jackets, who were rated as high as 8th in the national poll, later won the AMC Tournament and advanced to the second round of the national tournament

Estepp's inaugural campaign at the helm was full of memorable accomplishments. He guided the Yellow Jackets to a 27-4 overall record and a share of the AMC title with a 12-1 league mark. Cedarville was ranked as high as No. 1 in the country, finished in a tie for the No. 2 spot in the final poll, and advanced to the national tournament.

The Jackets assembled a number of school records which included a 14-game winning streak. They also wiped out all of the previous marks for defense.

Cedarville led the country in field goal percentage defense with opponents shooting just 37.9 percent. They also ranked second nationally by allowing a stingy 60 points per contest which was 10 points per game lower than the old school record.

Estepp's leadership did not go unnoticed. He was voted the AMC Coach of the Year as well as the NCCAA Midwest Region Coach of the Year.

Estepp took on his current position after serving as an assistant coach for eight years under former head coach Ray Slagle. He played a key role during Slagle's successful tenure with the Yellow Jackets from 2000 to 2008.

Cedarville won 177 games during that timespan, averaged 24.1 wins over the last seven seasons, won three American Mideast Conference titles, and two AMC Tournament championships.



The Yellow Jackets made five trips to the NAIA Division II National Tournament where they never lost in the first round. They advanced to the semifinals once, the quarterfinals twice, and to the second round twice.

This is the first head coaching position for Estepp. A 1997 graduate of Cedarville College with a degree in physical education, he was a student assistant at the school during his senior year and went on to acquire coaching experience at all levels of basketball.

Estepp was the 8th grade coach at Cedarville Junior High School in 1996-97. He spent the next year at Clark County Christian High School in Kentucky where he was the varsity assistant boys basketball coach and the head coach in golf and tennis.

Estepp spent the 1998-99 season as the junior varsity coach at Oak Hill (Ohio) High School. He held the same position in 1999-2000 at South Webster (Ohio) High School which is where he graduated from in 1993.

Estepp comes from a rich basketball coaching heritage. His father, Dale, spent 27 years in the profession at Fairfield Union and South Webster high schools.

Estepp also has a master's degree in education from Cedarville University that he earned in 2008. Pat and his wife, Melanie, reside in Cedarville with their three children: sons Isaiah, 14, and Grant, 11, as well as daughter, Merynn, 5.

Cedarville, Davis & Elkins Honored **Again for Academic Success Rates**



INDIANAPOLIS - Cedarville University and Davis & Elkins College headlined the Great Midwest Athletic Conference with Academic Success Rates of 90 percent or higher as released by the NCAA on Wednesday.

Cedarville and Davis & Elkins are among 27 NCAA Division II schools to be honored part of the Presidents' Award for Academic Excellence, now in its fifth year.

This is the third consecutive year that both Cedarville and D&E have received the Presidents' Award for Academic Excellence.

D&E had a reported ASR of 94 with UC-San Diego, Assumption and Seattle Pacific, while Cedarville's ASR of 91 tied four other schools.

For the first time, the University of the Sciences in Philadelphia led Division II with an Academic Success Rate of 99 percent, followed closely by Saint Michael's College, Point Loma Nazarene University and Bentley University, all of which achieved a 98 percent ASR.

For the second straight year, the Northeast-10 led Division II's 24 conferences in ASR rates, with five athletics programs posting scores of 90 percent or more.

The G-MAC ranked fifth among all 24 Division II conferences with ASR's of 90 percent or more.

"We are pleased by the increasing number of Division II schools whose student-athletes are earning Academic Success Rates of 90 percent or higher," said Judy Bense, president of the University of West Florida and chair of the Division II Presidents Council. "These schools and their students demonstrate the utmost dedication to success in the classroom and on the field, and we are proud of their efforts."

The Academic Success Rate is the percentage of student-athletes who graduate within six years of initial enrollment in college and includes virtually all Division II student-athletes, including transfers and those not receiving athletics scholarships.

The Division II ASR also captures about 51 percent more college athletes than the federal graduation rate. Unlike the federal graduation rate, the ASR also counts student-athletes who transfer to a school after initial enrollment elsewhere and removes from the rate student-athletes who leave school while academically eligible. The national ASR is 71 percent for student-athletes who entered college from 2005 through 2008.

Regardless of which measure is used, Division II college athletes graduate at a higher rate than the general student body. The federal rate for the 2008 entering class of student-athletes was 55 percent, compared to 49 percent for the general student body.
