

Today's Games

The Cedarville University baseball team hosts the Oakland City University Mighty Oaks in a three-game weekend series at Yellow Jacket Field - a doubleheader on Friday and a single nine-inning game on Saturday. Cedarville is 26-9 on the season after splitting a twin bill on Wednesday at Malone in Canton, Ohio. Oakland City, an NCAA II independent program, is 14-19 including a sixgame winning streak. In their most recent action, the Oaks swept two games at Kentucky State on Tuesday.

Senior shortstop Alex Beelen is CU's top hitter at .411 and a team-high 51 hits. Beelen registered five hits in the games at Malone on Wednesday.

Cedarville's sophomore Cam McWilliams is second on the team hitting at a .402 clip. The speedy center fielder has scored 24 runs while leading the Yellow Jackets with 17 stolen bases.

Rookie third baseman/DH Sam Summerlin has boosted his average to a third-best .377 on 20 hits in 53 at bats.

Junior outfielder Chris Ward is hitting .373 while leading CU in triples (5), runs scored (34) and slugging pct. (.608). He is second with 27 RBI's this year.

Nate Davenport, a 6-4 senior, is batting .348 with a .583 slugging percentage. The first sacker also has impressive numbers in hits (46), doubles (11), triples (4), HR's (4), RBI's (47) and total bases (77).

The Yellow Jacket pitching staff features sophomore David Ledbetter with a sparkling 0.38 ERA - allowing just two earned runs in 47 2/3 innings with a 6-1 record and a team-best 61 K's. Rookie Jordan Ammon also has a 6-1 mark in 41 innings of work.

Oakland City's Eric Barnes, a senior infielder, leads the team with seven doubles, a triple, two HR's and 27 RBI's.

Freshman lefty Trent Benningfield is 4-0 with a 4.86 ERA. He leads the pitching staff with 17 appearances and is second on the team with 22 strikeouts.

The two teams met four times previously this spring. The first game was a 16-1 win for the Jackets in a contest played in Clearwater, Florida. Cedarville swept three games from the Mighty Oaks on March 23-24 by scores of 7-3, 10-8 (9) and 13-4 in Oakland City, Indiana.



Last Time Up - 4/18/12

The Yellow Jackets scored four times in the seventh inning to produce a 5-2 victory at Malone in the first game of a doubleheader on Wednesday afternoon. The Pioneers claimed the nightcap, 5-0.

It wasn't looking good for CU in the opener after a two-out solo homer in the sixth gave the host Pioneers a 2-1 lead. What's more, the Jackets' leadoff hitter was retired in the seventh.

Cam McWilliams reached on an error to start the comeback. Paul Hembekides walked and Alex Beelen singled home the tying run.

Chris Ward's sacrifice fly gave Cedarville the lead. Nate Davenport singled and David Ledbetter followed with a two-run triple to provide a pair of insurance runs.

Beelen was 2-for-3 with two runs scored and an RBI. Hembekides added a double and McWilliams stole a base.

Steve Cardwell, 2-4 was the winning pitcher. Ryan Ledbetter got the final two outs to record his first save.

In game two, Malone broke a scoreless tie by scoring all five of its runs in the sixth inning. A CU error led to three of the tallies being unearned.

Beelen doubled and finished with three of the team's four hits. Sam Summerlin had the other for Cedarville.



Head Coach Mike Manes



Mike Manes (pronounced MAN-us) has been the head baseball coach at Cedarville University since 2008. He has guided the Yellow Jackets to their four winningest seasons in school history and three trips to the NCCAA National Tournament.

Cedarville set a school record for the most victories in a season in 2011 with a 33-18-2 mark and had a best-ever five NCCAA All-Americans on the roster. It was also the first time in more than 30 years that the Yellow Jackets registered

three consecutive winning seasons on the diamond.

CU copped the NCCAA Midwest Region banner for the second time in three years and returned to the NCCAA National Tournament. Manes was named the Region Coach of the Year.

Cedarville posted a 28-27 record in 2010. The Jackets were also the NCCAA Midwest Region runner-up.

Manes was named the 2009 NCCAA Midwest Region Coach of the Year after leading Cedarville to the region title. The Yellow Jackets won over 30 games for the first time in school history with their 32-28 record and split four games at the NCCAA Nationals.

Cedarville was the Midwest Region runner-up in Manes' first season in 2008. The Jackets set a then school record for the most victories in season with 23. They also won eight games in the tough American Mideast Conference which equaled their league win total from the previous three seasons combined.

Manes came to the Yellow Jackets following a four-year stay as head coach at Trinity International University near Chicago. He was able to turn the TIU program around after inheriting a team that won just four games in his first season in 2004 and the school had never qualified for the conference tournament.

Manes then guided the Trojans to 85 victories over the next three seasons by winning 25, 28, and 32 games, respectively, which set school records for the most victories in a season each time. The 2006 squad put together TIU's first-ever winning season and the 2007 team finished 32-22.

In his short tenure, Manes guided the Trojans to their first-ever conference tournament appearance, two NCCAA North Central Region championships, and TIU played in the NCCAA National Tournament in each of his last three seasons. He was tabbed the 2005 NCCAA North Central Region Coach of the Year.

The Nebraska native previously founded and coached the Lincoln Crusaders which is an American Legion baseball club. In his 11 years at the helm, the team made nine trips to the state tournament winning one championship and finishing as the runner-up on two other occasions.

Manes is actively involved in baseball administration. He is currently the NCCAA baseball chair as well as the chair of the Great Midwest Athletic Conference which is the newest NCAA Division II conference.

Manes is a 1989 graduate of Liberty University and he earned a master's degree in 2005 from Almeda University. Mike and his wife, Connie, reside in Springfield and have four married children and five grandchildren.

innings of a 3-2, 11-inning decision over Cincinnati-Clermont. **2010** - Posted a 4-2 record with a 2.95 ERA during his rookie season.....made eight appearances with six starts.....fanned 24 batters and walked 10 in 42 2/3 innings.....totaled a season-high eight

strikeouts in a 4-1 victory against Ohio Christian.






