Tonight's Game Preview

he Cedarville University Lady Jackets host the Notre Dame College Falcons tonight in an American Mideast Conference game in the Callan Athletic Center. It is the final regular season contest of the 2010-11 schedule.

Cedarville, ranked #16 in this week's NAIA II Top 25 Poll, enters the game 22-7 overall and 12-3 in the AMC. The Lady Jackets posted an 87-58 league win against visiting Wilberforce on Tuesday night. The Falcons are 21-8 on the season with an 11-4 AMC record. Notre Dame dropped the Malone Pioneers 86-44 on Tuesday in Canton, Ohio.

The Lady Jacket lineup features three players scoring in double figures. Leading the way is senior post player Aubrey Siemon - averaging 13.3 ppg and 12 rebounds per game. She is CU's all-time leading rebounder with 1,296 in her career and tops the AMC in rebounding. Siemon's .549 field goal percentage and .868 mark at the charity stripe top the Lady Jackets.

Rookie Kayla Jenerette, a 5-5 guard, is the second Lady Jacket with a double-digit scoring average at 12.7 points per game. She leads CU with 56 steals and a .468 mark from long-range on 52-of-111 - second-best in NAIA Division II.

Senior guard Rachel Hurley adds 12.3 points per game while leading the team in assists with 88. Hurley is second on the team with 55 three-point field goals and currently ranks fourth all-time at CU in made three-pointers with 209.

Senior guard Lydia Miller is tossing in 9.1 ppg with third-best marks in assists (81) and free-throw shooting (.824).

Junior Kara Cayton, a 5-4 guard, is tossing in 9 points per game. She has a team-best 67 three-pointers and is tied for second on the team in steals with 35. Cayton is also second with 83 assists.

Starting forward Caitlyn Brooks, a 6-0 senior, adds 5.3 points and 3.6 rebounds per game. She is third on the squad with a .800 effort at the free-throw line.

Freshman Deborah Chandler comes off the bench to contribute 5.6 ppg and 3.9 rebounds per outing.

Cedarville shoots .439 from the field including 244-of-624 attempts from the three-point line for a .391 mark. The Lady Jackets are solid at the free throw line with a .780 team pct. - best in NAIA II.

Cedarville is outscoring opponents by 14 points per game while holding them to .364 shooting from the floor. The Lady Jackets are controlling the boards with a +5.8 margin.

The Falcons are led by two players hitting in double figures. Yvette Hunter, a 5-11 senior, tops the team with 12.9 ppg. Kealy McNally adds 12.1 points per game and is the top rebounder at 6.6 caroms per night. She leads the team with 46 steals and 20 blocked shots. McNally is 78-102 from the charity stripe for a .765 performance.



Notre Dame is scoring 74.8 points per game while Kealy McNally allowing a third-best in the AMC 60.4 points per con-

test. The team is .420 from the field and .323 from behind the three-point line. The Falcons are excellent at the free throw line hitting 429-of-602 for a .713 effort.

CU leads the all-time series with NDC by a 9-1 margin including a 57-55 last second victory just nine days ago in South Euclid.

There was no mistaking the emphasis that NAIA Division II #16 Cedarville placed on breast cancer awareness while taking care of Wilberforce, 87-58, in an American Mideast Conference game.

The Lady Jackets donned new pink uniforms as part of the Women's Basketball Coaches Association Pink Zone Week. For added emphasis, they wore pink shoelaces while the coaches sported shades of pink in their attire. Fans were also asked to make a donation for breast cancer research upon entering the Callan Athletic Center.

Cedarville had little problem with its Greene County rival which is located just four miles away. The Jackets eased out to a 46-30 halftime lead before pulling away for the 29-point final.

Kayla Jenerette paced five players in double figures with 18 points for Cedarville, 22-7 overall and 12-3 AMC.. Aubrey Siemon registered her 16th double-double of the season with 14 points and 19 rebounds.

Lydia Miller finished with 11 points while Rachel Hurley and Jenna Smith added 10 points apiece. The Lady Jackets controlled the boards, 56-32, and converted 17-of-18 free throws.





The Panthers have been in the driver's seat for the past six weeks and continue to be the nation's only undefeated team.

Top-ranked Davenport (28-0, 14-0 Wolverine-Hoosier Athletic Conference) is riding a 28-game winning streak after last week's wins against Madonna (Mich.) and Northwestern Ohio. The Panthers Davenport head coach clinched its fifth-consecutive WHAC regular-season

title with an 80-70 road win at Madonna on Feb. 9. In its 95-68 victory over Northwestern Ohio on Feb. 12, DU was led by senior guard Kallie Benike, who contributed a team-high 19 points.

Second-ranked Northwestern (25-1, 16-0 GPAC) won its first outright regular-season GPAC title since the 2000-01 season with a 30-point win over No. 3 Morningside on Feb. 9. The Red Raiders ran away with a 76-46 victory behind the individual performances of Val Kleinjan, Becca Hurley and Kendra

No. 3 Morningside (22-4, 12-3 GPAC) suffered its second loss to Northwestern this season after shooting just 28.3 percent from the floor. After failing to have any scorers in double-figures against the Red Raiders, the Mustangs recovered with a 79-63 win against Concordia (Neb.) on Feb. 12.

Fourth-ranked Sioux Falls (23-3, 11-3 GPAC) benefited from Morningside's loss as it jumped into second place in the league standings with a half-game advantage. The Cougars secured a 66-58 victory over Dordt (lowa) as all five starters reached double-digits in scoring on Feb. 9.

Saint Francis (23-5, 12-2 Mid-Central College Conference) returns to the lead group at No. 5. The Cougars rebounded from their 77-72 loss to Marian (Ind.) on Feb. 3 with an 84-58 win over Goshen (Ind.) on Feb. 9. Saint Francis regained a share of the conference lead with a 71-66 win at home against No. 6 Indiana Wesleyan nine days later.

Of the 12 teams that moved up in rank, No. 7 Walsh (Ohio) received the largest boost, climbing three spots. Northwest (Wash.) took the biggest hit, dropping from No. 16 to 23.

No. 21 Concordia (Ore.) and No. 24 Valley City State (N.D.) re-entered the Top 25 this week, replacing William Penn (Iowa) and Jamestown (N.D.). Twelve conferences are represented on the Top 25 poll as the GPAC continues to lead with five teams: Northwestern, Morningside, Sioux Falls, No. 19 Briar Cliff and No. 22 Mount Marty (S.D.). It is the sixth week this season that three GPAC teams are present in the top five. Two leagues, the American Mideast Conference and Mid-Central College Conference, had a trio of teams
