Jesse Froese RHP (#19) – Business Management







Weekend Series

The Cedarville University baseball team hosts the Davis & Elkins College Senators in a four-game Great Midwest Athletic Conference series this weekend to close out the 2016 regular season. CU's six seniors will be honored before Saturday's games.

Cedarville enters the weekend with a 14-25 mark (7-11 G-MAC) including a split of a league twinbill at Kentucky Wesleyan last Friday. Davis & Elkins brings a 13-29 record (7-13 G-MAC) into Yellow Jacket Field including a split of a G-MAC DH with visiting Ohio Valley last Saturday.

Junior third baseman Drew Johnson leads the Jackets with a .382 batting average. He tops CU with 60 hits, 13 doubles, three triples, 2 HR's, 11 stolen bases, 85 total bases and a .541 slugging pct. Senior outfielder David Lenhardt is second with a .349 batting average while ranking second with 44 base hits. Sophomore outfielder Colton Potter is batting .23 with



a team-high 30 runs batted in including a second-best nine SB's and 63 total bases. Drew Johnson

Senior right-hander Garrett Baker is 3-2 with a 2.85 earned run average in 47 1/3 innings of action. Senior reliever Connor Hamilton is the alltime lead in appearances with 60 while posting two saves this year.

The Yellow Jackets will be playing in the six-team G-MAC Baseball Championship Tournament May 11-14 at Prasco Park in Mason, Ohio.

OWENSBORO, Ky. - The Yellow Jackets gave G-MAC frontrunner Kentucky Wesleyan all it could handle as the two sides traded victories in a twinbill.

Cedarville won the opener, 4-1, but dropped the second contest, 2-1. Winning pitcher Andrew Plunkett, 2-1, Connor Hamilton, and Jordan Adams combined on a six-hitter in the first game.

The visitors struck for three runs in the first at bat - two of which were unearned. Drew Johnson launched a solo home run in the 3rd for a 4-0 lead.

Joey Chapman was 3-for-3 with a run scored. Thad Ferguson added two hits with a double.

Plunkett pitched five scoreless innings. He allowed five hits with three strikeouts and a walk.

In the nightcap, KWC pushed across a run in the bottom of the 8th inning to account for the 2-1 final.

Colton Potter had two hits including a double. Starting pitcher Garrett Baker fanned six in 6 1/3 innings for the Jackets.


