Tonight's Game Preview

The Cedarville University Lady Jackets host the Roberts Wesleyan College Raiders tonight in an American Mideast Conference game in the Callan Athletic Center as part of the annual Li'l Sibs Weekend.

Cedarville, ranked #15 in this week's NAIA II Top 25 Poll, enters the game 18-6 overall and 8-2 in the AMC. The Lady Jackets dropped league foe Malone 95-63 on Thursday night in Canton. The Raiders are 14-8 overall with a 7-3 AMC record. Roberts Wesleyan's most recent action was a 77-46 thumping of Mount Vernon Nazarene last Saturday in Rochester, New York.

The Lady Jacket lineup features three players scoring in double figures. Leading the way is senior post player Aubrey Siemon - averaging 13.9 ppg with a league-best 11.6 rebounds per game. She is CU's all-time leading rebounder with 1,226 in her career. Siemon's .552 field goal percentage paces CU and has a second-best .860 mark at the charity stripe.

Rookie Kayla Jenerette, a 5-5 guard, is the second Lady Jacket with a double-digit scoring average at 12.5 points per game. She leads CU with 50 steals and a .512 mark from long-range on 44-of-86 - best in NAIA II.

Senior guard Rachel Hurley adds 12.4 points per game while leading the team in assists with 78. Hurley is second on the team with 46 three-point field goals and ranks fifth all-time at CU in made three-pointers with 200.

Senior guard Lydia Miller is tossing in 9.5 ppg, is second on the team in assists (68) and leads the squad at .875 from the stripe.

Junior Kara Cayton, a 5-4 guard, has upped her scoring average to 9 points per game. She has a team-best 56 three-pointers and is tied for second on the team in steals with 30.

Starting forward Caitlyn Brooks, a 6-0 senior, adds 5.7 points and 3.8 rebounds.

Freshman Deborah Chandler comes off the bench to contribute 6.4 ppg and 4.2 rebounds per outing.

Cedarville shoots .449 from the field including 208-of-495 attempts from the three-point line for a .420 mark. The Lady Jackets are deadly at the free throw line with a .780 team pct. CU leads NAIA II in both three-point and free throw shooting.

Cedarville is outscoring opponents by 15.7 points per game while holding them to .366 shooting from the floor. The Lady Jackets are controlling the boards with a +6.1 margin.

The Raiders are led in scoring by 6-0 senior post player Brittany McMillon with 11.4 points and 6.3 rebounds per game. She has a team-best .473 field goal percentage and 45 steals.

Marissa Bunce, a 5-8 sophomore guard, is the only other RWC in double figures with 10.2 ppg. Bunce has a team-best 48 three-point field goals. Roberts Weslevan is scoring 73 points per game

The Lady Jackets lead the all-time series with RWC by a 5-2 margin. CU won last season's only meeting 76-64 on Jan. 23, 2010 in Rochester, NY behind Aubrey Siemon's 13th double-double of the year of 17 points and 13 boards.

NAIA Division II #15 Cedarville flipped in 13 three-pointers and breezed to a 95-63 victory at Malone in an American Mideast Conference game on Thursday night.

The Lady Jackets entered the contest leading the country in accuracy from beyond the arc (.411) and proceeded to knock down 13-of-21 bombs. They were 8-of-11 in the second half alone

Cedarville sprinted to a 23-7 lead and was never threatened. It was 43-26 at halftime and a 30-point bulge midway through the second period.

Aubrey Siemon piled up 20 points and 12 rebounds in 21 minutes of action for the Lady Jackets, 18-6 overall and 8-2 AMC. Rachel Hurley nailed four long balls en route to 16 points while Kayla Jenerette came off the bench with four trifectas and 16 points.

However, Kara Cayton took team honors from long range. She buried five three-pointers to account for her 15 points to go along with a gamehigh six assists.

Cedarville, who also leads the nation in free throw percentage, converted 12-of-14 charity tosses and committed just seven turnovers in the game. Malone falls to 6-18 and 2-9 AMC.

Looking Ahead



The Lady Jackets head out on a three-game AMC week with trips to Ursuline, Notre Dame and Mount Vernon Nazarene. On Tuesday, Feb. 8 the team will travel to Pepper Pike, Ohio for a 7 p.m. tipoff against the Ursuline College Arrows. Just two days later, Thursday, Feb. 10 CU will be back in northeast Ohio for a 5:30 p.m. encounter with the Notre Dame College Falcons.

Cedarville ends the week with a trip to Mount Vernon Nazarene University on Saturday, Feb. 12 slated for a 2 p.m. start.

CU returns to the Callan Athletic Center for the final two games of the regular season. The Lady Jackets host Wilberforce on Tuesday, Feb. 15 at 5:30 p.m. Cedarville finishes out the 2010-11 regular season portion of the schedule versus Notre Dame OH on Saturday, Feb. 19 at 5:30 p.m.





Top Eight Teams Retain Ranking in NAIA Division II Women's Basketball Coaches' Top 25 Poll

KANSAS CITY, Mo. - Davenport (Mich.) maintained its position at No. 1 in the seventh installment of the NAIA Division II Women's Basketball Coaches' Top 25 Poll, the NAIA announced Monday. The Panthers captured all 16 possible first-place votes and 436 points to spend its fourth-consecutive week as the topranked team. Great Plains Athletic Conference representatives Northwestern (lowa) and Morningside (lowa) hold steady at second and third, respectively, while No. 4 Saint Francis (Ind.) and No. 5 Black Hills State (S.D.) remain locked in.



At 25-0, 11-0 Wolverine-Hoosier Athletic Conference, Davenport is the only unbeaten team remaining. The Panthers have torched league foes with their closest game to date coming

in a 81-64 road win at Indiana Tech on Jan. 26. In that win, Kallie Benike posted 22 points, eight rebounds, five assists, three steals and one block in 34 minutes of action. Davenport got its 25th victory when it traveled to Siena Heights (Mich.) on Jan. 29 and came away with a 48-point win, 98-50.

Northwestern (22-1, 13-0 GPAC) totaled 422 points and remains a stronghold at the No. 2 position. With just one game on the schedule last week, the Red Raiders hosted neighbor-school Dordt (lowa) on Jan. 29. Northwestern sophomore Kendra De Jong and senior Becca Hurley combined for 41 points en route to a 75-60 win over the Defenders.

For the second week in-a-row, Morningside (20-3, 10-2 GPAC) claims the No. 3 spot with 408 points. The Mustangs solidified their top-five ranking with a Top-25 road win over then-No. 17 Mount Marty on Jan. 26. Morningside had three players in double-figure scoring for the game and held onto a 71-65 win. The Mustangs ended their three-game road swing with a 73-60 victory at Hastings (Neb.) on Jan.

Fourth-ranked Saint Francis, who is riding a 12-game winning streak, tallied 391 points. At 21-4, 10-1 Mid-Central College Conference, the Cougars remain in a twoway tie for first place with Indiana Wesleyan in the league standings. USF avenged its 79-65 home loss to Taylor (Ind.) on Dec. 1 with an 87-74 win on the Trojans' home court on Jan. 26. Returning to Fort Wayne, Ind., on Jan. 29, the Cougars won in convincing fashion by beating Spring Arbor (Mich.) 84-57

Black Hills State collected 375 points and remains fifth in this week's poll. At 18-3 and undefeated in Dakota Athletic Conference play, the Yellow Jackets have complete control of the league standings. In its only matchup of the week, Black Hills State ran off to a 47-35 lead at halftime against South Dakota Tech and never looked back. Keely Krolikowski, the DAC's leading scorer at 17.3 points per game, finished the contest with 24 points and four assists

Following a 67-53 upset of then-No. 11 St. Ambrose (lowa) on Jan. 27, William Penn (lowa) leaps into the Top 25 at No. 16. The Lady Statesmen extended their winning streak to eight with the win, before unranked Mount Mercy (lowa) handed them an 87-67 setback on Jan. 29

Twelve conferences are represented on the Top 25 poll as the GPAC continues to lead with five teams: Northwestern, Morningside, No. 6 Sioux Falls (S.D.), No. 17 Briar Cliff (lowa) and Mount Marty. Three leagues, the American Mideast Conference, Midwest Collegiate Conference and MCCC, had a trio of teams garner national ranking

The poll was voted upon by a panel of head coaches representing each of the conferences. The next poll will be announced on Feb. 7
