Dr. Johnson has been at Cedarville University in various roles since 1974. Prior to her current position she served as the Dean of the College of Health Professions from 2004-2014. Dr. Johnson was the Head Coach of the Lady

Jacket tennis team for 30 years until 2006 and is currently the Associate Head Coach for the CU women's tennis team. She is married to Cliff, and together they reside in Cedarville.

Tonight's Match

The Cedarville University women's volleyball team hosts the Trevecca University Trojans in an important Great Midwest Athletic Conference contest tonight in the Callan Athletic Center.

Cedarville, under the direction of seventh-year Head Coach Doug Walters (151-105), enters tonight's action with a 14-12 record including a league-leading 6-1 tally in the G-MAC.

The Lady Jackets, pre-season favorites to three-peat in the Great Midwest Athletic Conference, dropped a 3-1 verdict at the University of Indianapolis on Tuesday night in their most recent action.

Trevecca is 13-10 overall with a 4-1 record in the Great Midwest Athletic Conference. The Trojans were swept by the University of Southern Indiana on Tuesday night in Nashville.

Senior Amanda Bell is topping the offensive arsenal of CU with 226 kills while adding a second-best 243 digs.

Classmate Hannah Wagner, a 6-2 outside hitter, is second on the team with 216 kills to go with a .242 attack percentage. She is also second on the Lady Jackets with 72 blocks.

Sophomore Abby Shelton is third with 209 kills while classmate Angela Becker, a 5-6 libero, paces the back row with 387 digs (4.12/set).

Setters senior Maddie (Anderson) Ledbetter and sophomore Kristin Cardwell direct CU's offense. Ledbetter is the all-time Lady Jacket leader with 272 service aces and ranks sixth with 2,969 career assists. She is on track to become just the fifth setter in CU volleyball history to post 3,000 or more assists in a career. Cardwell has 454 assists, 127 digs and is third with 30 service aces this season. She is just 32 assists away from reaching 1,000 in her first two years at Cedarville.

Trevecca is led by Head Coach Jayme Crowley who is in her seventh year at the helm of the program (137-99).

Sophomore outside/middle hitter Katelyn Atkinson, the 2013 G-MAC Freshman of the Year, leads the Trojans with 342 kills and 3.98 kills per set.

Delaney Hearne, a junior outside/middle hitter, is second with 198 kills with a team-high 60 blocks.

Junior setter Loren Bennett has handed out 767 assists while Kayleigh Jarrett tops the back row with 245 digs.

Cedarville holds a 5-2 advantage in the all-time series with the Trojans. Trevecca posted a 3-2 win over CU earlier this year on October 4 in Nashville, Tennessee.

Meet Coach Doug Walters



Doug Walters has been the head volleyball coach at Cedarville University since 2008. He is the sixth head coach in the program's history and the first male to serve in the capacity.

The Lady Jackets have posted 137 victories during Walters' six-year tenure. The list of honors includes the 2008 NCCAA championship as well as back-to-back Great Midwest Athletic Conference crowns in 2012 and 2013.

During the school's first active season in NCAA Division II in 2012, his squad rolled to a 32-6 overall mark and was a perfect 8-0 in the G-MAC. Cedarville went on to win the inaugural G-MAC Tournament and Walters was ultimately voted the league's Coach of the Year.

The Jackets, who finished 23-14 overall in 2013, repeated the feat after sharing the league's best regular season record at 12-2. They went on the road to claim their second straight G-MAC Tournament trophy.

Walters' first season with the Lady Jackets in 2008 was a memorable one as he guided the program to its third National Christian College Athletic Association title in four years. He was tabbed the NCCAA National Coach of the Year.

Cedarville finished with a 27-12 record overall that season and tied for fourth place out of 15 teams in the American Midwest Conference with a 10-4 mark. The Lady Jackets qualified for the AMC Tournament and advanced to the semifinals.

CU was 15-23 overall in 2009. However, the Lady Jackets were the #2 seed in the AMC Tournament after going 8-4 in the league. The Jackets were 18-20 and 6-4 AMC in 2010 while advancing to the semifinals of the conference tournament.

Cedarville finished with a 22-18 mark in 2011 during the school's NCAA provisional year and was the No. 1 seed in the Ohio Independent Championship Tournament.

Walters came to Cedarville after assembling a 128-73 record in nine years of high school coaching in southern Ohio. He spent his last two seasons at the prep level at Milford High School, a Division I program near Cincinnati.

Walters previously spent seven years building Eastern High School in Sardinia into one of the top Division III programs in Ohio. The Warriors, who were ranked in the state's Top 10 in three different seasons, won four conference titles, two sectional championships, and were the district runner-up once. He was a four-time conference Coach of the Year and saw eight players continue their careers at the collegiate level.

Walters is the founder and former director of the Greater Miami Volleyball Club. The GMVC was started in 2003 and is a Junior Olympic organization that has quickly built a reputation as one of the top regional clubs in Cincinnati.

Walters continues to be involved at the club level. He is a National Team Coach for the Elevation Volleyball Club based out of Mason, Ohio.

Additionally, Walters is the volleyball chair of the Great Midwest Athletic Conference. He serves as the G-MAC rep to the AVCA Division II Head Coaches Committee and is a member of the AVCA National Poll Committee.

Walters is a 1997 graduate of Northern Kentucky University and he earned his master's degree from the University of Dayton in 2003. Doug and his wife, Angela, reside in Morrow, Ohio with their daughter Caitlyn, 12.

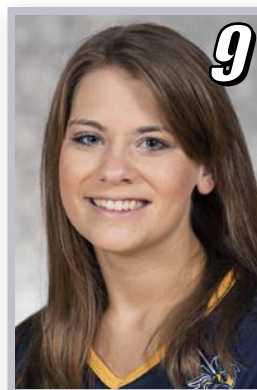
