Tonight's Game Preview

The Cedarville University Yellow Jackets host the University of Illinois Springfield Prairie Stars tonight in the Callan Athletic Center.

Cedarville is 1-3 on the year after dropping a 74-65 decision at NCAA II #8 University of Findlay on Saturday afternoon. The battle included 11 ties with CU on the short end of the free throw and rebounding stats.

The Prairie Stars, also 1-3 in the early going, are NCAA II members of the Great Lakes Valley Conference. The most recent action for UIS was an 89-84 overtime loss to visiting Lindenwood on Saturday. Two of UIS' three defeats have been by five points.

Senior Jimmy Nwogbo, a 6-foot-7 forward, has bolted out to a great start in 2012-13. Last year's NCCAA National Tournament MVP leads the Jackets with 20.8 points, 8.3 rebounds per game, six steals and a .660 field goal percentage.

Senior guard Austin Foote is second on the team in scoring with a 14 ppg average. He also leads in three-point FG's (9) and free throw shooting (9-for-10).

Zach Brown, a 6-foot-3 senior point guard, adds 8.3 points per game while pacing the team with 12 assists.

Caleb Maxwell, a 6-foot-8 senior forward, is producing solid minutes off the bench and may get his first start of the campaign tonight. Maxwell is tossing in 7.5 ppg and is tied for second in the rebounding category at 5.3 boards per contest.

Jason Cuffee, a sophomore transfer from Division I Wright State, is contributing 6.5 points and 4.5 rebounds per game. He is second on the team with

an .889 mark from the charity stripe on 8-for-9 shooting.

Brian Grant, a 6-foot-8 junior post player, adds 6 points per game to the Yellow Jacket offense while tied with Maxwell in rebounding at 5.3 rpg.

Illinois Springfield is under the direction of third-year coach Ben Wierzba. Prior to coming to UIS he spent three seasons as an assistant coach at the University of Evansville.

The Prairie Stars will look to use their balanced scoring attack to compete with the Yellow Jackets. Seven UIS players are averaging between 6.8 and 11.8 points per game.

Junior guard Regan Bruenger and senior guard Kyle Gupton lead the offense each at 11.8 points per game. Gupton is the main deep threat for the Prairie Stars with a 12-for-23 performance from behind the arc for a .522 effort.

Dylan Mosack, a 6-8 junior forward, is the second-leading rebounder at 4.5 per game while turning away a team-best 13 shots in the first four games of the season. Mosack boasts a 12-for-14 efforts from the free throw line.

Dylan Sparkman is the top rebounder at 5.3 boards per night. The 6-foot-10 sophomore has hit eight of ten from the free throw line.

Kentrell King, a 6-foot sophomore guard, comes off the bench to lead the Prairie Stars in assists with 14. He adds 3.5 points per game.

Tonight's contest is the first-ever meeting between the two schools on the men's basketball court.

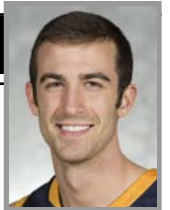
Sports may be one of the few activities that has ultimate highs and ultimate lows. Right when things seem to be going perfectly, things can change quickly. On the flip side, when nothing seems to be working, everything can seem to click in one moment. The momentum of a game and team can vary in a matter of a few plays. We as a team are pushing through this sluggish start. Our most recent win gave us a boost. We had needed a win after our first two losses and although our victory was sub-par at best...we would take the win. One thing we are realizing; however, is we have no room to breathe. We have no room to sit back and kick our feet up. Our competitive schedule will not allow that behavior.

Our next game was against the No. 8-ranked team in NCAA II, Findlay. Most of you already know the conclusion to this game. It always leaves somewhat of a bitter taste in your mouth when your weaknesses are exploited. In addition, you have to face these weaknesses, acknowledge them, and fix them. It is like forgiving someone, it is incredibly hard to do, but in the end both parties are much better and then begin the process of repairing that broken trust or relationship. Our first weakness was defense. Although we work hard, our focus, awareness, and recognition have not been one hundred percent. We break down and allow our opponents to drive by us, back cut us, and score far too many points in the paint. Our second weakness is our offense. Stagnant and ineffective are two ways to describe its current status. Little ball movement, quick shots, and unwise drives to the basket have caused little production.

But there is good news. The good news is that we recognize the problems. Our most recent practice was spent entirely on addressing these issues. Sure, its difficult but in the end and in the long run I truly believe we will be very effective. I would have liked to start the season with a better record. I would have liked to start this season without the disappointment. I could wish a lot of things, but the truth of the matter is that none of it can be changed. We do what we can now, make the most of the opportunities before us, and we have fun.

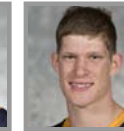

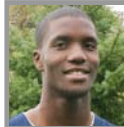

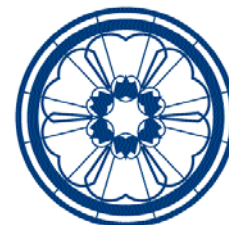

Last Time Out

FINDLAY, Ohio - NCAA Division II No. 8 Findlay won the battle of the free throw line and the boards to hand the Yellow Jackets a 74-65 setback in their first road contest of the season on Saturday afternoon, Nov. 17.

The host Oilers, 1-1 overall, outscored Cedarville 35-14 at the line and assembled a 40-29 margin on the boards. UF was 25-for-26 from the stripe in the second half alone.

Findlay's largest lead was the final score. The Jackets hit three straight three-pointers and ran off 12 consecutive points for a 20-16 advantage midway through the first half, yet, trailed 31-30 at the break.

Austin Foote's rare four-point play gave the visitors a 57-56 lead with 8:46 left. CU was still up 60-59 at the 6:38 mark when UF hit four straight free throws and never trailed again.

"We were beaten at the free throw line," stated Head Coach Pat Estapp. "Give Findlay credit. They attacked the basket better than we did and got to the foul line more than double than we did. We also didn't do our job on the boards and didn't shoot well again."

Foote tallied 18 points to lead Cedarville, 1-3. Jimmy Nwogbo and Marcus Reineke chipped in 12 points each. The Jackets shot 38 percent from the field including 29 percent outside the arc.

Looking Ahead

Cedarville heads out on a four-game road trip when they travel to Grand Valley State University in Allendale, Michigan for a 1:00 p.m. tangle with the Lakers on Saturday, November 24.

Cedarville will visit Lewis University in Romeoville, Illinois for a 7:30 p.m. tipoff against the Flyers on Friday, November 30.

The Jackets continue their trip with a stop in Kenosha, Wisconsin on Saturday, December 1 to meet up with the University of Wisconsin-Parkside at 3 p.m.

The journey ends on Thursday, December 6 in Rensselaer, Indiana against the Pumas of Saint Joseph's College.

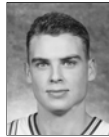

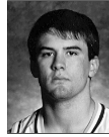

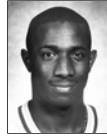

Head Coach Pat Estep

Pat Estep has been the head men's basketball coach at Cedarville University since the 2008-09 campaign. He has guided his alma mater to an average of 24 victories per season and four consecutive national tournament appearances.



The Yellow Jackets are coming off of a 23-9 performance in what was their NCAA Division II provisional year. They won the school's first NCCAA Championship banner in convincing fashion after entering the 2012 tournament as the No. 1 seed and winning their three games by an average of 18 points. Estep was tabbed NCCAA National Coach of the Year.

Cedarville finished strong again in 2010-11 by winning eight of their last nine regular season games including the last five in a row. The Jackets were ranked as high as 14th in the NAIA Division II poll and finished at 20-13.

Cedarville won 16 of its last 18 games in 2009-10 to finish 26-9 and 14-2 in the American Midwest Conference as the league runner-up. The Yellow Jackets, who were rated as high as 8th in the national poll, later won the AMC Tournament and advanced to the second round of the national tournament.

Estep's inaugural campaign at the helm was full of memorable accomplishments. He guided the Yellow Jackets to a 27-4 overall record and a share of the AMC title with a 12-1 league mark. Cedarville was ranked as high as No. 1 in the country, finished in a tie for the No. 2 spot in the final poll, and advanced to the national tournament.

The Jackets assembled a number of school records which included a 14-game winning streak. They also wiped out all of the previous marks for defense.

Cedarville led the country in field goal percentage defense with opponents shooting just 37.9 percent. They also ranked second nationally by allowing a stingy 60 points per contest which was 10 points per game lower than the old school record.

Estep's leadership did not go unnoticed. He was voted the AMC Coach of the Year as well as the NCCAA Midwest Region Coach of the Year.

Estep took on his current position after serving as an assistant coach for eight years under former head coach Ray Slagle. He played a key role during Slagle's successful tenure with the Yellow Jackets from 2000 to 2008.

Cedarville won 177 games during that timespan, averaged 24.1 wins over the last seven seasons, won three American Midwest Conference titles, and two AMC Tournament championships.

The Yellow Jackets made five trips to the NAIA Division II National Tournament where they never lost in the first round. They advanced to the semifinals once, the quarterfinals twice, and to the second round twice.

This is the first head coaching position for Estep. A 1997 graduate of Cedarville College with a degree in physical education, he was a student assistant at the school during his senior year and went on to acquire coaching experience at all levels of basketball.

Estep was the 8th grade coach at Cedarville Junior High School in 1996-97. He spent the next year at Clark County Christian High School in Kentucky where he was the varsity assistant boys basketball coach and the head coach in golf and tennis.

Estep spent the 1998-99 season as the junior varsity coach at Oak Hill (Ohio) High School. He held the same position in 1999-2000 at South Webster (Ohio) High School which is where he graduated from in 1993.

Estep comes from a rich basketball coaching heritage. His father, Dale, spent 27 years in the profession at Fairfield Union and South Webster high schools.

Estep also has a master's degree in education from Cedarville University that he earned in 2008. Pat and his wife, Melanie, reside in Cedarville with their three children: sons Isaiah, 11, and Grant, 8, as well as daughter, Merynn, 2.

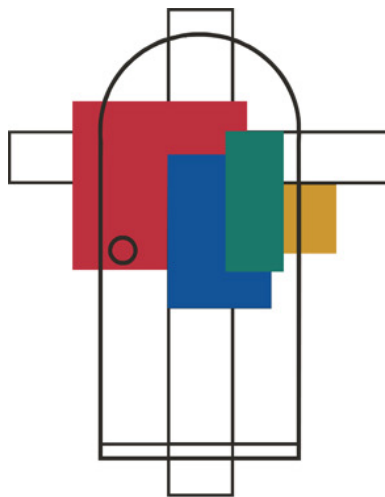

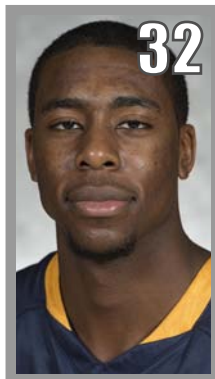
