
Christina Kirkpatrick's Softball Blog

Kelsey (Warrington) Chapman is in her final season with the Lady Jacket softball team.....started all 45 contests she appeared in last spring.....produced a fifth-best .281 batting

average.....led team with 38 runs batted in - tied for sixth all-time in a single season.....tied for a team-best three HR's.....added four doubles and two triples....ranked fourth with 56 total bases...registered a fifth-highest .403 slugging percentage.....went 3-for-3 with a triple, three runs and an RBI in the home opening 18-1 win over Minnesota-Crookston....tallied a 3-for-4 outing including three runs batted in and a run scored in a 14-1 win over visiting Wheeling Jesuit.....paced squad with 12 multiple-RBI games.....career leader in home runs at CU with 12 and is tied for the top spot with 39 doubles....ranks second all-time with 56 extra base hits and 103 RBI's....fourth-best with 221 career total bases and is sixth all-time with a .474 slugging percentage.....tied for first all-time at Cedarville with eight sacrifice flies.....member of the National Christian College Athletic Association (NCCAA) Midwest Region Team....NCCAA Scholar-Athlete.....Great Midwest Athletic Conference (G-MAC) Academic Team.

Courtnie Spain returns for her third season with the Lady Jacket softball team....led pitching staff in wins (9), appearances (26), innings pitched (121), strikeouts (132), ERA

(2.89) and saves (2).....twice registered season-high 10 strikeouts - a 2-0 complete game one-hitter over Felician during the annual spring break trip to Florida and a 12-5 decision against visiting Ursuline in a Great Midwest Athletic Conference (G-MAC) contest.....topped the G-MAC in innings pitched and was second in strikeouts.....ranked 29th in NCAA Division II strikeouts per seven innings with 7.6.....132 K's in 2013 rank eighth all-time for a single season at Cedarville.....leads CU all-time with four saves, is third all-time with 24 relief appearances and is fourth all-time with 243 strikeouts.....also holds spots in Top 10 all-time in appearances and winning percentage........
