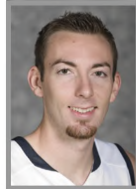


Tonight's Game Preview

The Cedarville University Yellow Jackets host the Point Park Pioneers in an American Midwest Conference battle on Farmer's Night in the Callan Athletic Center.

Cedarville enters the contest with a record of 12-10 and 7-4 in the AMC. The Jackets swept a pair of AMC games this past weekend in New York - defeating Houghton 89-66 and Daemen 75-59. Point Park is 11-8 on the year with a 5-6 league mark. The Pioneers dropped a 91-72 decision at NAIA II #1 Walsh on Tuesday night.

The Yellow Jacket lineup continues to feature four players scoring in double figures. Leading the offensive attack is senior guard Matt Harner - averaging 18.6 points per game with a team-high 76 three-point field goals. Harner tops the squad with a .444 mark from behind the arc and is one of the AMC's best at the charity stripe with a .797 effort.

Sophomore forward Brian Hecker contributes 13.2 ppg and is CU's second-leading rebounder at 5.6 rpg. He leads the squad in blocks and is fourth with 27 three-pointers.

Senior point guard Derrick Hannon is hitting 11.4 points per contest and leads the Jackets and the AMC with 112 assists. He is the Jackets' fourth-leading rebounder at 4.1 per game.

Sophomore guard Austin Foote is scoring 10.5 points per game and adds firepower from outside the three-point line with a second-best 30 long-range baskets.

Adam Riehle, a 6-3 senior forward, tops the Yellow Jacket rebounders at 6 per game. He adds 8.3 points per contest while pacing the squad with a .635 field goal percentage.

Cedarville is shooting .466 from the field including 189-of-553 attempts from the three-point line for a .342 mark. The team is continuing a steady improvement at the charity stripe with a 227-of-370 effort (.614).

Cedarville is outscoring opponents by +2.2 points per game (78.9 to 76.7). The Yellow Jackets are winning the rebounding battle by a slim margin of +.7.

The Pioneer roster includes five players hitting in double figures. Kris Douse, a 6-7 senior forward, tops PPU with 19.2 ppg and is the AMC's leading rebounder at 13.4 rpg. He tossed in a game-high 27 points in Tuesday's loss at Walsh.

Jimmy Sherwood, a 6-2 senior guard, has returned to the lineup from an injury and is scoring 17.5 points per contest. The transfer from Duquesne is the team's second-leading rebounder (5.4 rpg) and free-throw shooter (.735).

T.J. Heatherington, a sophomore guard, suffered a knee injury in the January 15 game against the Yellow Jackets and is questionable for action. He has a 14.5 ppg average including 62 assists.

Point Park is scoring 90.6 points per game - second-highest in the AMC - but are allowing a league-worst 89.2 points per contest. The Pioneers are hitting .436 from the field and .344 from behind the arc on 176-of-512 shooting. They are last in the AMC with a .600 mark at the charity stripe.

The Yellow Jackets lead all-time series with Point Park by a narrow 7-6 margin. The Pioneers dropped CU in overtime by a 99-93 verdict on January 15, 2011 in a game played in West Mifflin, Pennsylvania.



Kenny Reep's Latest Weekly Blog

January 31, 2011

Just returned early Sunday morning from a busy weekend of travel, fresh off the bus from balmy Buffalo. Once more we boarded the bus Thursday night to face our AMC opponents to the North and came home with two conference wins. Driving through the remote wilds of upstate New York was quite an adventure as we left civilization and eventually found the snowy Eden of the Houghton campus in the middle of the barren landscapes of Centerville, New York. We defeated the Houghton Highlanders without too much trouble and then had the opportunity to watch the women's team pull out a win AFTER us.

The home crowd was "eating it up" and Matt Harner shot 6 foul shots for the 3 rapid-fire technicals.

We made it back to Cedarville early Sunday morning, only to find out a day later that we might be leaving for Tuesday's game at Malone on Monday night because of bad weather coming our way. Logging long hours on the charter bus is just the name of the game when riding into battle with the Cedarville Yellow Jackets.

Kenny Reep is a 6-foot-7 senior center from Peachtree City, Georgia. He is in her fourth season of action with the Yellow Jackets and is an exercise science major.

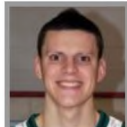

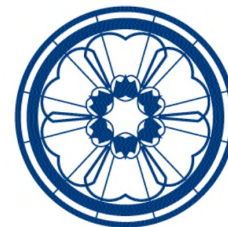

Last Time Out



The Yellow Jackets rose to the occasion defensively and continued their inexplicable mastery over Daemen with a convincing 75-59 American Midwest Conference win on Saturday afternoon in Amherst, New York.

It was the third victory in three tries this season for Cedarville over the Wildcats and the 11th in 12 all-time meetings. This outcome occurred primarily because the Jackets checked the hosts on 32 percent shooting including a 1-for-17 showing from beyond the arc.

Neither team could muster much in the first half. Austin Foote drained a pair of late three-pointers to help Cedarville to a 30-22 halftime lead. Matt Harner's three-pointer nailed a triple for a 45-28 spread at the 12:40 mark.

The Yellow Jackets enjoyed a 63-46 advantage with five minutes left before Daemen made a brief run. The Wildcats closed to within 65-56, but ran out of time.

Harner scored 14 of his 16 points in the second half. Brian Hecker finished with 15 points and Brian Grant tallied 12 for Cedarville, 12-10 overall and 7-4 AMC.

Daemen falls to 12-11 and 7-5 AMC.

The Jackets return to the Callan Athletic Center on Tuesday, Feb. 15 as the squad hosts the Bulldogs of Wilberforce University at 7:30 p.m.

Cedarville heads to Malone University on Thursday, Feb. 17 for a rescheduled contest against the Pioneers. Tip-off is 5:30 p.m.

CU ends the regular season against Notre Dame OH on Saturday, Feb. 19 at 7:30 p.m. in the Callan Athletic Center.

No. 21 Jamestown is the lone newcomer in this week's poll

KANSAS CITY, Mo - For the seventh-straight poll, Walsh (Ohio) is the No. 1 team, announced in the seventh regular-season edition of the NAIA Division II Men's Basketball Coaches' Top 25 poll. The Cavs have reached a 22-0 record to start the campaign, the best start since the 1982-83 season when they went 30-0. Walsh is the unanimous No. 1 selection 16 first-place votes for the second-straight week and posted 436 total points.



No. 21 Jamestown (N.D.) reaches the Top 25 for the first time since the first regular-season poll on Nov. 29, 2010 (No. 22). The Jimmies have won five in-a-row and 13 of their last 15 games. With an 18-5 record, they are currently on top of the Dakota Athletic Conference standings.

Dropping one game last week, Indiana Tech fell out of the rankings. With a 17-7 record, the Warriors were ranked 25th last week.

With the only undefeated record in the NAIA, Walsh continues to dominate. The Cavs are ranked No. 1 in the NAIA in scoring margin (32.1 ppg), scoring offense (95.8 ppg) and field goal percentage (.519). Eighteen of their 22 victories have been decided by more than 10 points, including a 99-63 victory against then-No. 18 Malone (Ohio) on Jan. 29. They look to extend a 43-game home winning streak this week.

For the second-straight week, Northwood (Fla.) holds the second-position with 422 points. Holding a 20-2 record, the Seahawks won their 12th-straight game with a 75-54 victory against Edward Waters (Fla.) on Jan. 29.

No. 3 Cornerstone (Mich.) continues to hold steady in the top 10. With 408 points in the Top 25, the Golden Eagles have been ranked in the top 10 in all eight polls this year. On Wednesday, the Golden Eagles host Marygrove (Mich.), followed by Indiana Tech on Saturday. Davenport won its fourth-straight with a 62-44 victory against Aquinas (Mich.) on Jan. 29.

Fourth-ranked Indiana Wesleyan moves up one spot this week, tallying 426 points. Boasting a school-record 19-game winning streak, the Wildcats recently defeated Bethel (Ind.), 70-61 on Jan. 29. A key matchup is on Tuesday against No. 13 Saint Francis (Ind.). Currently with a 22-3 record, Indiana Wesleyan is a perfect 11-0 in the Mid-Central College Conference.

Sliding up one spot, No. 5 Embry-Riddle posts 378 total points in the poll. The Eagles are 21-2 and have won their last six games and 18 of their last 19. With a win against No. 2 Northwood on Monday, Jan. 31 Embry-Riddle would grab the first-place position in The Sun Conference. The Eagles head into the contest trailing Northwood by one-half game in the standings. After Monday, Embry-Riddle faces Southeastern (Fla.) on Wednesday and Edward Waters (Fla.) on Saturday.

Eleven conferences are represented this week, led by the four members from the Mid-Central College Conference (MCC) and Great Plains Athletic Conference (GPAC). The MCC claims No. 4 Indiana Wesleyan, No. 13 Saint Francis (Ind.), No. 19 (tie) Grace (Ind.) and No. 19 (tie) Huntington (Ind.). These four hail from the GPAC: No. 11 Northwestern (Iowa), No. 14 Briar Cliff (Iowa), No. 17 Sioux Falls (S.D.) and No. 22 Dakota Wesleyan (S.D.). The Cascade Collegiate Conference, Midlands Collegiate Conference and Wolverine-Hoosier Athletic Conference each land a trio of teams.

The poll was voted upon by a panel of head coaches representing each of the conferences and independents. The eighth regular-season Top 25 will be announced on Feb. 7.
