Tonight's Game Preview

The Cedarville University Lady Jackets host the Ohio Valley University Fighting Scots tonight in a Great Midwest Athletic Conference game in the Callan Athletic Center.

Cedarville, with a 15-9 record (11-3 G-MAC), had their nine-game winning streak snapped on Tuesday with an 80-71 league loss at Central State.

Ohio Valley, 8-16 overall with a 5-9 mark in the G-MAC, dropped their most recent game - a 74-53 conference setback to visiting Davis & Elkins.

Head Coach Kirk Martin, in his 13th year with the Cedarville program, is 328-95 (.775). He has posted eleven 20-win seasons with the Lady Jackets.

Cedarville is averaging 76.4 points per game while allowing opponents 71 points per outing. The Lady Jackets lead the G-MAC in FG pct. (.464), three-point FG pct. (.373) and assists per game (18.1).

Senior Kayla Jenerette is one of four players hitting in double-digits for CU. The 5-4 guard continues to lead Cedarville with a 15.1 ppg scoring average. Jenerette, with a fourth-best career .799 mark at the free throw line, is 63-of-81 this year for a .778 effort. She paces the team with 58 three-point field goals and ranks second all-time with 250 long-range shots. Jenerette, with 1,760 career points, is tied for #5 all-time at Cedarville.

Kaya Linkous, a 5-10 sophomore forward, is Cedarville's second-leading scorer at 11.9 ppg and rebounder at 5.9 boards per game. She leads the league in field goal percentage at .579 - sixth-best all-time in a single-season at CU.

Junior guard Raegan Ryan is the team's third-leading scorer at 11.7 points per contest. She paces the squad in assists (122) and steals (39). Ryan has hit a second-best 37 field goals from behind the arc. She tops the G-MAC with 5.3 assists per game and has dished out 27 assists in her last three contests.

The fourth Lady Jacket in double digits is junior Deborah Gordon. The 5-11 forward is adding 10.3 points per game while leading CU in rebounding with 6.4 boards per contest.

Kaysie Brittenham, a 5-8 sophomore guard, is averaging 7.8 points per game while hitting a second-best 38 three-point field goals with a .432 effort (38-88) - second-highest in the G-MAC.

Ohio Valley is under the direction of fourth-year Head Coach David Wadlington (35-72, .327).

OVU is scoring 66.2 points per game while allowing opponents 73.9 points per contest. The Fighting Scots are hitting .355 from the field including a .214 mark from behind the arc - both efforts rank at the bottom of the G-MAC.

The Fighting Scots will be led by Saira House with 10.6 points per game, 76 assists and 45 steals. The 5-6 senior guard, a transfer from the University of Findlay, played her high school basketball at Kenton Ridge in Springfield, Ohio.

Kayla Parsley, a 6-1 senior forward, tops OVU and the G-MAC with 9.2 rebounds per game.

Meghan Miller, a 5-8 rookie guard, leads the Fighting Scots with 27 three-point field goals.

Cedarville won the only other previous meeting with the Fighting Scots - an 89-63 decision earlier this season on January 23 in Vienna, West Virginia.

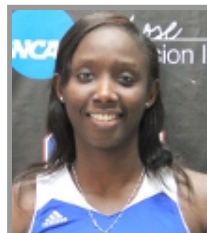

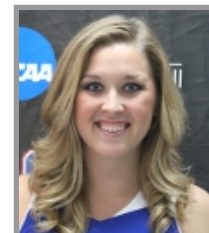

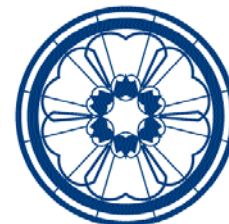

Last Time Out



Central State never trailed in winning just its second Great Midwest Athletic Conference game of the season, 80-71, over Cedarville at Beacom-Lewis Gymnasium on Tuesday night.

It's doubtful many basketball people saw this coming. The Lady Jackets had won nine straight, 12 of their last 13, and were unbeaten on the road in the G-MAC. The host Marauders, on the other hand, had dropped eight in a row.

For the most part, Central State was in charge from the opening tip. Once CU tied the game, 2-2, the Marauders took the lead for good and methodically built it to as much as 14 points in the first half. It was 42-33 at the break.

CSU scored the first eight points of the second period and eventually had its largest lead of 57-38 at the 13:17 mark. However, an 18-4 run over the next four minutes quickly got the Jackets within five.

It was still a five-point spread, 64-59, with 8:07 left when the Marauders made a decisive move. They netted seven consecutive points to push the difference out to 12 and CU never recovered.

Kayla Linkous finished with 19 points for the Lady Jackets while Raegan Ryan totaled 17 points and eight assists. Deborah Gordon and Danielle Spiliotis chipped in 10 points apiece.

Cedarville was in line to host the G-MAC Tournament on March 6-8 with a sweep of its three remaining games. Now, the Jackets must win the last two and hope that Ursuline wins at league leader Trevecca Nazarene on Saturday.

Looking Ahead



Cedarville closes out the 2013-14 regular season by hosting Salem International University on Saturday, Mar. 1. The contest with the Tigers is slated for a 2:00 p.m. start. It is "Senior Day" and the Lady Jackets will be honoring their six seniors.

The G-MAC Tournament takes place March 6-8 at the #1 seed. The host is still to be determined pending results of games to be played this Saturday.

Head Coach Kirk Martin

Kirk Martin has been the head women's basketball coach at Cedarville University since the 2001-02 season. After building the Lady Jackets into one of the top NAIA programs in the country, he has guided them to a successful transition in NCAA Division II.

Martin's teams have averaged 26 wins per season during his tenure. CU has amassed one NCCAA title, two NAIA Division II national runner-up finishes, and six conference championships.

Prior to Martin's arrival, the Lady Jackets had won 20 games in a season twice. He has accomplished the feat 11 times including back-to-back 35-win campaigns in 2004 and 2005.

Cedarville was 20-10 last winter in its first active NCAA season and posted a 24-8 mark during its NCAA provisional year in 2011-12. The Jackets captured the NCCAA Midwest Region banner each year, were the 2012 NCCAA runner-up, and also claimed the 2012 Ohio Independent Championship.

CU made its eighth and final appearance at the 2011 NAIA Division II National Tournament which featured a surprising run to the quarterfinals. The Lady Jackets knocked off perennial powers Saint Francis (Ind.) and Ozarks before losing to unbeaten Davenport to finish the season 24-10.

Martin guided Cedarville to five straight NAIA national tournament appearances from 2003 through 2007 including back-to-back runner-up finishes in 2004 and 2005. The Jackets ended up with a 17-8 record at the event with a semifinals achievement in 2007, quarterfinals efforts in 2006 and 2011, and two second round showings.

Martin's club owned American Midwest Conference titles from 2003 through 2007 assembling an 86-4 record during that timespan. CU ran off three straight undefeated league campaigns in the AMC South Division from 2004 through 2006 which included a conference-record 72-game winning streak.

Martin was able to lead a young Lady Jacket squad to a strong finish and the NCCAA national title in 2008. He was named the NCCAA National Coach of the Year.

Martin took over the coaching reigns at his alma mater in 2001-02 and promptly guided Cedarville to a 23-10 record - at the time a school record for the most wins in a single season. The Jackets posted a 15-5 mark to finish fourth in the 19-team AMC. They were the only league school to beat the top three teams in the standings and all three were ranked in the NAIA Division II Top 25.

Martin came to Cedarville after developing Southeastern High School into one of Ohio's elite Division IV girls' basketball programs. He brought with him an impressive list of credentials produced at a school where he was employed since graduating from Cedarville College in 1976. He earned his master's degree in Educational Administration from the University of Dayton in 1982.

Martin coached Southeastern, located just eight miles away in South Charleston, Ohio, to a 297-34 record for a .897 winning percentage during a coaching career that spanned 1986-97 and 1999-2001. He led the Trojans to the Ohio Division IV state championship in 1996, one state runner-up finish, and to 11 Kenton Trace Conference championships including ten straight. Southeastern assembled a 162-game KTC winning streak, won all 11 district title games they ever played in, and advanced to the Division IV Sweet 16 in 11 of his last 12 years.

Martin never had a losing season at Southeastern and earned numerous honors for his team's accomplishments. He was tabbed state Coach of the Year in 1989, was twice named Southwest District Coach of the Year, was a four-time District 9 Coach of the Year, and was a six-time Clark County Coach of the Year. He was inducted into the Cedarville University Athletic Hall of Fame in 1998 for his coaching accomplishments.

Kirk and his wife, Vicki, reside in Springfield. The Martins have three married children, who along with their spouses are all CU graduates, and five grandchildren.

Jordan Lykes has been named the G-MAC Women's Basketball Athlete of the Week for the second time this season and the second time in the last month (Feb. 3) after helping her team to a win over Kentucky Wesleyan before falling to Trevecca Nazarene.

In the weekend's first game, a double-overtime win over Kentucky Wesleyan, Lykes scored a game and career-high 31 points on 12-21 shooting. She also led the game with 15 rebounds. Trailing by two points with just seven seconds left, Lykes scored the game-tying bucket on a lay-up leaving just a second on the clock and forcing overtime. Despite not scoring in the first overtime, Lykes scored six of the team's nine points in the second overtime, securing the victory with a rebound and two free throws in the final seconds of a 99-94 win.

In the teams loss to Trevecca Nazarene, Lykes totaled a game-high 20 points on 9-18 shooting. She also added seven rebounds and an assist. Here 51 points was the most scored in conference this past week, and her 25.5 points per game also led the G-MAC over the last week.

With her big scoring week, Lykes moved her scoring average to 14.3 points a game, and is now ranked in a tie for third for scoring, 1.1 points behind the league's top scorer. She is also tied for third in rebounding with 7.5 boards a game.

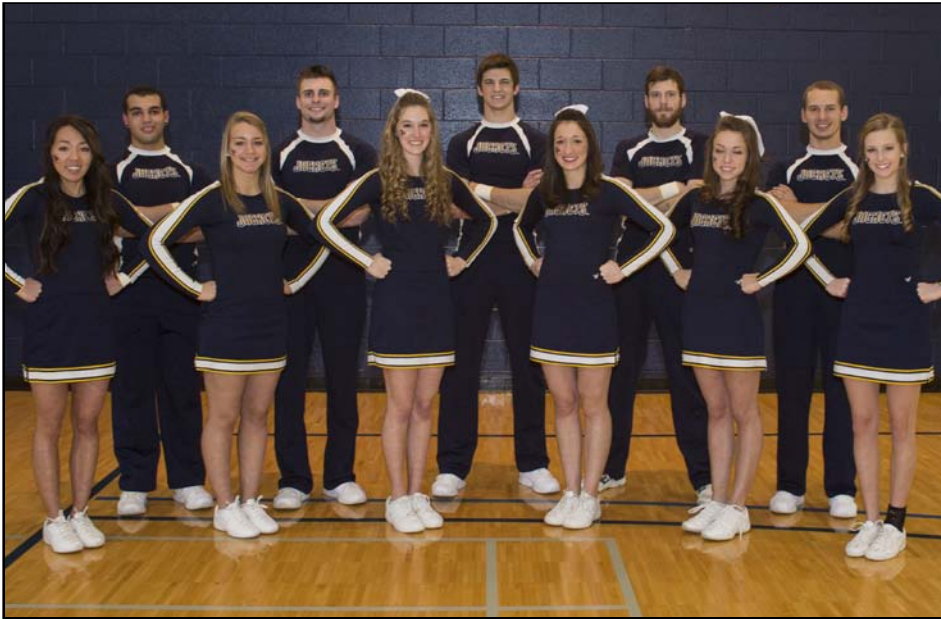
