Tonight's Match

The Cedarville University women's volleyball team hosts the Notre Dame College OH Falcons in a non-conference match tonight in the Callan Athletic Center

The Lady Jackets, under the leadership of fifth-year Head Coach Doug Walters (105-78), enter today's action with a 23-5 record and a #9 ranking in this week's National Christian College Athletic Association (NCCAA) Division I Poll.

Cedarville posted their second consecutive win on Tuesday night with a 3-1 verdict in a Great Midwest Athletic Conference tangle at Ursuline College in Pepper Pike, Ohio.

Notre Dame College, an NCAA II provisional member, is 4-20 on the year including a 3-0 setback to visiting Tiffin on Tuesday.

Outside hitter Hannah Wagner, a 6-2 sophomore, continues to pace the Cedarville offensive efforts with 283 kills and 77 blocks. Wagner, coming off a careerbest 19 kills against Ursuline, has a second-best .284 attack percentage.

Stephanie Rogers, a junior 5-11 middle hitter, leads CU with her .300 attack mark and is second to Wagner



with 245 kills and 74 blocks. Sophomore setter Maddie Anderson has a teamleading 596 assists and 54 service aces. Senior Erica Hannah Wagner

Bartholomew has tallied 401 assists on the year while ranking fourth alltime at CU with 3.859.

Senior Heather Kirkpatrick, one of just five Lady Jacket players to reach 2,000 career digs, leads the CU defense with 411 digs in 2012.

Outside hitter Brianne Schmansky is one of the top offensive threats for NDC. The 5-9 senior leads the Falcons with 222 kills and a .263 attack percentage. Rookie Angela Bush leads with 59 total blocks.

Chandler Mass directs the Falcon attack with 789 assists while leading the squad with 25 service aces. Kelsey Swords has 259 digs while teammate Magenta Tygret is second with 235.



Notre Dame College Head Coach Mark Ridley is in his tenth year (137-197) with the Falcons.

Cedarville owns a commanding 14-1 lead in the all-time series with Notre Dame. The Lady Jackets swept all three matches in 2011 - winning the regular season home and away contests before taking down the Falcons 3-1 in the opening round of the OIC Tournament at Walsh.

Meet Coach Doug Walters



Doug Walters has been the head volleyball coach at Cedarville University since 2008. He is the sixth head coach in the program's history and the first male to serve in the capacity.

The Lady Jackets have posted 82 victories during Walters' four-year tenure. CU finished with a 22-18 mark in 2011 during the school's NCAA Division II provisional year and was the No. 1 seed in the Ohio Independent Championship Tournament.

Walters' first season with the Lady Jackets was a memorable one as he guided the program to its third National Christian College Athletic Association title in four years. He was tabbed the 2008 NCCAA National Coach of the Year.

Cedarville finished with a 27-12 record overall and tied for fourth place out of 15 teams in the American Mideast Conference with a 10-4 mark. The Lady Jackets qualified for the AMC Tournament and advanced to the semifinals.

Cedarville was 15-23 overall in 2009. However, the Lady Jackets were the #2 seed in the AMC Tournament after going 8-4 in the league. CU was 18-20 and 6-4 AMC in 2010 while advancing to the semifinals of the conference tournament.

Walters came to Cedarville after assembling a 128-73 record in nine years of high school coaching in southern Ohio. He spent his last two seasons at the prep level at Milford High School, a Division I program near Cincinnati.

Walters previously spent seven years building Eastern High School in Sardinia into one of the top Division III programs in Ohio. The Warriors, who were ranked in the state's Top 10 in three different seasons, won four conference titles, two sectional championships, and were the district runner-up once. He was a fourtime conference Coach of the Year and saw eight players continue their careers at the collegiate level.

Walters is the founder and former director of the Greater Miami Volleyball Club. The GMVC was started in 2003 and is a Junior Olympic organization that has quickly built a reputation as one of the top regional clubs in Cincinnati.

Walters continues to be involved at the club level. He is the Elevation Volleyball Club 17's National Team Coach based out of Mason, Ohio.

Additionally, Walters is the volleyball chair of the Great Midwest Athletic Conference. He serves as the G-MAC rep to the AVCA Division II Head Coaches Committee and is a member of the AVCA National Poll Committee.

Walters is a 1997 graduate of Northern Kentucky University and he earned his master's degree from the University of Dayton in 2003. Doug and his wife, Angela, reside in Hamersville, Ohio with their daughter Caitlyn, 10.

The Great Midwest Athletic Conference (G-MAC), which was approved by the NCAA Division II Membership Committee in February of 2012 as a member conference effective September 1, 2012, will be working through an educational assessment program with the goal of beginning competition as the 24th active NCAA Division II conference by 2013-14.

The G-MAC features active and reclassifying members from Ohio, Kentucky, Tennessee, Virginia, and West Virginia. Charter members of the G-MAC include Cedarville University, Central State University, Kentucky Wesleyan College, Trevecca Nazarene University, Urbana University and Ursuline College. The G-MAC expanded with the inclusion of Alderson-Broaddus College, Davis & Elkins College, and Ohio Valley University as active DII members in 2012.

The University of Virginia's College at Wise was approved as a Full Member, while Georgetown College was added as a Provisional Member in 2012 as well.

The G-MAC, headquartered in the Indianapolis metro area, will sponsor 12 championships in 2012-13 as a NCAA Division II member conference.
