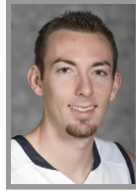


Tonight's Game Preview

The Cedarville University Yellow Jackets host the Wilberforce University Bulldogs in an American Mideast Conference game tonight in the Callan Athletic Center.

Cedarville enters the contest with a record of 15-11 and 10-5 in the AMC. The visiting Jackets romped over Mount Vernon Nazarene 88-59 on Saturday afternoon. Wilberforce is 5-21 on the year with a 3-13 league record. The Bulldogs dropped a 97-50 decision at Notre Dame in South Euclid, Ohio on Saturday.

The Yellow Jacket lineup features four players scoring in double figures. Leading the offensive charge is senior guard Matt Harner - averaging 18.7 points per game with a team-high 89 three-point field goals. He has moved into second all-time at CU with 291 long-distance baskets. Harner tops the squad with a .428 mark from behind the arc and is one of the AMC's best at the charity stripe with an .808 effort.

Sophomore Brian Hecker contributes 11.9 ppg and is CU's second-leading rebounder at 5.1 rpg. The 6-5 forward leads the squad in blocks and is fourth with 28 three-pointers.

Senior point guard Derrick Hannon is hitting 11.1 points per contest and leads the Jackets and the AMC with 129 assists. He has a team-high 46 steals and is the fourth-leading rebounder at 4 per game.

Sophomore guard Austin Foote is also scoring 11.1 points per game including a second-best 39 long-range baskets.

Adam Riehle, a 6-3 senior forward, tops the Yellow Jacket rebounders at 6.3 per game while adding 8.6 points per contest. Riehle is second with a .601 field goal percentage.

Freshman Brian Grant, a 6-8 post player coming off a career-high 21 points at Mount Vernon, adds 5.8 points per game while leading the way with a .639 field goal percentage.

Cedarville is shooting .463 from the field including 222-of-646 attempts from the three-point line for a .344 mark. The team is connecting .624 at the charity stripe on 280-of-449.

Cedarville is outscoring opponents by +3.2 points per game (79.8 to 76.6). The Yellow Jackets are winning the rebounding battle by a slim margin of +1.7.

The Bulldog roster includes five players hitting in double figures this season. Chris Olafioye, a 6-3 junior guard, is tossing in 21.4 points per game and is one of the league's top scorers. He is hitting .464 from the field with a second-best 42 three-pointers.

Another 6-3 junior guard, Darius Foster, adds 14.5 ppg and 5.5 rebounds per contest. He is the Bulldog's second best free throw shooter at .812.

Tim Giles is the third-leading scorer for WU with an 11.4 ppg scoring average. The senior guard paces the team in three-point field goals (43) and is one of the AMC's leaders at the free throw line with an .817 effort.

Wilberforce is scoring 72.9 points per game while allowing 87.8 points per contest. The Bulldogs are hitting .422 from the field but just a .280 from behind the arc. They are hitting .659 at the charity stripe.

The Yellow Jackets lead all-time series with their long-time Greene County rivals by an 59-19 margin. The Jackets captured the matchup earlier in the season on Dec. 7, 2010 at Wilberforce by an 84-56 final. Matt Harner tossed in 19 points with Brian Hecker adding 15. Adam Riehle grabbed a game-high nine boards as CU owned the rebounding stat 53-34.

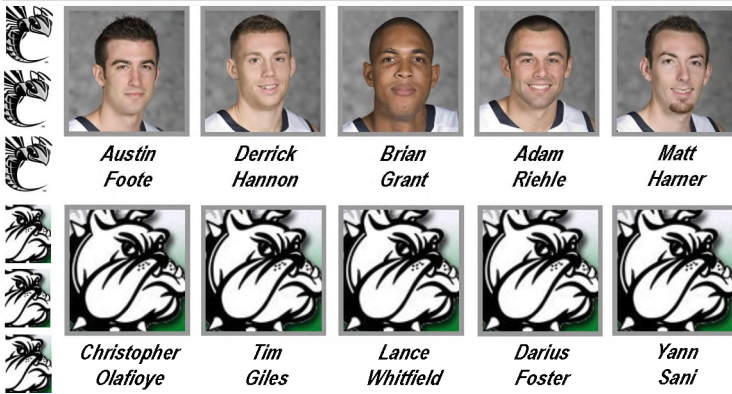

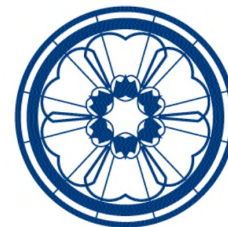

Last Time Out



Cedarville used a 16-point run to take control in the first half and never relinquished the momentum in cruising to an impressive 88-59 American Midwest Conference victory at Mount Vernon Nazarene.

The longtime rivals were locked in what was expected to be a tight contest with the Cougars inching out to a 20-17 margin with 10:55 left in the initial half. Cedarville answered with the decisive run, took the spread out to 18 points by halftime, and inflated the bulge to as much as 32 in the second period.

Brian Grant played his finest game as a Yellow Jacket. He totaled a career-high 21 points to go along with eight rebounds as Cedarville improved to 15-11 overall and 10-5 AMC.

Austin Foote flipped in 20 points while Matt Harner tallied 13. Adam Riehle produced a double-double of 12 points and 11 boards.

The outcome was surprising given that MVNU entered the game 10-1 at home including a perfect 6-0 mark in AMC contests. Cedarville shot 53 percent from the field and dominated the rebounding, 46-26, with the totals including 18 offensive rebounds.

The Cougars dip to 15-13 and 8-8 AMC.

Cedarville heads to Malone University on Thursday, Feb. 17 for a rescheduled contest against the Pioneers. Tip-off is 5:30 p.m.

CU ends the 2010-11 regular season against Notre Dame OH on Saturday, Feb. 19 at 7:30 p.m. in the Callan Athletic Center.

Pending final standings in the AMC, the Yellow Jackets will await word on possible post season action.

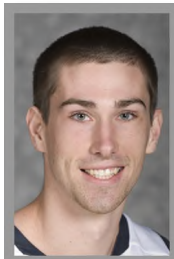

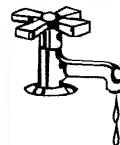

CEDARVILLE, Ohio - Roberts Wesleyan center Alif Bland is the AMC Men's Basketball Player of the Week for Jan. 31 through Feb. 6.

CU's Riehle receives Ron Holmes Award

CEDARVILLE, Ohio - Adam Riehle, a member of the Cedarville University men's basketball team, was presented with the American Midwest Conference's Ron Holmes Award prior to the conference game between Mount Vernon Nazarene University and the Yellow Jackets on Saturday, Feb. 12, 2011

The Ron Holmes Memorial Award is given each year by the AMC in honor of the former MVNU basketball standout who was tragically killed in a car accident prior to his senior season in 1991. Holmes, who is regarded by many as the best player in Cougar basketball history, was just 418 points shy of becoming the program's all-time leading scorer. He still ranks eighth in career points (1,824) and had the second-best career scoring average in school history at 18.2 points per game. He also holds the school records for free throws made and attempted in both a season and a career.

The Ron Holmes Memorial Award was implemented on behalf of the conference coaches to recognize a player who exhibits the same outstanding basketball ability, character, and academic achievements that Holmes did. The recipient is selected following his sophomore or junior season, and the award is presented at a game during the following year.

Walsh remains undefeated and in charge of the top spot

KANSAS CITY, Mo - As the only undefeated team remaining, Walsh (Ohio) owns the top spot for the eighth straight week, announced in the eighth regular-season edition of the NAIA Division II Men's Basketball Coaches' Top 25 poll.

Following Walsh in the poll is No. 2 Northwood (Fla.), No. 3 Cornerstone (Mich.), No. 4 Oklahoma Wesleyan and No. 5 Embry-Riddle (Fla.).

There was one replacement this week. No. 25 Indiana Tech hops in and Bryan (Tenn.) (No. 23) falls out. Indiana Tech has been ranked four previous times, with the most recent coming on Jan. 24.

With a 24-0 start, Walsh earned 15 of the possible 16 first-place votes and 436 total points. The start is the best in school history, only behind the 30-0 beginning during the 1982-83 season, when Bob Huggins was the head coach. On Feb. 5, the Cavs dumped Notre Dame (Ohio), 84-74 to improve to 13-0 in the America Midwest Conference. The competition has not been a challenge for the Cavs. They rank first in the country in both scoring margin (30.6 ppg) and scoring offense (95.1 ppg). Walsh hosts Daemen (N.Y.) on Tuesday, Wilberforce (Ohio) on Thursday before heading out to Roberts Wesleyan (N.Y.) on Saturday.

Second-ranked Northwood posted 422 total points and the remaining first-place vote. The Seahawks have won 15-consecutive games and face Ave Maria (Fla.) on Wednesday in their next contest.

Checking in at No. 3 is Cornerstone with 408 total points. For the third-straight week and sixth overall, Cornerstone is in the third spot. At 23-3 overall, the Golden Eagles tangle with Michigan-Dearborn on Wednesday and Siena Heights (Mich.) on Saturday.

Sliding up four spots is No. 4 Oklahoma Wesleyan with 385 total points. The Eagles grabbed a pivotal conference showdown on Feb. 4 against then-No. 6 Bellevue (Neb.), 83-74. This week, Oklahoma Wesleyan welcomes Haskell Indian Nations (Kan.) on Friday and Ozarks (Mo.) on Saturday.

Embry-Riddle is the second team from The Sun Conference to be in the top-five. The Eagles are 23-3 overall and gathered 369 points this week. On Wednesday, Embry-Riddle plays Florida Memorial and follows that up with a Saturday date at Saint Thomas (Fla.).

Eleven conferences are represented this week, led by the four members from the Mid-Central College Conference (MCC) and Great Plains Athletic Conference (GPAC). The MCC claims No. 6 Indiana Wesleyan, No. 13 Saint Francis (Ind.), No. 17 Grace (Ind.) and No. 19 Huntington (Ind.). These four hail from the GPAC: No. 11 Northwestern (Iowa), No. 16 Briar Cliff (Iowa), No. 18 Sioux Falls (S.D.) and No. 23 Dakota Wesleyan (S.D.). The Cascade Collegiate Conference, Midlands Collegiate Conference and Wolverine-Hoosier Athletic Conference each land a trio of teams.

The poll was voted upon by a panel of head coaches representing each of the conferences and independents. The ninth regular-season Top 25 will be announced on Feb. 14.

NOTES: Through eight regular-season polls, there have been 37 teams ranked overall... The 24 wins by No. 1 Walsh (Ohio) are the most in Division II... Top-ranked Walsh has been ranked in the top-five in each of the last 20 polls, dating back to last season... No. 5 Embry-Riddle (Fla.) holds the most No. 1 rankings since the 2000 season with 17; Oklahoma Wesleyan and Oregon Tech are next with 12 mentions at No. 1... Oregon Tech and Walsh own the Division II active streak for longest run in the Top 25 at 72 straight weeks -- the last time either was not ranked was Jan. 11, 2005... Oklahoma Wesleyan is next in line with 42 consecutive rankings followed by Northwood (Fla.) at 37.
