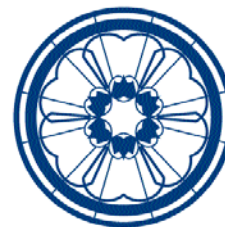

ALLENDALDE, Mich. - Grand Valley State placed four players in double figures while the Yellow Jackets struggled from the field during a 71-56 reversal in a non-conference contest on Saturday afternoon.

The Lakers, 2-1, gave up the first two points of the game. They answered with a three-pointer and never trailed again.

Cedarville labored to 29 percent shooting in the first half and trailed, 36-28, at the break. GVSU was able to thwart any chance of a Jacket comeback in the second period by hitting 52 percent of its field goals.

Marcus Reineke scored a game-high 24 points and was the only player in twin figures for Cedarville, 1-3. No other teammate tallied more than seven points.

The Jackets play their fifth consecutive opponent from the GLIAC on Tuesday by hosting Hillsdale at 7:45 p.m.

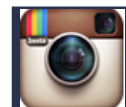

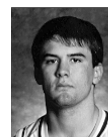

After helping his team to a pair of road victories, Alderson Broaddus junior Malcolm Tatum is spotlighted as the Great Midwest Athletic Conference Men's Basketball Athlete of the Week.

Tatum contributed with balanced numbers across the board as the Battlers have won three straight following a season-opening setback.

The talented first-team all-conference guard averaged 18.5 points, 4.5 assists and three rebounds, per contest last week as Alderson Broaddus toppled Virginia Union and Bowie State.

Tatum played in 71 of a possible 80 minutes on the floor and shot just under 53 percent from the field (9-for-17) and connected on five three-point baskets. He also sank 14 shots at the free-throw line last week.

In a one-point win against Bowie State, Tatum scored 13 of his 23 points at the charity stripe. He handed out for assists and grabbed as many rebounds while also recording a steal.

Earlier in the week versus Virginia Union, he was 5-of-7 from the field and 3-of-4 from long range as part of his 14 points. He also facilitated the offense with five more assists in ABU's 21-point margin of victory.

Head Coach Pat Estep

Pat Estep has been the head men's basketball coach at Cedarville University since the 2008-09 campaign. He has guided his alma mater to an average of 21 victories per season and five national tournament appearances.

The Yellow Jackets' first active season in NCAA Division II resulted in a 22-9 mark in 2012-13. Estep was voted the Great Midwest Athletic Conference Coach of the Year as his team claimed the G-MAC regular season title, the G-MAC Tournament trophy, and placed third in the NCAA Championship.

Cedarville was 23-9 during its NCAA provisional year in 2011-12. They won the school's first NCAA Championship banner in convincing fashion after entering the 2012 tournament as the No. 1 seed and winning their three games by an average of 18 points. Estep was tabbed NCAA National Coach of the Year.

Cedarville finished strong again in 2010-11 by winning eight of their last nine regular season games including the last five in a row. The Jackets were ranked as high as 14th in the NAIA Division II poll and finished at 20-13.

Cedarville won 16 of its last 18 games in 2009-10 to finish 26-9 and 14-2 in the American Midwest Conference as the league runner-up. The Yellow Jackets, who were rated as high as 8th in the national poll, later won the AMC Tournament and advanced to the second round of the national tournament.

Estep's inaugural campaign at the helm was full of memorable accomplishments. He guided the Yellow Jackets to a 27-4 overall record and a share of the AMC title with a 12-1 league mark. Cedarville was ranked as high as No. 1 in the country, finished in a tie for the No. 2 spot in the final poll, and advanced to the national tournament.

The Jackets assembled a number of school records which included a 14-game winning streak. They also wiped out all of the previous marks for defense.

Cedarville led the country in field goal percentage defense with opponents shooting just 37.9 percent. They also ranked second nationally by allowing a stingy 60 points per contest which was 10 points per game lower than the old school record.

Estep's leadership did not go unnoticed. He was voted the AMC Coach of the Year as well as the NCAA Midwest Region Coach of the Year.

Estep took on his current position after serving as an assistant coach for eight years under former head coach Ray Slagle. He played a key role during Slagle's successful tenure with the Yellow Jackets from 2000 to 2008.

Cedarville won 177 games during that time span, averaged 24.1 wins over the last seven seasons, won three American Midwest Conference titles, and two AMC Tournament championships.

The Yellow Jackets made five trips to the NAIA Division II National Tournament where they never lost in the first round. They advanced to the semifinals once, the quarterfinals twice, and to the second round twice.

This is the first head coaching position for Estep. A 1997 graduate of Cedarville College with a degree in physical education, he was a student assistant at the school during his senior year and went on to acquire coaching experience at all levels of basketball.

Estep was the 8th grade coach at Cedarville Junior High School in 1996-97. He spent the next year at Clark County Christian High School in Kentucky where he was the varsity assistant boys basketball coach and the head coach in golf and tennis.

Estep spent the 1998-99 season as the junior varsity coach at Oak Hill (Ohio) High School. He held the same position in 1999-2000 at South Webster (Ohio) High School which is where he graduated from in 1993.

Estep comes from a rich basketball coaching heritage. His father, Dale, spent 27 years in the profession at Fairfield Union and South Webster high schools.

Estep also has a master's degree in education from Cedarville University that he earned in 2008. Pat and his wife, Melanie, reside in Cedarville with their three children: sons Isaiah, 13, and Grant, 10, as well as daughter, Merynn, 4.

2014-15 Season Preview

CEDARVILLE, Ohio -

Cedarville will tip off the men's basketball season at home for the fifth consecutive year with the Don Callan Classic on Nov. 14-15.

The four-team event featuring G-MAC member Alderson Broaddus (W.Va.) along with Ashland and Ohio Dominican from the GLIAC will begin a 28-game trek for the Yellow Jackets. Seventh-year Head Coach Pat Estepp knows what he's getting his team into.

"We have assembled another challenging schedule against some of the best programs in the Midwest Region. We have four teams that were ranked in the top 25 in DII at some point last season as well as Tampa, who made the South Regional."

After that, Cedarville enters the Great Midwest Athletic Conference fray. Estepp's club won't find any easy ones in league play, either.

"I expect the G-MAC to be challenging. Kentucky Wesleyan and Alderson Broaddus have a lot of talent, and it appears some of the other programs have brought in talented players as well. We are going to have to be locked in and ready to play every night we step on the court."

Thirteen games are scheduled for the Callan Athletic Center. However, four of the last five contests on the docket are road tilts.

Jackets Succeed in Classroom



CEDARVILLE, Ohio - Cedarville University student-athletes continue to be just as impressive in the classroom as they are in the field of competition.

The Yellow Jackets remain among the best in Division II according to the recently released NCAA Academic Success Rate data.

CU tied for 12th nationally among 313 Division II schools in Federal Graduation Rate at 78 percent. The FGR computes the percentage of student-athletes, who earned their degree in the six-year window from the 2007-08 academic year through 2012-13.

The Academic Success Rate (ASR) calculates how student-athletes are making satisfactory progress toward a degree. Cedarville, at 91 percent, tied for 21st in the country in that category.

Fran Campbell, Assistant Academic Vice President for Student Success & University Registrar, proclaimed, "We are pleased to confirm that the academic success and graduation rates for our student-athletes remain very strong, and even improved in comparison with last year's commendable percentages."

"Although the graduation rate for our overall student body decreased slightly to 70% for this reporting cycle, this rate for our student-athletes increased to 78%. This is a notable comparison which reflects very positively on the quality and achievements of our student-athletes!"

According to the NCAA report, the FGR for all Division II student-athletes across the country is 55 percent, an improvement of one percent over last year, while the rate for the overall student body remained the same at 48 percent. The DII national ASR average is 71 percent.

Athletic Director Dr. Alan Geist added, "This is a great achievement. God continually blesses Cedarville University with tremendous student-athletes who take all aspects of their education seriously."

"As always, I want to say thanks to our coaching staff and to each member of our faculty, staff, and administration for all they have done to help our student-athletes be successful in the classroom."
