Tonight's Game Preview

he Cedarville University Yellow Jackets host the Roberts Wesleyan College Raiders in an American Mideast Conference tonight in the Callan Athletic Center as part of the annual Li'l Sibs Weekend.

Cedarville enters the contest with a record of 13-10 and 8-4 in the AMC. The Jackets clipped visiting Point Park 100-87 on Thursday night for CU's third win in a row. Roberts Wesleyan is 12-11 overall with a 6-6 league record. The Raiders pulled off a huge last second 84-77 AMC win over Notre Dame on Thursday in Rochester, New York.

The Yellow Jacket lineup features four players scoring in double figures. Leading the offensive arsenal is senior guard Matt Harner - averaging 18.9 points per game with a team-high 81 three-point field goals. Harner tops the squad with a .443 mark from behind the arc and is one of the AMC's best at the charity stripe with an .806 effort.

Sophomore Brian Hecker contributes 12.7 ppg and is CU's second-leading rebounder at 5.4 rpg.

The 6-5 forward leads the squad in blocks and is fourth with 27 three-pointers but is questionable for action tonight due to a hip injury.

Sophomore guard Austin Foote is scoring 11.2 points per game and adds firepower from outside the three-point line with a second-best 34 long-range baskets.

Senior point guard Derrick Hannon is hitting 11.1 points per contest and leads the Jackets and the AMC with 118 assists. He has a team-high 43 steals and is the fourth-leading rebounder at 4 per game.

Adam Riehle, a 6-3 senior forward, is slated to get a start tonight in place of the injured Hecker. He tops the Yellow Jacket rebounders at 6.3 per game while adding 8.4 points per contest. Riehle paces the squad with a .627 field goal percentage.

Cedarville is shooting .464 from the field including 198-of-577 attempts from the three-point line for a .343 mark. The team is continuing a steady improvement at the charity stripe with a 254-of-404 effort (.629).

Cedarville is outscoring opponents by +2.7 points per game (79.8 to 77.2). The Yellow Jackets are winning the rebounding battle by a margin of +1.3.

The Raider roster includes just two players hitting in double figures. Jordan Heath, a 6-10 sophomore forward, tops RWC with 15.2 ppg and 7.1 rpg. He is second on the team with 43 blocked shots

Dan Foley, a 6-3 senior guard/forward, adds 13.9 points per game and a second-best 64 assists. He leads the AMC in steals with 2.2 per contest.

Alif Bland, a 6-8 junior post player, has returned to action after an injury. Bland tosses in 9.8 ppg and is the third-leading rebounder.

Roberts Wesleyan is scoring 73.3 points per game and allowing 70.2 points per contest. The Raiders are hitting .432 from the field but have league-worst .272 from behind the arc. They are



next to last in the AMC with a .615 mark at the charity stripe.

The Yellow Jackets lead all-time series with Roberts Wesleyan by an 11-4 margin. The Jackets won a league match-up earlier this season on Dec. 11, 2010 in Rochester by a 71-62 final as Matt Harner tossed in 20 points.

Just returned early Sunday morning from a busy weekend of travel, fresh off the bus from balmy Buffalo. Once more we boarded the bus Thursday night to face our AMC opponents to the North and came home with two conference wins. Driving through the remote wilds of upstate New York was quite an adventure as we left civilization and eventually found the snowy Eden of the Houghton campus in the middle of the barren landscapes of Centerville, New York. We defeated the Houghton Highlanders without too much trouble and then had the opportunity to watch the women's team pull out a win AFTER us.

We made it back to Cedarville early Sunday morning, only to find out a day later that we might be leaving for Tuesday's game at Malone on Monday night because of bad weather coming our way. Logging long hours on the charter bus is just the name of the game when riding into battle with the Cedarville Yellow Jackets.

Last Time Out



Matt Harner pumped in 26 points and Caleb Maxwell enjoyed a career night to guide Cedarville to a 100-87 American Mideast Conference win over Point Park in the Callan Athletic Center on Thursday night.

Harner did his thing, but it was Maxwell who made an unlikely contribution. Entering the game with just 22 points to his credit for the season, the 6-foot-8 sophomore came off the bench to explode for career-highs of 25 points and 13

Maxwell's effort was timely especially since starting forward Brian Hecker barely lasted a minute when a hip injury flared up. The visiting Pioneers scored the last nine points of the first half for a 41-37 advantage and increased the margin to seven early in the second period.

Maxwell, who racked up 21 points and nine boards in the second half alone, broke a 50-50 tie to give CU the lead for good at the 13:50 mark. He scored 13 of the team's points during a 19-7 spurt to provide the Jackets' largest edge at 77-64 with 6:05 left.

Harner knocked down five three-pointers and hit 7-of-8 free throws to go along with four assists for Cedarville, 13-10 overall and 8-4 AMC. Maxwell was 9-for-11 from the field and 7-of-9 at the line.

Austin Foote hit four three-pointers and finished with 21 points. Adam Riehle added a double-double of 11 points and 10 rebounds while Derrick Hannon dealt out a game-high six assists.

The Yellow Jackets were an impressive 27-of-32 at the free throw line in the second half after missing their only two attempts in the opening frame. Point Park, who outlasted CU 99-93 in overtime nearly three weeks ago, falls to 11-9 and 5-7 AMC.

Cedarville heads to Malone University on Thursday, Feb. 17 for a rescheduled contest against the Pioneers. Tip-off is 5:30 p.m.

CU ends the regular season against Notre Dame OH on Saturday, Feb. 19 at 7:30 p.m. in the Callan Athletic Center.



Adam Riehle (pronounced REE-lee) returns for his fourth season with the Yellow Jackets.....key front line player, who played in all 35 games as a junior with 31 starts.....averaged 3.6 points and 4.1 rebounds per game.....known for his hard-

nosed, aggressive style of play.....totaled eight points in a game eight times.....pulled down a career-high nine rebounds against Cumberlands (Ky.) and Trevecca Nazarene.....NAIA and NCCAA Scholar-Athlete.



No. 21 Jamestown is the lone newcomer in this week's poll

KANSAS CITY, Mo - For the seventh-straight poll, Walsh (Ohio) is the No. 1 team, announced in the seventh regular-season edition of the NAIA Division II Men's Basketball Coaches' Top 25 poll. The Cavs have reached a 22-0 record to start the campaign, the best start since the 1982-83 season when they went 30-0. Walsh is the unanimous No. 1 selection 16 first-place votes for the second-straight week and posted 436 total points.

and 13 of their last 15 games. With an 18-5 record, they are currently on top of the Dakota Athletic Conference standings.

Dropping one game last week, Indiana Tech fell out of the rankings. With a 17-7 record, the Warriors were ranked 25th last week.

With the only undefeated record in the NAIA, Walsh continues to dominant. The Cavs are ranked No. 1 in the NAIA in scoring margin (32.1 ppg), scoring offense (95.8 ppg) and field goal percentage (.519). Eighteen of their 22 victories have been decided by more than 10 points, including a 99-63 victory against then-No. 18 Malone (Ohio) on Jan. 29. They look to extend a 43-game home winning streak this week.

For the second-straight week, Northwood (Fla.) holds the second-position with 422 points. Holding a 20-2 record, the Seahawks won their 12th-straight game with a 75-54 victory against Edward Waters (Fla.) on Jan. 29.

No. 3 Cornerstone (Mich.) continues to hold steady in the top 10. With 408 points in the Top 25, the Golden Eagles have been ranked in the top 10 in all eight polls this year. On Wednesday, the Golden Eagles host Marygrove (Mich.), followed by Indiana Tech on Saturday. Davenport won its fourth-straight with a 62-44 victory against Aquinas (Mich.) on Jan. 29.

Fourth-ranked Indiana Wesleyan moves up one spot this week, tallying 426 points. Boasting a school-record 19-game winning streak, the Wildcats recently defeated Bethel (Ind.), 70-61 on Jan. 29. A key matchup is on Tuesday against No. 13 Saint Francis (Ind.). Currently with a 22-3 record, Indiana Wesleyan is a perfect 11-0 in the Mid-Central College Conference.

Sliding up one spot, No. 5 Embry-Riddle posts 378 total points in the poll. The Eagles are 21-2 and have won their last six games and 18 of their last 19. With a win against No. 2 Northwood on Monday, Jan. 31 Embry-Riddle would grab the first-place position in The Sun Conference. The Eagles head into the contest trailing Northwood by one-half game in the standings. After Monday, Embry-Riddle faces Southeastern (Fla.) on Wednesday and Edward Waters (Fla.) on Saturday

Eleven conferences are represented this week, led by the four members from the Mid-Central College Conference (MCC) and Great Plains Athletic Conference (GPAC). The MCC claims No. 4 Indiana Wesleyan, No. 13 Saint Francis (Ind.), No. 19 (tie) Grace (Ind.) and No. 19 (tie) Huntington (Ind.). These four hail from the GPAC: No. 11 Northwestern (Iowa), No. 14 Briar Cliff (Iowa), No. 17 Sioux Falls (S.D.) and No. 22 Dakota Wesleyan (S.D.). The Cascade Collegiate Conference, Midlands Collegiate Conference and Wolverine-Hoosier Athletic Conference each land a trio of teams.
