### Tonight's Game Preview

Kayla Jenerette's Weekly Blog

The Cedarville University Lady Jackets host the Ursuline College Arrows tonight in a Great Midwest Athletic Conference game in the Callan Athletic Center. Tonight is also the annual Play 4Kay Game which promotes raising funds for breast cancer research.

Cedarville, with a 14-8 record (10-2 G-MAC), has won eight consecutive games including their most recent action - an 84-52 league win at Salem International on Tuesday, Feb. 18.

Ursuline, 12-10 overall with a 7-5 mark in the G-MAC, has won three straight including a 98-81 non-conference decision over visiting Wilberforce on Saturday, Feb. 15.

Head Coach Kirk Martin, in his 13th year with the Cedarville program, is 327-94 (.777). He has posted 11 20-win seasons with the Lady Jackets.

Cedarville is averaging 76.5 points per game while allowing opponents 70.8 points per outing. The Lady Jackets lead the G-MAC in FG pct. (.468), FT pct. (.743) and assists per game (18).

Senior Kayla Jenerette is one of four players hitting in double-digits for CU. The 5-4 guard continues to lead Cedarville with a 15.5 ppg scoring average. Jenerette, with a fourth-best career .802 mark at the free throw line, is 61-of-77 this year for a .792 effort. She paces the team with 55 three-point field goals and ranks second all-time with 247 long-range shots. Jenerette, with 1,739 career points, is just 20 points away from moving into #6 all-time at Cedarville.

Kaya Linkous, a 5-10 sophomore forward, is Cedarville's second-leading scorer at 11.7 ppg and rebounder at 5.9 boards per game. She leads the league in field goal percentage at .596.

Junior guard Raegan Ryan is the team's thirdleading scorer at 11.5 points per contest. She paces the squad in assists (106) and steals (30). Ryan has hit a second-best 34 field goals from behind the arc. She tops the G-MAC with five assists per game and is coming off a career-high 11 assists in the win at Salem International.

The fourth Lady Jacket in double digits is junior Deborah Gordon. The 5-11 forward is adding 10.2 points per game while leading CU in rebounding with 6.4 boards per contest.


Kaysie Brittenham, a 5-9 sophomore guard and the reigning G-MAC Player of the Week, is averaging 8.1 points per game while hitting a second-best 35 three-point field goals with a .455 effort (35-77) - second-highest in the G-MAC.

Ursuline is under the direction of second-year Head Coach Shannon Sword (16-32, .333). She came to Ursuline following a stint as an assistant at NCAA II power Ashland University.

UC is scoring 76.2 points per game while allowing opponents 72.9 points per contest. The Arrows are hitting .423 from the field including a .307 effort from behind the arc.

The offensive attack of the Arrows is led by Emma Ricketts with 14.6 points per game - thirdbest in the G-MAC. The 6-0 junior also paces Ursuline with 6.7 rebounds per contest.



### **Last Time Out**



SALEM, W.Va. - The beat goes on for Cedarville women's basketball. Kayla Linkous paced four players in double figures with 17 points and the Lady Jackets extended their winning streak to eight in a row with an 84-52 Great Midwest Athletic Conference win at Salem International on Tuesday night.

All 10 players in uniform scored, grabbed at least one rebound, and dished out at least one assist, thus, epitomizing the phrase "team effort."

Cedarville led 39-26 by halftime and the margin ballooned to 30 midway through the second half. The Lady Jackets finished 5-0 on their road swing and have won 11 of their last 12 games.

Cedarville canned a season-high 13 three-pointers and shot 52 percent outside the arc. The Jackets were good on 52 percent of their shots overall and converted 11-of-12 free throws.

Linkous made all six of her shots from the field, went 5-for-6 at the line, and hauled in a game-high seven rebounds. Whitney Robinson buried 4of-5 three pointers and totaled a career-high 12 points.

Kaysie Brittenham and Kayla Jenerette tallied 12 points apiece. Raegan Ryan handed out a career-high 11 assists.

Coach Martin summarized the effort, "It took a while to get rolling, but once the shots started falling we played well at both ends. Whitney (Robinson) hit a couple big threes early which we badly needed and Raegan (Ryan) focused hard on being an assist machine. I do love how well we are shooting the ball right now."

### Looking Ahead



Next week, the Lady Jackets make the short trip to Central State University for a 7 p.m. Great Midwest Athletic Conference contest with the Marauders on Tuesday, Feb. 25.

One week from tonight, Thursday, Feb. 27 Cedarville will host Ohio Valley University for a 5:30 p.m. encounter against the Fighting Scots.

CU closes out the 2013-14 regular season by hosting Salem International University on Saturday, Mar. 1. The contest with the Tigers is slated for a 2:00 p.m. start.

The G-MAC Tournament takes place March 6-8 at the #1 seed.



### Head Coach Kirk Martin

Kirk Martin has been the head women's basketball coach at Cedarville University since the 2001-02 season. After building the Lady Jackets into one of the top NAIA programs in the country, he has guided them to a successful transition in NCAA Division II.

Martin's teams have averaged 26 wins per season during his tenure. CU has amassed one NCCAA title, two NAIA Division II national runner-up finishes, and six conference championships.



Prior to Martin's arrival, the Lady Jackets had won 20 games in a season twice. He has accomplished the feat 11 times including back-to-back 35-win campaigns in 2004 and 2005.

Cedarville was 20-10 last winter in its first active NCAA season and posted a 24-8 mark during its NCAA provisional year in 2011-12. The Jackets captured the NCCAA Midwest Region banner each year, were the 2012 NCCAA runner-up, and also claimed the 2012 Ohio Independent Championship.

CU made its eighth and final appearance at the 2011 NAIA Division II National Tournament which featured a surprising run to the quarterfinals. The Lady Jackets knocked off perennial powers Saint Francis (Ind.) and Ozarks before losing to unbeaten Davenport to finish the season 24-10.

Martin guided Cedarville to five straight NAIA national tournament appearances from 2003 through 2007 including back-to-back runner-up finishes in 2004 and 2005. The Jackets ended up with a 17-8 record at the event with a semifinals achievement in 2007, quarterfinals efforts in 2006 and 2011, and two second round showings.

Martin's club owned American Mideast Conference titles from 2003 through 2007 assembling an 86-4 record during that timespan. CU ran off three straight undefeated league campaigns in the AMC South Division from 2004 through 2006 which included a conference-record 72-game winning streak.

Martin was able to lead a young Lady Jacket squad to a strong finish and the NCCAA national title in 2008. He was named the NCCAA National Coach of the Year.

Martin took over the coaching reigns at his alma mater in 2001-02 and promptly guided Cedarville to a 23-10 record - at the time a school record for the most wins in a single season. The Jackets posted a 15-5 mark to finish fourth in the 19-team AMC. They were the only league school to beat the top three teams in the standings and all three were ranked in the NAIA Division II Top 25.

Martin came to Cedarville after developing Southeastern High School into one of Ohio's elite Division IV girls' basketball programs. He brought with him an impressive list of credentials produced at a school where he was employed since graduating from Cedarville College in 1976. He earned his master's degree in Educational Administration from the University of Dayton in 1982.

Martin coached Southeastern, located just eight miles away in South Charleston, Ohio, to a 297-34 record for a .897 winning percentage during a coaching career that spanned 1986-97 and 1999-2001. He led the Trojans to the Ohio Division IV state championship in 1996, one state runner-up finish, and to 11 Kenton Trace Conference championships including ten straight. Southeastern assembled a 162-game KTC winning streak, won all 11 district title games they ever played in, and advanced to the Division IV Sweet 16 in 11 of his last 12 years.

Martin never had a losing season at Southeastern and earned numerous honors for his team's accomplishments. He was tabbed state Coach of the Year in 1989, was twice named Southwest District Coach of the Year, was a four-time District 9 Coach of the Year, and was a sixtime Clark County Coach of the Year. He was inducted into the Cedarville University Athletic Hall of Fame in 1998 for his coaching accomplishments.

Kirk and his wife, Vicki, reside in Springfield. The Martins have three married children, who along with their spouses are all CU graduates, and five grandchildren.

Kaysie Brittenham has been named the G-MAC Women's Basketball Athlete of the Week for the first time this season

after helping her team to two important G-MAC wins last week. Brittenham led the team in scoring in wins over Kentucky Wesleyan and against Trevecca Nazarene on the road.

In the weekend's first game, Brittenham tied teammate Kayla Jenerette for the team lead in scoring with 18 points, going 8-12 from the field. She added three assists and a rebound. In the seasons most important game against TNU, Brittenham once again paced the team in scoring, putting up 20 points on 7-11 shooting, including going 5-7 from long range. She added two rebounds, an assist, and a steal.

The two wins extend Cedarville's winning streak to seven-straight. They also handed TNU its second conference loss, bringing the two teams into a tie in the loss column. Cedarville holds the advantage, winning both meetings with TNU on the season. If Cedarville can win out, they would secure the regular-season championship and the right to host the G-MAC Championship Tournament.

Coming into last week, Brittenham was averaging only 6.7 points per game, but posted 19 points per game in her two games. She has now led the team in scoring in three games this season, all G-MAC contests.




