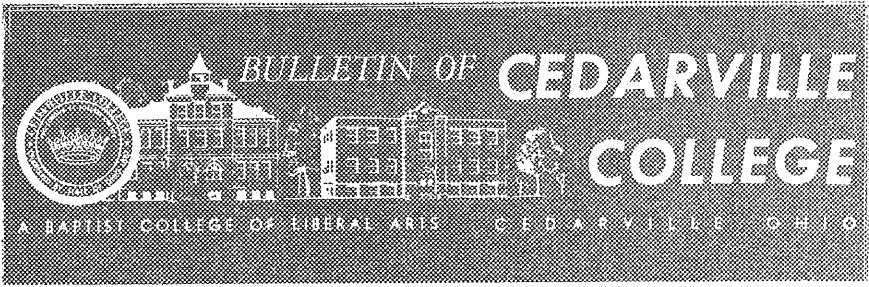

CONSTRUCTION TO BEGIN ON STUDENT CENTER

The Board of Trustees of Cedarville College at the regular quarterly meeting held on Saturday, January 13, voted to begin construction on the new Student Center as soon as weather conditions will permit.

At the present time some \$15,000 is available in gifts for this project, and at least \$50,000 will be made available through the sale of Series "B" bonds. Additional funds required to complete this structure must be obtained through gifts of interested churches and friends.

We will begin this building and plan for its completion as funds are on hand for the project.

The students of Cedarville College have shown their interest in this project first of all by giving of their own substance and enlisting the aid of others in establishing a Student Center fund. They have also recently assessed themselves a \$10.00 per semester Student Union fee. This will be a permanent charge to students each semester and the money will be used to pay off the bonds which are sold for this building project.

May this decision on the part of our Board of Trustees, plus the action of our student body, be an encouragement to our friends to give to the Student Center fund so that when classes begin next September this new building will be completed and ready for use.

PRACTICAL APPLICATION OF EDUCATION

Practical application of principles learned was well demonstrated recently in a project done by 14 members of the Business Statistics class taught by Mr. Kenneth H. St. Clair.

Several months ago the mayor of the village of Cedarville appointed a committee on community industrial development, of which Dean Richard McIntosh is a member.

Before any community can be developed, it is important to know the attitude of the residents. It was necessary for a community attitude survey to be conducted. A professional firm was consulted; and the cost estimate was about \$300, a figure out of the reach of the committee.

Dean McIntosh then called on the teacher of the Cedarville College Business Statistics class. The project was begun in November, 1961. The students prepared a sectional map of Cedarville, chose the sample, performed the actual interviewing, (questionnaires were obtained from Ohio State University), tabulated the data, and wrote the report under the direction of Mr. St. Clair. Total cost was \$1.35.

Officials of Cedarville and surrounding communities were amazed and thrilled at the information given by the report. Copies are being produced to be distributed to various important people and organizations in the area.
