Tonight's Match

The Cedarville University women's volleyball team hosts the Kentucky State University Thorobrettes tonight in a non-conference contest in the Callan Athletic Center. It is the final home match of 2015 and is also Senior Night.

Cedarville, under the direction of eighth-year Head Coach Doug Walters (173-119), enters tonight's encounter with a 16-13 record (9-1 G-MAC) and an unblemished mark (10-0) at home during the 2015 campaign. CU posted 3-1 victories over visiting IU East last Tuesday and Great Midwest Athletic Conference foe Ursuline last Wednesday in Pepper Pike, Ohio.

Kentucky State, NCAA II members of the Southern Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (SIAC), is 19-11 this season but has dropped three of their last four contests. The Thorobrettes, 16-1 in the SIAC, suffered a 3-0 loss to visiting Saint Catharine last Thursday.

Four juniors have led the way for the Lady Jackets in the 2015 season. Outside hitter Abby Shelton tops the offensive attack with 355 kills and 3.82 kills per set. Shelton is 96 kills away from joining CU's 1,000 Kill Club. Rachel Krikke, a 6-1 middle hitter, tops the G-MAC with a .365 attack percentage.

Libero Angela Becker, coming off a career-high 40 digs at Ursuline, paces the back row with 446 digs while setter Kristin Cardwell has handed out 877 assists and paces the squad with 41 service aces.

Head Coach Christina Coleman is in her fourth season (77-70) at KSU. She has an impressive 58-8 mark versus SIAC foes.

Kirtrice Ploucha, a 5-11 junior outside hitter, tops the Thorobrettes attack with 261 kills and 2.75 kills per set. Classmate Anjelique Kyle, a 5-7 setter, directs the offense while posting 807 assists.

CU won the only other previous meeting with Kentucky State - a 3-0 verdict on Sept. 15, 2012 in Cedarville, Ohio.

Last Time on the Court - 11/4/15

PEPPER PIKE, Ohio - Abby Shelton buried 22 kills as the Lady Jackets won their fourth straight match with a four-set G-MAC result at Ursuline.

Cedarville improved to 16-13 overall and 9-1 G-MAC by scores of 25-21, 24-26, 25-14, 25-19.

Shelton was the only Lady Jacket to reach twin figures. Rachel Krikke tallied nine kills while Taylor Wilkerson produced seven to go along with four blocks.

Kristin Cardwell piled up 41 assists with three service aces and 10 digs. Katie Sir rejected three blocks.

The back line was busy with Angela Becker recording a career-high 40 digs.

Emily Gewirtz also had a career-best in digs with 19 and Abby Woodard chipped in 11.

Numbers Game:

- Shelton's 22 kills were the most since she buried 22 vs. Trevecca on Oct. 3.
- Cardwell registered at least 40 assists for the ninth time this season.
- Becker's 40 digs eclipsed her previous career-high of 34 which she set as a freshman.
- The Jackets' single-match record of 45 digs was established by Amy Zehr on Oct. 22, 1991 vs. Bluffton.
- Cedarville is 14-0 all-time vs. Ursuline.

Head Coach Doug Walters



Doug Walters has been the head volleyball coach at Cedarville University since 2008. He is the sixth head coach in the program's history.

The Lady Jackets have posted 157 victories during Walters' seven-year tenure. The list of honors includes the 2008 NCCAA championship as well as three consecutive Great Midwest Athletic Conference crowns in 2012, 2013, and 2014.

During the school's first active season in NCAA Division II in 2012, his squad rolled to a 32-6 overall mark and was a perfect 8-0 in the G-MAC. Cedarville went on to win the inaugural G-MAC Tournament and Walters was ultimately voted the league's Coach of the Year.

The Jackets, who finished 23-14 overall in 2013, repeated the feat after sharing the league's best regular season record at 12-2. They went on the road to claim their second straight G-MAC Tournament trophy.

Then, in 2014, CU made it a three-peat after rolling through the league schedule with a 10-1 regular season mark. The Jackets hosted the G-MAC Tournament as the #1 seed and locked down their third straight title to finish 20-13.

Walters' first season with the Lady Jackets in 2008 was a memorable one as he guided the program to its third National Christian College Athletic Association title in four years. He was tabbed the NCCAA National Coach of the Year.

Cedarville finished with a 27-12 record overall that season and tied for fourth place out of 15 teams in the American Midwest Conference with a 10-4 mark. The Lady Jackets qualified for the AMC Tournament and advanced to the semifinals.

Despite going 15-23 overall in 2009, the Lady Jackets were the #2 seed in the AMC Tournament after going 8-4 in the league. The Jackets were 18-20 and 6-4 AMC in 2010 while advancing to the semifinals of the conference tournament.

Cedarville finished with a 22-18 mark in 2011 during the school's NCAA provisional year and was the No. 1 seed in the Ohio Independent Championship Tournament.

Walters came to Cedarville after assembling a 128-73 record in nine years of high school coaching in southern Ohio. He spent his last two seasons at the prep level at Milford High School, a Division I program near Cincinnati.

Walters previously spent seven years building Eastern High School in Sardinia into one of the top Division III programs in Ohio. The Warriors, who were ranked in the state's Top 10 in three different seasons, won four conference titles, two sectional championships, and were the district runner-up once. He was a four-time conference Coach of the Year and saw eight players continue their careers at the collegiate level.

Walters was founder and former director of the Greater Miami Volleyball Club. The GMVC was started in 2003, was a Junior Olympic organization, and was recognized as one of the top regional clubs in the Cincinnati area.

Walters continues to be involved at the club level. He is a National Team Coach for the Elevation Volleyball Club based out of Mason, Ohio.

Additionally, Walters is the volleyball chair of the Great Midwest Athletic Conference. He is also the chair of the NCAA Division II Women's Volleyball Midwest Regional Advisory Committee and serves on the Division II Women's Volleyball National Committee.

Walters is a 1997 graduate of Northern Kentucky University and he earned his master's degree from the University of Dayton in 2003. Doug and his wife, Angela, reside in Morrow, Ohio with their daughter Caitlyn, 13.

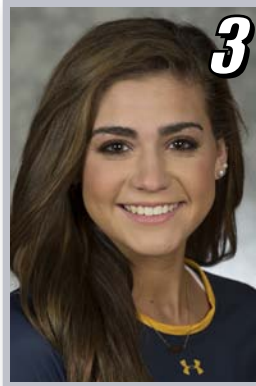
