to be first in the G-MAC which hopefully means we will be hosting the tournament!

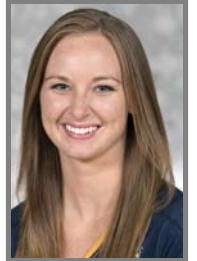
Please be praying for us this week in our studies and for me as I try to work myself back into practices!

Tonight's Match

The Cedarville University women's volleyball team hosts the Central State University Marauders in an Great Midwest Athletic Conference contest tonight in the Callan Athletic Center. Tonight is the final regular season home match of the 2014 schedule.

Cedarville, under the direction of seventh-year Head Coach Doug Walters (153-105), enters tonight's action with a 16-12 record including a league-leading 8-1 tally in the G-MAC.

The Lady Jackets, pre-season favorites to three-peat in the Great Midwest Athletic Conference, can secure the 2014 regular season title with wins tonight and on Friday at Ursuline. CU posted a pair of home league wins last weekend. A 3-0 victory over Trevecca on Friday and a 3-2 come-from-behind win against Kentucky Wesleyan on Saturday.

Central State is 0-13 overall with a 0-9 record in the Great Midwest Athletic Conference. The Marauders dropped matches last weekend versus Kentucky Wesleyan and Trevecca.

Senior Hannah Wagner, a 6-2 outside hitter, leads a balanced CU attack with 248 kills to go with a .259 attack percentage. The reigning G-MAC Volleyball Athlete of the Week is second on the Lady Jackets with 76 blocks. Classmate Amanda Bell has second-best tallies in kills (244) and digs (267).

Sophomore Abby Shelton is third with 235 kills while classmate Angela Becker, a 5-6 libero, paces the back row with 417 digs (4.09/set).

Junior middle hitter Tori Thompson is the fourth Lady Jacket with 200+ kills (214) while topping the team in blocks with 93.

Setters senior Maddie Ledbetter and sophomore Kristin Cardwell direct CU's offense. Ledbetter is the all-time Lady Jacket leader with 272 service aces and ranks fifth with 3,019 career assists. She is just the fifth setter to reach that mark in Cedarville volleyball history. Cardwell has 501 assists, 148 digs and is third with 32 service aces this season.

Central State is led by Head Coach Quiona Boffman who has served in that role for the past two seasons.

Rookie Lakendra Worthy tops the CSU squad with 50 kills and 54 digs.

Setters Regine Harris and Brein Babbs direct the Marauder offense.

Cedarville holds a 67-11 advantage in the all-time series with their G-MAC Greene County rivals including a 3-0 sweep on Oct. 7 in Wilberforce, Ohio.

Teresa Clark is also the Assistant Chair of the Dept. of Kinesiology & Allied Health and is the Faculty Athletic Representative for Cedarville. Coach Clark previously served as the Head Women's Volleyball Coach from 1996-2005. She accumulated 322 wins during that time which is the most all-time at Cedarville University. She is married to Assistant Sports Information Director, Jim Clark, and together they have two children and three grandchildren.

Meet Coach Doug Walters



Doug Walters has been the head volleyball coach at Cedarville University since 2008. He is the sixth head coach in the program's history and the first male to serve in the capacity.

The Lady Jackets have posted 137 victories during Walters' six-year tenure. The list of honors includes the 2008 NCCAA championship as well as back-to-back Great Midwest Athletic Conference crowns in 2012 and 2013.

During the school's first active season in NCAA Division II in 2012, his squad rolled to a 32-6 overall mark and was a perfect 8-0 in the G-MAC. Cedarville went on to win the inaugural G-MAC Tournament and Walters was ultimately voted the league's Coach of the Year.

The Jackets, who finished 23-14 overall in 2013, repeated the feat after sharing the league's best regular season record at 12-2. They went on the road to claim their second straight G-MAC Tournament trophy.

Walters' first season with the Lady Jackets in 2008 was a memorable one as he guided the program to its third National Christian College Athletic Association title in four years. He was tabbed the NCCAA National Coach of the Year.

Cedarville finished with a 27-12 record overall that season and tied for fourth place out of 15 teams in the American Midwest Conference with a 10-4 mark. The Lady Jackets qualified for the AMC Tournament and advanced to the semifinals.

CU was 15-23 overall in 2009. However, the Lady Jackets were the #2 seed in the AMC Tournament after going 8-4 in the league. The Jackets were 18-20 and 6-4 AMC in 2010 while advancing to the semifinals of the conference tournament.

Cedarville finished with a 22-18 mark in 2011 during the school's NCAA provisional year and was the No. 1 seed in the Ohio Independent Championship Tournament.

Walters came to Cedarville after assembling a 128-73 record in nine years of high school coaching in southern Ohio. He spent his last two seasons at the prep level at Milford High School, a Division I program near Cincinnati.

Walters previously spent seven years building Eastern High School in Sardinia into one of the top Division III programs in Ohio. The Warriors, who were ranked in the state's Top 10 in three different seasons, won four conference titles, two sectional championships, and were the district runner-up once. He was a four-time conference Coach of the Year and saw eight players continue their careers at the collegiate level.

Walters is the founder and former director of the Greater Miami Volleyball Club. The GMVC was started in 2003 and is a Junior Olympic organization that has quickly built a reputation as one of the top regional clubs in Cincinnati.

Walters continues to be involved at the club level. He is a National Team Coach for the Elevation Volleyball Club based out of Mason, Ohio.

Additionally, Walters is the volleyball chair of the Great Midwest Athletic Conference. He serves as the G-MAC rep to the AVCA Division II Head Coaches Committee and is a member of the AVCA National Poll Committee.

Walters is a 1997 graduate of Northern Kentucky University and he earned his master's degree from the University of Dayton in 2003. Doug and his wife, Angela, reside in Morrow, Ohio with their daughter Caitlyn, 12.

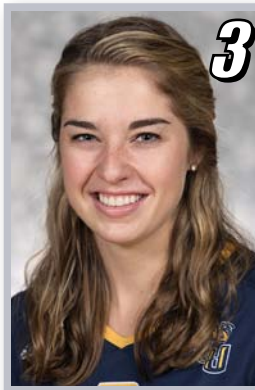

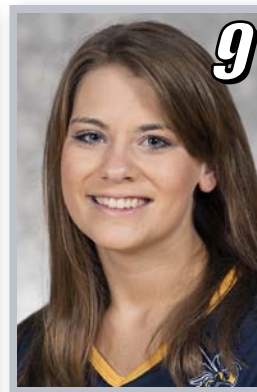

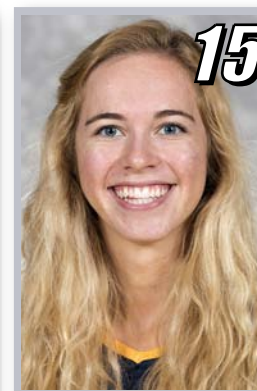
