"I am aware that Cedarville played a Sunday afternoon game against Alderson Broaddus this past weekend, almost exactly a year following (April 12, 2015) the twin-bill against Davis & Elkins. Is this Cedarville's first steps toward shedding the "Christian" aspect of the university, as many universities so recently have?" - (A Concerned Alumni)

No, Cedarville is as committed to its' faith as the University has ever been. Both instances, the April 12th doubleheader and the games played this past weekend, were a result of poor weather conditions combined with an inability to re-work our schedule. Both Davis & Elkins and Alderson Broaddus are located in West Virginia, roughly five hours away from Cedarville, which adds to the difficulty in rescheduling the contests. The Davis & Elkins games last season were moved to Sunday because we were already in West Virginia, and unable to reschedule the games for any other date on the schedule that coordinated with both teams.

Similarly, Alderson Broaddus, along with ourselves, have packed schedules through the remainder of the season leading to the reasonable conclusion that make-up games are highly unlikely. On both occasions, Coach Manes has requested and been granted approval from both the Athletic Department and from the University itself to play these games. While playing on Sundays is not ideal for the University, some accommodations must be made in order to reconcile poor weather conditions for outdoor sporting events. Also, in both instances, our coaching staff has invited the opposing team to join us in church to worship along side us and to share the gospel. All Sunday games are played in the afternoons and evenings to

avoid any church conflict for both players and coaches from both sides of the diamond.

Weekend Series

The Cedarville University baseball team hosts the Ohio Valley University Fighting Scots in a four-game Great Midwest Athletic Conference series this weekend.

Cedarville enters the weekend with a 10-21 mark (3-7 G-MAC) including a 7-3 verdict over visting Miami-Hamilton on Tuesday. Ohio Valley brings a 9-28 record (3-9 G-MAC) into Yellow Jacket Field including a 12-4 win at Ohio-Lancaster on Tuesday.

Senior outfielder David Lenhardt leads the Jackets with a .359 batting average including team-highs of nine doubles, two HR's, 23 runs and a .521 slugging percentage. Junior third baseman Drew Johnson is second on the club with a .358 batting average. He tops CU with 44 hits, two triples and 59 total bases.



Sophomore outfielder Colton Potter is batting a *David Lenhardt* third-best .340 with a team-high 25 runs batted in.


Senior right-hander Garrett Baker, the current G-MAC Pitcher of the Week, is 2-2 with a 3.82 earned run average in 33 innings of action. Senior reliever Connor Hamilton is tied for the all-time lead in appearances with 56 while posting two saves this year.

Last Time Up • 4/19/16

CEDARVILLE, Ohio - Colton Potter stroked three hits and winning pitcher Brent Solinger notched his first collegiate victory in a 7-3 non-conference result over Miami-Hamilton.

Solinger allowed three earned runs on six hits in six innings. He struck out four and walked two.

David Bancroft allowed just one hit in two innings of relief and Jordan Adams tossed a scoreless 9th.

The Yellow Jackets, 10-21, took control with four runs in the 4th inning.

Potter went 3-for-4 with a double, two runs scored, and two RBI's to lead CU's 12-hit attack.

Drew Johnson had two hits with a double. Ross Melchior and Gunnar Stinson added two hits apiece.





Head Coach Mike Manes



Mike Manes (pronounced MAN-us) has been the head baseball coach at Cedarville University since 2008. He has guided the Yellow Jackets to the seven winningest seasons in school history and six trips to the NCCAA National Tournament.

Manes has won more games than any previous baseball coach that CU has ever had averaging nearly 30 victories per season. The Jackets have claimed four NCCAA Midwest Region banners during his tenure.

Three of Manes' players have advanced to the professional ranks including righthanded pitcher David Ledbetter, who was a 3rd round choice by the Texas Rangers and 99th pick overall in the 2013 MLB First-Year Player Draft.

The Yellow Jackets were 31-27 in 2014 while winning 10 of their last 15 games. They were the Great Midwest Athletic Conference runner-up and advanced to the NCCAA National Semifinals.

Cedarville posted a 29-19 mark in 2013. The Jackets claimed their third straight NCCAA Midwest Region title and returned to the national tournament.

CU set the school record for the most victories in a season in 2012 with a 38-13 record. The Yellow Jackets won their third NCCAA Midwest Region banner in the past four years and advanced to the national tournament as the No. 1 seed.

Cedarville was 33-18-2 in 2011 and had a best-ever five NCCAA All-Americans on the roster. The Jackets copped the NCCAA Midwest Region banner for the second time in three years and returned to the NCCAA National Tournament. Manes was named the Region Coach of the Year.

Cedarville finished with a 28-27 record in 2010. The Jackets were also the NCCAA Midwest Region runner-up.

Manes was named the 2009 NCCAA Midwest Region Coach of the Year after leading Cedarville to the region title. The Yellow Jackets won over 30 games for the first time in school history with their 32-28 record and split four games at the NCCAA Nationals.

Cedarville was the Midwest Region runner-up in Manes' first season in 2008. The Jackets set a then school record for the most victories in season with 23. They also won eight games in the tough American Mideast Conference which equaled their league win total from the previous three seasons combined.

Manes came to the Yellow Jackets following a four-year stay as head coach at Trinity International University near Chicago. He was able to turn the TIU program around after inheriting a team that won just four games in his first season in 2004 and the school had never qualified for the conference tournament.

Manes then guided the Trojans to 85 victories over the next three seasons by winning 25, 28, and 32 games, respectively, which set school records for the most victories in a season each time. The 2006 squad put together TIU's first-ever winning season and the 2007 team finished 32-22.

In his short tenure, Manes guided the Trojans to their first-ever conference tournament appearance, two NCCAA North Central Region championships, and TIU played in the NCCAA National Tournament in each of his last three seasons. He was tabbed the 2005 NCCAA North Central Region Coach of the Year.

The Nebraska native previously founded and coached the Lincoln Crusaders which is an American Legion baseball club. In his 11 years at the helm, the team made nine trips to the state tournament winning one championship and finishing as the runner-up on two other occasions.

Manes is actively involved in baseball administration. He is currently the NCCAA baseball chair as well as the chair of the new Great Midwest Athletic Conference.

Manes is a 1989 graduate of Liberty University and he earned a master's degree in 2005 from Almeda University. Mike and his wife, Connie, reside in Springfield and have four married children and 12 grandchildren.


