



Today's Game

The Cedarville University softball team hosts the University of Indianapolis Greyhounds in a single-game today at Lady Jacket Field. The meeting between the two schools was originally slated as a twinbill but had to be reduced to a single game due to Indianapolis unexpectedly reaching the maximum amount of regular season games played in 2011-12. Cedarville, with a record of 29-18, posted a pair of victories over visiting Salem International on Saturday afternoon. The Greyhounds, NCAA II members of the Great Lakes Valley Conference (GLVC), are 44-7 and ranked #2 in the April 18th national poll but have dropped five of their last seven games including a league split with visiting Bellarmine on Sunday. Today's game features two of the best all-around hitters in NCAA II - Cedarville's Kelsey Wilson and Indianapolis' Casey Williamson.

Cedarville's Kelsey Wilson is the second-leading hitter in NCAA Division II. The sophomore outfielder/infielder is bating .543 with a team-leading 82 base hits, 46 runs scored, 14 doubles, five triples, 4 HR's, 43 RBI's, 118 total bases, a .781 slugging pct. and 31 stolen bases. Wilson broke the school record for most hits in a single season (75) when she singled in the second game at Northern Kentucky last week.



Junior Kenleigh Ludlow is second on the batting charts with a .363 mark. She is second on the squad with 49 hits Kelsey Wilson while also ranking second with 17 stolen bases.

Sophomore Shelby Young is the third-best hitter on the squad. The outfielder is hitting .327 with 48 base hits and six doubles while ranking second to Wilson in runs batted in with 33.

Sophomore Kelsey Warrington is tied with Wilson for the team lead in home runs while ranking third in runs batted in (30). She is second on the team in doubles (13) and total bases (68). Warrington is tied for first in the CU all-time home run category with nine.

Freshman hurler Cecelia DeBartolo paces the Lady Jacket pitching corps with a 14-8 record. She has a team-high 104 strikeouts in 126 1/3 innings with a staff-best 2.33 earned run average.

The Greyhounds are led by freshman outfielder Casey Williamson with a .465 batting mark, 18 doubles, five triples, seven home runs, 53 runs scored, 48 RBI's and 122 total bases for a .777 slugging pct. Williamson also tops Indy with 33 stolen bases in 34 attempts.

Rookie Samantha Krcelich is having an outstanding first season with 12 doubles, seven HR's, 42 runs batted in and 84 total bases.



Indianapolis is led by two stellar arms in the circle. Junior Jennifer DeMotte with a 29-5 record, a 0.98 ERA Casey Williamson and 220 strikeouts in 213 1/3 innings of work. Classmate Audry Ernst is 15-2 with a 1.77 earned run average.

Today's contest is the first-ever meeting between the two schools on the softball field.



Last Time Up

Kelsey Wilson had another big day including a game-winning home run to pace Cedarville to a doubleheader sweep of visiting Salem International on Saturday afternoon.

Wilson hammered a two-run homer with one out in the bottom of the seventh inning to win game one, 6-5. Rachel Bull walked, Kenleigh Ludlow sacrificed her to second, and Wilson unloaded her fourth bomb of the year to left center.

Missy Murphy, Jessica Palm, and Courtney Teague all joined Wilson with two hits each. Cecelia DeBartolo got the pitching victory in relief.

The Lady Jackets won the nightcap 11-3 in six innings by the eight-run mercy rule. Wilson singled, doubled, and tripled to go along with two

Kelsey Warrington was 3-for-4 with two RBI's and two runs scored for Cedarville, who improved to 13-2 at home and 29-18 overall. Palm added two hits and three RBI's.

DeBartolo pushed her record in the circle to 14-8. She tossed her 14th complete game.



Head Coach Wes Rowe



Wes Rowe has been the head softball coach at Cedarville University since 2008. He is the school's 10th head coach since the fast-pitch program started in 1985.

Rowe's methodical rebuilding campaign has produced 87 victories thus far including a school-record 32 wins in 2011. He guided the Lady Jackets to their second NCCAA Midwest Region championship last spring and their seventh national tournament appearance.

Rowe took a young Lady Jacket squad and won 18 games during his inaugural campaign followed by 16 wins and then 21. He coached his three NCCAA All-Americans and has had eight scholar-athletes.

Prior to assuming his current position, Rowe was the girls softball varsity assistant coach for one year at Milan High School in Michigan. He served as head coach of the Michigan Dominators 18U travel team for three seasons.

Rowe's 2005 squad won four tournaments while the 2004 team placed 4th out of 44 teams at the USSSA World Series and earned the Sportsmanship Award in voting by all competing teams. His 2003 club finished 5th in the NSA World Series and 7th in the Super World Series.

Rowe was the assistant coach of the Michigan Mustangs 16U team in 2002 that finished as the USSSA World Series runner-up. He previously served as head coach of the Calvary Christian Academy baseball team in Ypsilanti, Mich. for the 2000 campaign.


Rowe is a 1978 graduate of Cedarville College. He was a starting outfielder during his four-year Yellow Jacket baseball career.

Wes and his wife, Ann, reside in Cedarville. They have had three of their children graduate from the University including Charissa, who was a four-year outfielder for the Lady Jackets from 2006 through 2009. Their son, Sam, is a senior at the University.


