Weekend Series

The Cedarville University softball team hosts the Ohio Valley University Fighting Scots in a four-game Great Midwest Athletic Conference this weekend at Lady Jacket Field. CU's two seniors, Nicole Davis and Carlyn Hanzel, will be honored between games on Saturday afternoon.

Cedarville enters the action with a record of 22-26 (13-11 G-MAC) after splitting a four-game series at Davis & Elkins on Monday and Tuesday.

Ohio Valley brings an 11-32 (8-14 G-MAC) mark including dropping two games against visiting Davis & Elkins on Sunday, April 17.

Cedarville's Brienne O'Dell, a sophomore infielder/outfielder, leads the team in hitting with a .363 mark including a team-high 58 base hits and 70 total bases.

Rookie catcher Angela Stephano has a second-best .333 hitting mark with 16 hits in 48 at bats including a team-leading two triples and a third-high seven doubles.

Senior third baseman Nicole Davis ranks third with a .336 batting mark while pacing the Lady Jackets in triples (2) and RBI's (29).

Senior pitcher Kristine Brown tops the Fighting Scots with an impressive .405 batting average, 28 RBI's, 62 total bases and a .534 slugging percentage. She is 5-16 in the circle with 98 K's in 136 innings.

Madison Wallace is second in hitting with a .326 mark and is tied with Brown for the lead in base hits with 47.

The Lady Jackets lead the all-time series with OVU by an 8-2 margin including sweeping all three games played last season - on March 20-21 in Cedarville.

ELKINS, W.Va. - Brienne O'Dell led the offense and Morgan Arbogast went the distance in the circle as Cedarville defeated Davis & Elkins, 4-2, in the second game of a G-MAC twinbill.

The Senators won the opener, 9-0, in a contest called in the 5th inning via the 8-run mercy rule.

Cedarville, 22-26 overall and 13-11 G-MAC, split its eight-game, five-day trip to West Virginia.

O'Dell was 3-for-4 in the nightcap with a double, a run scored, and an RBI.

Danielle Wolgamot drilled a solo home run - her team-leading fifth of the season - and scored two runs.

Arbogast, 10-12, allowed two earned runs in seven innings. She struck out three and walked two.

In the opener, the Lady Jackets were only able to come up with three hits - two off the bat of Avary Humes. She also stole two bases.

Head Coach Wes Rowe



Wes Rowe has been the head softball coach at Cedarville University since 2008. He is the school's 10th head coach since the fast-pitch program started in 1985.

Rowe's methodical rebuilding campaign has produced an average of 27.3 victories per year including school-record 35-win efforts in 2012, 2014, and 2015. The Lady Jackets have produced five consecutive winning seasons for the first time in school history.



Cedarville was the Great Midwest Athletic Conference runner-up during the league's first year in 2013 and again in 2015. Rowe guided Cedarville to its second straight NCCAA Midwest Region championship in 2012 and his team has made four national tournament appearances in all - 2011, 2012, 2014, and 2015.

Rowe has coached one NCCAA National Player of the Year, eight NCCAA All-Americans, and 33 All-Region performers. A total of 16 of his players have been recognized as scholar-athletes.

Prior to coming to Cedarville, Rowe was the girls softball varsity assistant coach for one year at Milan High School in Michigan. He served as head coach of the Michigan Dominators 18U travel team for three seasons.

Rowe's 2005 squad won four tournaments while the 2004 team placed 4th out of 44 teams at the USSSA World Series and earned the Sportsmanship Award in voting by all competing teams. His 2003 club finished 5th in the NSA World Series and 7th in the Super World Series.

Rowe was the assistant coach of the Michigan Mustangs 16U team in 2002 that finished as the USSSA World Series runner-up. He previously served as head coach of the Calvary Christian Academy baseball team in Ypsilanti, Mich. for the 2000 campaign.

Rowe is a 1978 graduate of Cedarville College. He was a starting outfielder during his four-year Yellow Jacket baseball career.

Wes and his wife, Ann, reside in Cedarville. All four of their children have graduated from the University including Charissa, who was a four-year outfielder for the Lady Jackets from 2006 through 2009. The Rowes also have two grandchildren.
