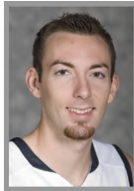


Tonight's Game Preview

The Cedarville Ununiversity Yellow Jackets host the Notre Dame College Falcons tonight in an American Mideast Conference game in the Callan Athletic Center. It is the final regular season contest of the 2010-11 schedule.

Cedarville enters the contest with a record of 17-11 and 12-5 in the AMC. The Yellow Jackets took sole possession of second place in the league with an 89-75 win at Malone on Thursday. Notre Dame is 11-18 on the year with a 6-11 league record. The Falcons posted a 95-88 victory over visiting Point Park on Thursday night.

The Yellow Jacket lineup features four players scoring in double figures. Leading the offensive arsenal is senior guard Matt Harner - averaging 19 points per game with a team-high 96 three-point field goals - just two shy of setting a school record for most three's in a single season. He has moved into second all-time at CU with 298 long-distance baskets. Harner tops the squad with a .427 mark from behind the arc and is one of the AMC's best at the charity stripe with an .831 effort.

Sophomore Brian Hecker contributes 11.8 ppg and is CU's second-leading rebounder at 5.1 rpg. The 6-5 forward is second on the squad in blocks with 14 and is fourth with 30 three-pointers.

Senior point guard Derrick Hannon is hitting 11.3 points per contest and leads the Jackets and the AMC with 137 assists. He has a team-high 50 steals and is the fourth-leading rebounder at 4.2 per game.

Sophomore guard Austin Foote, scoring 10.7 points per game including a second-best 39 long-range baskets, is doubtful for

action in tonight's game due to a shoulder injury suffered on Tuesday against Wilberforce.

Adam Riehle, a 6-3 senior forward, tops the Yellow Jacket rebounders at 6.2 per game while adding 8.1 points per contest. Riehle is second with a .596 field goal percentage.

Brian Grant, a 6-8 post player, continues to make significant contributions. The rookie adds 6.6 points per game while leading the way with a .658 field goal percentage.

Cedarville is shooting .467 from the field including 238-of-689 attempts from the three-point line for a .345 mark. The team is connecting at .634 from the charity stripe on 314-of-495.

Cedarville is outscoring opponents by +3.9 points per game (80.2 to 76.3). The Yellow Jackets are winning the rebounding battle by a margin of +2.6.

The Falcon roster includes one of the league's top all-around players. Eric Dummermuth, a 6-6 junior forward, tosses in 21.2 points per game while bringing in 11.1 rebounds per night. Both marks are second-best stats in the AMC.

Taylor Rieger, a 6-0 rookie guard, is NDC's second-leading scorer at 12.6 ppg. He has a team-leading 99 assists and 60 three-point field goals.

The third Falcon in double figures is senior Curtis McClure. He adds 12.1 ppg to the attack with a team-best 33 steals.

Notre Dame is scoring 76.8 points per game while allowing 74.3 points per contest. The Falcons are hitting .465 from the field and .343 from behind the arc. They are .687 at the charity stripe.

The Yellow Jackets lead all-time series with the Falcons by a 6-0 margin including an 82-80 victory on Feb. 10 in South Euclid. Matt Harner fired in 27 points including 5 three-point FG's. Daniel Kohavi added 12 points and five assists.

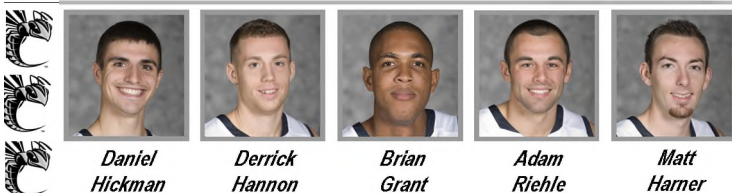

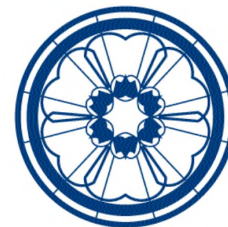

Last Time Out



Matt Harner scored 25 points and Cedarville took over sole possession of second place in the American Mideast Conference with an 89-75 victory at Malone.

The two teams entered the match-up tied for the #2 spot in the league with huge ramifications on the line. The biggest at stake was owning second place with one game to play and the potential of enjoying homecourt advantage through the first two rounds of the playoffs.

The Yellow Jackets, 17-11 overall and 12-5 AMC, never trailed in winning their fourth straight and claiming their seventh win in the past eight games. Harner netted 15 of his points in the first half when CU shot 50 percent from the field to open up a 44-38 margin at the intermission.

The Pioneers got as close as 55-51 with 10:40 left. Cedarville ran off the next nine points and went on to avenge an 81-60 home loss to Malone back on Nov. 30.

Harner made all 11 of his free throws and dished out a game-high five assists. Point guard Derrick Hannon produced a double-double with career-highs of 20 points and 11 rebounds.

Brian Grant continued his ever-improving play with 14 points. Brian Hecker and Daniel Hickman added 11 points apiece.

The Yellow Jackets shot 52 percent from the field and made 23-of-27 free throws including 19-of-22 in the second half. CU had a 40-29 rebound advantage.

Malone drops to 18-11 and 11-6 AMC.

The Yellow Jackets have completed the 2010-11 regular season and have qualified for the American Mideast Conference Tournament which begins on Tuesday, Feb. 22.

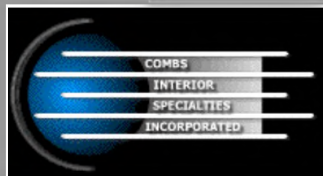

CU's Riehle receives Ron Holmes Award

CEDARVILLE, Ohio - Adam Riehle, a member of the Cedarville University men's basketball team, was presented with the American Midwest Conference's Ron Holmes Award prior to the conference game between Mount Vernon Nazarene University and the Yellow Jackets on Saturday, Feb. 12, 2011

The Ron Holmes Memorial Award is given each year by the AMC in honor of the former MVNU basketball standout who was tragically killed in a car accident prior to his senior season in 1991. Holmes, who is regarded by many as the best player in Cougar basketball history, was just 418 points shy of becoming the program's all-time leading scorer. He still ranks eighth in career points (1,824) and had the second-best career scoring average in school history at 18.2 points per game. He also holds the school records for free throws made and attempted in both a season and a career.

The Ron Holmes Memorial Award was implemented on behalf of the conference coaches to recognize a player who exhibits the same outstanding basketball ability, character, and academic achievements that Holmes did. The recipient is selected following his sophomore or junior season, and the award is presented at a game during the following year.

Two newcomers this season slide into the poll, which include #22 Warner Pacific and #25 South Dakota Mines

KANSAS CITY, Mo - Northwood (Fla.) becomes the new No. 1 in the ninth regular-season edition of the NAIA Division II Men's Basketball Coaches' Top 25 poll. Since the 1991-92 season when NAIA basketball split into two divisions, the Seahawks hold the top ranking for the first time in school history. The slide up to No. 1 was made possible after previously top-ranked and undefeated Walsh (Ohio) lost to unranked Roberts Wesleyan (N.Y.), 72-63 on Feb. 12.

No. 22 Warner Pacific (Ore.) and No. 25 South Dakota Mines (S.D.) both hop in the Top 25 for the first time this season. The Knights have won 10 of their last 11 games, while South Dakota Mines is on a seven-game winning streak. Owners of a 17-game winning streak, Northwood captures the top-ranking with 404 total points. The Seahawks corralled 13 first-place nods. They take their 25-2 record to Palm Beach Atlantic (Fla.) on Monday, followed by two more games at Southeastern (Fla.) and Florida Memorial. Northwood has already wrapped up at least a share of The Sun Conference regular season championship with a 14-0 record.

Despite its first loss, No. 2 Walsh earns two first-place votes and 389 total points. The Cavs had held the No. 1 spot for all eight regular-season Top 25 polls. Walsh ranks either first or second nationally in 10 different statistical categories, including first in scoring offense (94.3 ppg) and first in scoring margin (28.6 ppg).

With 383 total points, Cornerstone (Mich.) holds at the third spot for the fourth-straight time. The Golden Eagles, who are 25-3 on the year, take on Concordia (Mich.) on Wednesday before a showdown with No. 11 Davenport (Mich.) on Saturday. Cornerstone has won eight games in-a-row and leads Davenport by two games for the lead in the Wolverine-Hoosier Athletic Conference.

Oklahoma Wesleyan notched a big 68-63 win against then-No. 20 Ozarks (Mo.) on Feb. 12 to remain in the fourth position. The Eagles earned 367 total points in the Top 25.

Jumping up two positions is No. 5 Black Hills State (S.D.). With 344 total points, the Yellow Jackets enjoy their second top-five ranking this season – they were as high as No. 3 on Jan. 17. Black Hills State holds an overall record of 21-5 and next plays at Minot State (N.D.) on Friday and Dickinson State (N.D.) on Saturday.

Eleven conferences are represented this week, led by the four members from the Cascade Collegiate Conference (CCC), Mid-Central College Conference (MCC) and Great Plains Athletic Conference (GPAC). Coming out of the CCC are No. 8 Oregon Tech, No. 13 Eastern Oregon, No. 18 Northwest (Wash.) and No. 22 Warner Pacific. The MCC claims No. 9 Indiana Wesleyan, No. 14 Saint Francis (Ind.), No. 16 Grace (Ind.) and No. 21 Huntington (Ind.). These four hail from the GPAC: No. 10 Northwestern (Iowa), No. 15 Briar Cliff (Iowa), No. 20 Sioux Falls (S.D.) and No. 23 Dakota Wesleyan (S.D.). The Cascade Collegiate Conference, Midlands Collegiate Conference and Wolverine-Hoosier Athletic Conference each land a trio of teams.

The poll was voted upon by a panel of head coaches representing each of the conferences and independents. The 10th regular-season Top 25 will be announced on Feb. 21.

NOTES: After not being ranked for the first three regular-season polls, No. 10 Northwestern (Iowa) reaches the top-10 for the first time since the 2007-08 season...Through nine regular-season polls, there have been 39 teams ranked overall...The 26 wins by No. 2 Walsh (Ohio) are the most in Division II...Walsh has been ranked in the top-five in each of the last 21 polls, dating back to last season...No. 7 Embry-Riddle (Fla.) holds the most No. 1 rankings since the 2000 season with 17; Oklahoma Wesleyan and Oregon Tech are next with 12 mentions at No. 1...Oregon Tech and Walsh own the Division II active streak for longest run in the Top 25 at 73 straight weeks -- the last time either was not ranked was Jan. 11, 2005.
