Today's Game Preview



The Cedarville University Lady Jackets host the Walsh University Cavaliers today in the Callan Athletic Center as part of the annual Li'l Sibs Weekend.

Cedarville enters the game with a record of 14-7 and on a three-game winning streak. In their most recent action, the Lady Jackets topped Ursuline College by a final of 86-47 on Tuesday night in Pepper Pike, Ohio.

Walsh University, an institution also in transition into NCAA Division II membership, enters tonight's game with a record of 13-13. The visiting Cavaliers lost to the Falcons of Notre Dame College on Thursday night 71-62 in South Euclid, Ohio.

The 2011-12 Lady Jacket roster features two players hitting in double figures as well as four players with 68 or more assists.

Kayla Jenerette, a 5-foot-5 sophomore guard, continues to lead the team at 16.7 points per game including a team-high 50 three-point field goals and a .481 mark from long range.

Deborah Gordon, a 5-foot-11 rookie forward, is adding a second-best 11.4 points per contest while pacing CU with 6.6 rebounds per game. Gordon is expected to miss tonight's game due to a recent minor medical procedure but be back for Tuesday's contest with Wilberforce.

CU's third-leading scorer is Raegan Ryan today's SUBWAY Player of the Game. The 5-foot-5 freshman guard is tossing in 9.9 points per game while leading the squad with 32 steals and a .894 (42-for-47) mark at the charity stripe.

We also played Notre Dame away on Saturday. It was a long day of traveling and games. We traveled with the men which is bittersweet. We enjoy being able to interact with them and watch their game but let's just say the space on the bus was not ideal for some of us. Big men take up big spaces. Anyway, the Notre Dame game was a good and competitive game. It came down to the last two minutes. Raegan Ryan hit two huge free throws to give us a three point lead with about 12 seconds left. Kara Cayton added another two free throws with 3.5 seconds left. We came out with a win with the final score being 65-60.

As we watched the men's game, we unfortunately had to sit in front of the band. However, Coach Martin was quite thrilled - he would be the only one. Anyway, as the pep band director was in front of us, Coach picked up some directing skills. He seemed to be a natural when it came to waving his arms incessantly in all directions. Some of it may derive from what he does on the sidelines during games; but let's not speculate any further. leads CU with 73 assists and is second on the team with 33 three-pointers.

Post player Lauryn Robinson, a 6-foot-2 sophomore, will get the start tonight in place of the recovering Gordon. Robinson is contributing a fifth-best 5.9 points and a fourth-best 3.6 boards a game. She has the team lead with 14 blocked shots on the year.

Sophomore forward Deborah Chandler is scoring 5.9 points per game to go with 3.6 rebounds per contest.

Sophomore guard Becky Orchard adds 5.5 points per game while handing out a second-best 71 assists. Orchard is the second-leading Lady Jacket rebounder at 4 boards a game.

Heidi Ansiel, a 5-foot-8 sophomore, continues to produce solid minutes as a scorer and rebounder. She is contributing 4.4 ppg and 3.7 rpg.

Walsh University is directed by Head Coach Laurel Wartluft. She is in her sixth year with the Cavs and has a record of 104-76.

The lone player scoring in double digits for the Cavaliers is Tracy Payne. The 5-foot-5 junior guard is recording 11.8 points per game while leading the team in field goals (111) including 26 three-pointers.

Daniella Ciccarone, a 5-foot-8 sophomore guard, is hitting 9.6 points per game while leading the way with 70 assists and an .859 mark at the charity line.



The leading rebounder for Walsh is 6-foot-1 *Tracy Payne* senior center Kristi Yoder with 5.7 boards per game. Yoder adds 8.4 points per game to the Cav offense.

The Lady Jackets met up with the Cavaliers in the first game of the season at the Walsh Classic. Cedarville, with a narrow 19-17 lead in the all-time series, posted a 76-59 decision over the Cavs on Nov. 11, 2011.



This week we face Ursuline and Walsh. We are traveling to Ursuline on Tuesday and playing at 7 p.m. I'm definitely looking forward to this away game because we are able to visit and spend time with Bayley Nosal at her home before the game. It's always a blessing to stay connected with

alumni and we are all looking forward to it. On Saturday we play Walsh at home at 2 p.m.



Last Time Out

PEPPER PIKE, Ohio - Kayla Jenerette and Raegan Ryan did the damage from long range to spark Cedarville to an easy 86-47 victory at Ursuline on Tuesday night to win for the sixth time in the last seven outings.

Jenerette drilled 5-of-8 three-pointers en route to a game-high 21 points. Ryan was good on 4-of-5 long balls and totaled a career-high 18 markers.

The Lady Jackets, 14-7 overall, found themselves in a 17-17 tie with under eight minutes left in the first half. A 24-8 explosion to finish the period resulted in a 41-25 margin at the break.

Jenerette scored 11 straight points for CU early in the second half which included a trio of three-pointers. However, the host Arrows were still hanging around within 54-39 with 11:30 left.

The Jackets needed less than three minutes to run off 14 unanswered points. The string was part of a 21-2 haymaker that made it 75-41 at the 6:50 mark. Cedarville scored the final 11 points of the game to account for the final.

Deborah Gordon added 14 points for the Lady Jackets. Kara Cayton handed out a game-high seven assists.

CU made 10 three-pointers, converted 14-of-16 free throws, and controlled the boards, 48-31. Ursuline drops to 6-15.

Looking Ahead

This coming Tuesday, Feb. 14 CU will host Wilberforce University in a 7:00 p.m. tip-off.

One week from today, Saturday, Feb. 18 the Lady Jackets visit Urbana University Blue Knights in a game slated for 2 p.m.

Cedarville closes out the regular season with home games versus Central State (Feb. 21 - 5:30 p.m.) and Malone (Feb. 25 - 2:00 p.m.)

Head Coach Kirk Martin

Kirk Martin has been the head women's basketball coach at Cedarville University since the 2001-02 season and built the Lady Jackets into one of the top NAIA programs in the country. His teams have averaged 27 wins per season during his tenure.

Martin's team made its eighth and final appearance at the 2011 NAIA Division II National Tournament which featured a surprising run to the quarterfinals. CU knocked off perennial powers Saint Francis (Ind.) and Ozarks before losing to unbeaten Davenport to finish the season 24-10.



The Jackets won the school's fifth American

Mideast Conference championship in 2009-10 and finished 27-6 overall and 17-2 AMC. The Jackets were ranked No. 5 in the final NAIA Division II poll and ultimately advanced to the second round of the national tournament.

It was the second straight NAIA appearance for the CU women. They also earned an automatic berth in 2009 by finishing second in the demanding AMC.

Martin was able to lead a young Lady Jacket squad to a strong finish and the NCCAA national title in 2008. He was named the NCCAA National Coach of the Year.

Martin guided CU to five straight NAIA Division II national tournament appearances from 2003 through 2007 including back-to-back runner-up finishes in 2004 and 2005. The Jackets sport a 17-8 record at the event with a semifinals achievement in 2007, quarterfinals efforts in 2006 and 2011, and two second round showings.

Martin's club owned the American Mideast Conference titles from 2003 through 2007 assembling an 86-4 record during that timespan. CU ran off three straight undefeated league campaigns in the AMC South Division from 2003 through 2006 which included a conference-record 72-game winning streak.

Cedarville was rated No. 5 in the final 2006-07 NAIA Division II national poll en route to a 27-7 record. They held down the No. 1 position in 2005-06 which was the second straight year that the Lady Jackets accomplished the feat. They rolled to a 29-4 record overall which included a 19-game winning streak.

The Lady Jackets nearly met their ultimate goal of a national title in 2004-05 while posting a 35-2 record. Other highlights that season included an NAIA No. 1 ranking for the final six weeks of the season, a 22-game winning streak, and a second straight 18-0 run through the AMC South Division.

Martin's 2003-04 ball club produced a memorable campaign while being ranked as high as No. 2 in NAIA Division II. Among the team's many achievements were setting a school record for the most wins in a season with a 35-3 record, rolling to a perfect 18-0 league mark, and assembling a school-record 23-game winning streak.

Cedarville had a 31-3 overall record in the 2002-03 season, posted a 21game winning streak, claimed the AMC South Division with a 17-1 mark, and won the inaugural AMC championship game. The Jackets were ranked as high as No. 3 in the country and qualified for the NAIA Division II national tournament for the first time in school history where the team advanced to the second round.

Martin took over the coaching reigns at his alma mater in 2001-02 and promptly guided Cedarville to a 23-10 record - at the time a school record for the most wins in a single season. The Jackets posted a 15-5 mark to finish 4th in the 19-team AMC. They were the only league school to beat the top three teams in the standings and all three were ranked in the NAIA Division II Top 25. Cedarville qualified for the AMC Tournament and advanced to the semifinals.

Martin came to Cedarville after developing Southeastern High School into one of Ohio's elite Division IV girls' basketball programs. He brought with him an impressive list of credentials produced at a school where he was employed since graduating from Cedarville College in 1976. He earned his master's degree in Educational Administration from the University of Dayton in 1982.

He was inducted into the Cedarville University Athletic Hall of Fame in 1998 for his coaching accomplishments.

Kirk and his wife, Vicki, reside in Springfield. The Martins have three married children: older daughter, Amy Fourman, who is a former Lady Jacket volleyball and basketball player, resides in Enon, Ohio with her husband, Aaron, along with their two children; younger daughter, Kelly Mangin, resides in Fairborn, Ohio with her husband, Bryan, and their son; and son, Brent, is a former member of the Yellow Jacket golf and tennis teams, lives in Dayton with his wife, Rachel.
