



Tonight's Game

The Cedarville University baseball team hosts the Ohio Christian University Trailblazers in the 7th Annual Cedarville Baseball Classic at Fifth Third Field. The Yellow Jackets are 24-8 on the season including a doubleheader sweep of visiting Salem International on Friday. Saturday's two games with Salem were canceled due to rain. Ohio Christian is 6-20 in the 2012 campaign. The Trailblazers snapped a four-game skid with a 7-1 win over visiting Johnson University on Saturday.

Cedarville's sophomore Cam McWilliams paces the 2012 squad in hitting with a .413 mark. The speedy center fielder has scored 22 runs while leading the Yellow Jackets with 15 swipes.

Senior shortstop Alex Beelen is CU's second-best hitter at .393 with 29 runs, 10 doubles, a triple and a home run. Beelen also has a team-high 44 hits.

Sophomore Ryan Ledbetter is hitting .375 with 18 hits in 48 at bats.



Junior outfielder Chris Ward is hitting .370 while leading CU in runs scored with 31. He is tied with Beelen for a second-best 24 RBI's this year.

Classmate Logan Kasabian has steadily increased his batting mark to .367.

Nate Davenport, a 6-4 senior, is batting .367 with a .600 slugging percentage. The first sacker is tied with Beelen for the team lead in hits (44), has 11 doubles, 4 triples, 3 HR's, 42 runs batted in, 72 total bases and a .600 slugging pct.

The Yellow Jacket pitching staff features sophomore David Ledbetter with a sparkling 0.22 ERA allowing just one earned run in 40 2/3 innings with a 5-1 record and a team-best 49 K's. Rookie Jordan Ammon leads the Jackets in wins with a 6-1 mark in 40 innings of work. Junior righthander Michael Roe is 5-0 with 33 K's and a 2.59 ERA in 41 2/3 innings.

The two teams met previously this spring in a twinbill at Yellow Jacket Field. Cedarville swept the Trailblazers by scores of 9-2 and 3-2. CU won all three contests against Ohio Christian during the 2011 season.

Cam McWilliams delivered an RBI single with one out in the bottom of the seventh inning to give the Yellow Jackets a 5-4 win over Salem International to complete a twinbill sweep on Friday afternoon. CU won the opener, 11-0. A doubleheader on Saturday between the two squads was rained out.



After SIU tied the contest 4-4 with a two-out single in the top of the seventh, Logan Kasabian led off Cedarville's half with a double down the left field line.

Ryan Ledbetter sacrificed Kasabian to third and Chris Fox was hit by a pitch. McWilliams followed with a sharp single to right center to end it for the Yellow Jackets, 24-8 overall.

The Tigers, 4-36, held a 3-0 lead entering the bottom of the fourth inning. CU recovered for a 4-3 margin until the teams traded runs in

Kasabian, Alex Beelen and Chris Ward had two hits apiece. Winning pitcher Michael Rowe struck out six and improved to 5-0.

The first game was all Cedarville. Alex Beelen was 3-for-4 with two doubles, two runs scored, and two RBI's. McWilliams added two hits and Nate Davenport pounded a towering three-run homer.

Jordan Ammon got the win on the mound to push his mark to 6-1. John Mark Edwards worked the final inning.



Head Coach Mike Manes



Mike Manes (pronounced MAN-us) has been the head baseball coach at Cedarville University since 2008. He has guided the Yellow Jackets to their four winningest seasons in school history and three trips to the NCCAA National Tournament.

Cedarville set a school record for the most victories in a season in 2011 with a 33-18-2 mark and had a best-ever five NCCAA All-Americans on the roster. It was also the first time in more than 30 years that the Yellow Jackets registered

three consecutive winning seasons on the diamond.

CU copped the NCCAA Midwest Region banner for the second time in three years and returned to the NCCAA National Tournament. Manes was named the Region Coach of the Year.

Cedarville posted a 28-27 record in 2010. The Jackets were also the NCCAA Midwest Region runner-up.

Manes was named the 2009 NCCAA Midwest Region Coach of the Year after leading Cedarville to the region title. The Yellow Jackets won over 30 games for the first time in school history with their 32-28 record and split four games at the NCCAA Nationals.

Cedarville was the Midwest Region runner-up in Manes' first season in 2008. The Jackets set a then school record for the most victories in season with 23. They also won eight games in the tough American Mideast Conference which equaled their league win total from the previous three seasons combined.

Manes came to the Yellow Jackets following a four-year stay as head coach at Trinity International University near Chicago. He was able to turn the TIU program around after inheriting a team that won just four games in his first season in 2004 and the school had never qualified for the conference tournament.

Manes then guided the Trojans to 85 victories over the next three seasons by winning 25, 28, and 32 games, respectively, which set school records for the most victories in a season each time. The 2006 squad put together TIU's first-ever winning season and the 2007 team finished 32-22.

In his short tenure, Manes guided the Trojans to their first-ever conference tournament appearance, two NCCAA North Central Region championships, and TIU played in the NCCAA National Tournament in each of his last three seasons. He was tabbed the 2005 NCCAA North Central Region Coach of the Year.

The Nebraska native previously founded and coached the Lincoln Crusaders which is an American Legion baseball club. In his 11 years at the helm, the team made nine trips to the state tournament winning one championship and finishing as the runner-up on two other occasions.

Manes is actively involved in baseball administration. He is currently the NCCAA baseball chair as well as the chair of the Great Midwest Athletic Conference which is the newest NCAA Division II conference.

Manes is a 1989 graduate of Liberty University and he earned a master's degree in 2005 from Almeda University. Mike and his wife, Connie, reside in Springfield and have four married children and five grandchildren.


