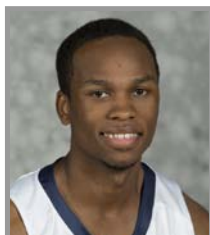

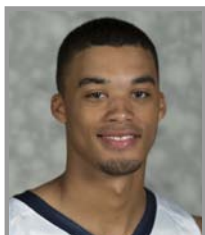

CEDARVILLE, Ohio - Malone used hot shooting to create a big second half lead en route to stinging the Yellow Jackets, 79-66, in the final game of the Fourth Annual Don Callan Classic.

The Pioneers hit 56 percent from the field in the first half. They erased a four-point deficit midway through the period to grab a 39-27 edge at the break.

A 15-point run, all on a string of five three-pointers, produced a 58-34 bulge with 12:11 to go. Cedarville got as close as 10 points in the final minute.

Patrick Bain paced four players in double figures with 13 points to go along with eight rebounds.

J.C. Faubion scored 11 points and grabbed a team-high nine boards.

Freshman Colton Linkous added 11 points while Easton Bazzoli chipped in 10.

Numbers Game:

- After starting the game 5-for-15 at the line, the Jackets made their last 12 in a row.
- Cedarville had attempted 26 free throws before Malone attempted its first with 2:20 left in the game.
- The Yellow Jackets controlled the boards, 40-35, and had fewer turnovers, 19-16.

Looking Ahead

The Yellow Jackets will end their season-opening four-game homestand with a non-conference game this Saturday, November 21. The Northwood University Timberwolves will pay a visit to the Callan Athletic Center for a 4:15 pm tip-off with the Jackets.

Cedarville will travel to Big Rapids, Michigan on Tuesday, November 24 to face the Ferris State University Bulldogs in a non-league affair scheduled for a 7:30 pm start.

The Jackets return home after Thanksgiving on Tuesday, December 1 for a 7:45 meeting with the Trailblazers of Ohio Christian University. OCU, NAIA II members of the Kentucky Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (KIAC), is coached by former Ohio State standout Tony Stockman.

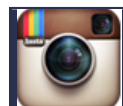

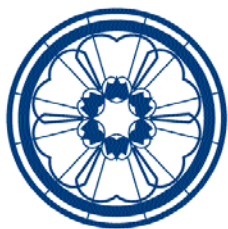

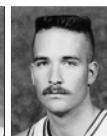

GREENWOOD, Ind. – Kentucky Wesleyan junior guard Ken-Jah Bosley was named the first Great Midwest Athletic Conference Men's Basketball Athlete of the Week for 2015-16 on Monday.

The Panthers (2-0) rumbled through their first two games of the new season, beating a pair of Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletics Conference (GLIAC) schools as part of the G-MAC/GLIAC Challenge.

Kentucky Wesleyan made the Motor City its own, beating Wayne State on the Warriors' home floor Saturday before storming back from a 19-point deficit to nip Tiffin on Sunday in Detroit.

Already a two time first team all-league selection in the Great Midwest Athletic Conference, Bosley helped steer the Panthers to the key non-conference/Midwest Region victories on opening weekend.

Bosley averaged 20 points per game while shooting almost 54 percent from the field. He also sank 9-of-10 tries from the free-throw line and had five rebounds.

The Panthers had a game-high 21 points from Bosley in their season opener as he sank 7-of-11 attempts from the field and was perfect on all free throws.

KWC won by a convincing margin of 31, shooting 58 percent from the field as a team.

Against Tiffin, Bosley and Panthers clawed their way back from a seemingly insurmountable deficit. With 1:56 left in the first half, KWC found itself trailing by 19, but cut the lead down to just five midway through the second half.

Head Coach Pat Estep

Pat Estep has been the head men's basketball coach at Cedarville University since the 2008-09 campaign. He has guided his alma mater to an average of 20 victories per season and five national tournament appearances.

The Yellow Jackets' first active season in NCAA Division II resulted in a 22-9 mark in 2012-13. Estep was voted the Great Midwest Athletic Conference Coach of the Year as his team claimed the G-MAC regular season title, the G-MAC Tournament trophy, and placed third in the NCAA Championship.

Cedarville was 23-9 during its NCAA provisional year in 2011-12. They won the school's first NCAA Championship banner in convincing fashion after entering the 2012 tournament as the No. 1 seed and winning their three games by an average of 18 points. Estep was tabbed NCAA National Coach of the Year.

Cedarville finished strong again in 2010-11 by winning eight of their last nine regular season games including the last five in a row. The Jackets were ranked as high as 14th in the NAIA Division II poll and finished at 20-13.

Cedarville won 16 of its last 18 games in 2009-10 to finish 26-9 and 14-2 in the American Midwest Conference as the league runner-up. The Yellow Jackets, who were rated as high as 8th in the national poll, later won the AMC Tournament and advanced to the second round of the national tournament.

Estep's inaugural campaign at the helm was full of memorable accomplishments. He guided the Yellow Jackets to a 27-4 overall record and a share of the AMC title with a 12-1 league mark. Cedarville was ranked as high as No. 1 in the country, finished in a tie for the No. 2 spot in the final poll, and advanced to the national tournament.

The Jackets assembled a number of school records which included a 14-game winning streak. They also wiped out all of the previous marks for defense.

Cedarville led the country in field goal percentage defense with opponents shooting just 37.9 percent. They also ranked second nationally by allowing a stingy 60 points per contest which was 10 points per game lower than the old school record.

Estep's leadership did not go unnoticed. He was voted the AMC Coach of the Year as well as the NCCAA Midwest Region Coach of the Year.

Estep took on his current position after serving as an assistant coach for eight years under former head coach Ray Slagle. He played a key role during Slagle's successful tenure with the Yellow Jackets from 2000 to 2008.

Cedarville won 177 games during that time-span, averaged 24.1 wins over the last seven seasons, won three American Midwest Conference titles, and two AMC Tournament championships.

The Yellow Jackets made five trips to the NAIA Division II National Tournament where they never lost in the first round. They advanced to the semifinals once, the quarterfinals twice, and to the second round twice.

This is the first head coaching position for Estep. A 1997 graduate of Cedarville College with a degree in physical education, he was a student assistant at the school during his senior year and went on to acquire coaching experience at all levels of basketball.

Estep was the 8th grade coach at Cedarville Junior High School in 1996-97. He spent the next year at Clark County Christian High School in Kentucky where he was the varsity assistant boys basketball coach and the head coach in golf and tennis.

Estep spent the 1998-99 season as the junior varsity coach at Oak Hill (Ohio) High School. He held the same position in 1999-2000 at South Webster (Ohio) High School which is where he graduated from in 1993.

Estep comes from a rich basketball coaching heritage. His father, Dale, spent 27 years in the profession at Fairfield Union and South Webster high schools.

Estep also has a master's degree in education from Cedarville University that he earned in 2008. Pat and his wife, Melanie, reside in Cedarville with their three children: sons Isaiah, 14, and Grant, 11, as well as daughter, Merynn, 5.

2015-16 Season Preview

CEDARVILLE, Ohio - The Yellow Jackets will play before the home fans 17 times during the 2015-16 men's basketball season.

Head Coach Pat Estopp announced his team's 28-game slate plus two exhibitions. Once the regular season gets going, eight of the first nine assignments will be in the Callan Athletic Center.

"Having 17 home games is crucial because we have seven freshmen and a transfer," Estopp explained. "We'll be trying to get everyone on the same page especially since we're so young."

Cedarville finished last winter in strong fashion to end up 13-16 overall and 9-5 G-MAC. The Jackets will again be tested from the start this year.

Estopp added, "The G-MAC will be rugged. It's been kind of top heavy with Alderson Broaddus and Kentucky Wesleyan in the last two years, but a number of teams have improved. Add to the fact our winner gets the automatic bid now and there will be much more on the line."

Estopp begins his eighth season as head coach of the Yellow Jackets. His teams have averaged 20 wins per season.

Cedarville, Davis & Elkins Honored Again for Academic Success Rates



INDIANAPOLIS – Cedarville University and Davis & Elkins College headlined the Great Midwest Athletic Conference with Academic Success Rates of 90 percent or higher as released by the NCAA on Wednesday.

Cedarville and Davis & Elkins are among 27 NCAA Division II schools to be honored part of the Presidents' Award for Academic Excellence, now in its fifth year.

This is the third consecutive year that both Cedarville and D&E have received the Presidents' Award for Academic Excellence.

D&E had a reported ASR of 94 with UC-San Diego, Assumption and Seattle Pacific, while Cedarville's ASR of 91 tied four other schools.

For the first time, the University of the Sciences in Philadelphia led Division II with an Academic Success Rate of 99 percent, followed closely by Saint Michael's College, Point Loma Nazarene University and Bentley University, all of which achieved a 98 percent ASR.

For the second straight year, the Northeast-10 led Division II's 24 conferences in ASR rates, with five athletics programs posting scores of 90 percent or more.

The G-MAC ranked fifth among all 24 Division II conferences with ASR's of 90 percent or more.

"We are pleased by the increasing number of Division II schools whose student-athletes are earning Academic Success Rates of 90 percent or higher," said Judy Bense, president of the University of West Florida and chair of the Division II Presidents Council. "These schools and their students demonstrate the utmost dedication to success in the classroom and on the field, and we are proud of their efforts."

The Academic Success Rate is the percentage of student-athletes who graduate within six years of initial enrollment in college and includes virtually all Division II student-athletes, including transfers and those not receiving athletics scholarships.

The Division II ASR also captures about 51 percent more college athletes than the federal graduation rate. Unlike the federal graduation rate, the ASR also counts student-athletes who transfer to a school after initial enrollment elsewhere and removes from the rate student-athletes who leave school while academically eligible. The national ASR is 71 percent for student-athletes who entered college from 2005 through 2008.

Regardless of which measure is used, Division II college athletes graduate at a higher rate than the general student body. The federal rate for the 2008 entering class of student-athletes was 55 percent, compared to 49 percent for the general student body.
