Tonight's Game Preview

The Cedarville Ununiversity Lady Jackets host the Hillsdale College Chargers tonight in the Callan Athletic Center. It is the home-opener of the 2011-12 schedule.

Cedarville enters the contest with a record of 1-1 after splitting two games last weekend at the Walsh Classic in North Canton, Ohio. The Lady Jackets opened the season with an impressive win last Friday over the host Cavaliers by a 76-59 final. On Saturday, the team ran out of steam dropping an 80-69 decision to Roberts Weslevan College.

Hillsdale College, NCAA II members of the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC), began their 2011-12 season at Urbana University last night. The Chargers were 17-10 last year with a 10-9 league record.

The 13-member Lady Jacket roster features 11 freshmen and sophomores with just two seniors. After just two games, CU has four players scoring in double figures. Leading the way are a pair of freshmen - Raegan Ryan and Deborah Gordon.



Ryan, a 5-5 quard, is tossing in 12 points per game and is tied for second on the team with eight assists. She is connecting at a .600 clip from the Raegan Ryan field on 9-of-15 shooting.

Gordon, a 5-11 forward, is also contributing 12 ppg and is tied with two other Lady Jackets for the team lead in rebounding with six boards per game. Gordon is hitting an impressive .588 from the field with a 10-of-17 effort.

CU's third-leading scorer, is Kayla Jenerette, last year's American Mideast Conference Freshman of the Year. Jenerette is adding 11.5 points to the attack with a team-high 13 assists and four three-point field goals.

Sophomore guard Becky Orchard is CU's fourth player hitting the double-digit mark with a 10.5 ppg tally. Orchard has 12 defensive rebounds and three assists.

Sophomore post player Danielle Spiliotis made her first collegiate start last Saturday against Roberts Wesleyan and is tied with Gordon and Orchard for the team lead in rebounding.

Deborah Chandler, a 6-0 sophomore forward, opened up the 2011-12 season with two solid outings. She is scoring 7.5 ppg with six boards and four assists.

A key for early-season success of the Lady Jackets is the recovery of 6-2 sophomore post player Lauryn Robinson who suffered a knee injury in the second half of Friday's win at Walsh.

The Hillsdale roster is a combination of talented and experienced returnees with six freshmen and four sophomores.

Chelsea Harrison, a 5-9 senior and three-year starter, tops the Charger attack. Harrison, a 2010-11 All-GLIAC South Division First Teamer, has been Hillsdale's leading scorer each of the last two campaigns.

Katie Bildner, a 6-0 senior forward, is a stellar defender and an offensive threat from inside and outside the arc.

Elizabeth Brannick is another key returner for Hillsdale. The 6-0 senior provides strength and rebounding in the low post.

The lone junior on the squad is Lea Jones who emerged last season has a leader in the GLIAC from three-point range. Jones was also one of the top peformers in the league at the free-throw

Hillsdale has won the only two previous meetings with the Lady Jackets including last season's 67-59 decision on January 18, 2011 in the Callan Athletic Center.





Cedarville made just 1-of-12 three-pointers and shot 31 percent overall in the decisive second half. The Raiders took advantage by outscoring the Jackets 44-27.







Head Coach Kirk Martin

Kirk Martin has been the head women's basketball coach at Cedarville University since the 2001-02 season and built the Lady Jackets into one of the top NAIA programs in the country. His teams have averaged 27 wins per season during his tenure.

Martin's team made its eighth and final appearance at the 2011 NAIA Division II National Tournament which featured a surprising run to the quarterfinals. CU knocked off perennial powers Saint Francis (Ind.) and Ozarks before losing to unbeaten Davenport to finish the season 24-10.



The Jackets won the school's fifth American
Mideast Conference championship in 2009-10 and finished 27-6 overall and
17-2 AMC. The Jackets were ranked No. 5 in the final NAIA Division II poll
and ultimately advanced to the second round of the national tournament.

It was the second straight NAIA appearance for the CU women. They also earned an automatic berth in 2009 by finishing second in the demanding AMC.

Martin was able to lead a young Lady Jacket squad to a strong finish and the NCCAA national title in 2008. He was named the NCCAA National Coach of the Year

Martin guided CU to five straight NAIA Division II national tournament appearances from 2003 through 2007 including back-to-back runner-up finishes in 2004 and 2005. The Jackets sport a 17-8 record at the event with a semifinals achievement in 2007, quarterfinals efforts in 2006 and 2011, and two second round showings.

Martin's club owned the American Mideast Conference titles from 2003 through 2007 assembling an 86-4 record during that timespan. CU ran off three straight undefeated league campaigns in the AMC South Division from 2003 through 2006 which included a conference-record 72-game winning streak.

Cedarville was rated No. 5 in the final 2006-07 NAIA Division II national poll en route to a 27-7 record. They held down the No. 1 position in 2005-06 which was the second straight year that the Lady Jackets accomplished the feat. They rolled to a 29-4 record overall which included a 19-game winning streak.

The Lady Jackets nearly met their ultimate goal of a national title in 2004-05 while posting a 35-2 record. Other highlights that season included an NAIA No. 1 ranking for the final six weeks of the season, a 22-game winning streak, and a second straight 18-0 run through the AMC South Division.

Martin's 2003-04 ball club produced a memorable campaign while being ranked as high as No. 2 in NAIA Division II. Among the team's many achievements were setting a school record for the most wins in a season with a 35-3 record, rolling to a perfect 18-0 league mark, and assembling a school-record 23-game winning streak.

Cedarville had a 31-3 overall record in the 2002-03 season, posted a 21-game winning streak, claimed the AMC South Division with a 17-1 mark, and won the inaugural AMC championship game. The Jackets were ranked as high as No. 3 in the country and qualified for the NAIA Division II national tournament for the first time in school history where the team advanced to the second round.

Martin took over the coaching reigns at his alma mater in 2001-02 and promptly guided Cedarville to a 23-10 record - at the time a school record for the most wins in a single season. The Jackets posted a 15-5 mark to finish 4th in the 19-team AMC. They were the only league school to beat the top three teams in the standings and all three were ranked in the NAIA Division II Top 25. Cedarville qualified for the AMC Tournament and advanced to the semifinals.

Martin came to Cedarville after developing Southeastern High School into one of Ohio's elite Division IV girls' basketball programs. He brought with him an impressive list of credentials produced at a school where he was employed since graduating from Cedarville College in 1976. He earned his master's degree in Educational Administration from the University of Dayton in 1982.

He was inducted into the Cedarville University Athletic Hall of Fame in 1998 for his coaching accomplishments.

Kirk and his wife, Vicki, reside in Springfield. The Martins have three married children: older daughter, Amy Fourman, who is a former Lady Jacket volley-ball and basketball player, resides in Enon, Ohio with her husband, Aaron, along with their two children; younger daughter, Kelly Mangin, resides in Fairborn, Ohio with her husband, Bryan, and their son; and son, Brent, is a former member of the Yellow Jacket golf and tennis teams, lives in Dayton with his wife, Rachel.

O'Brien chosen as new chair of DII Presidents Council

Nov. 2, 2011 - West Texas A&M President Pat O'Brien has been chosen as the new chair of the Division II Presidents Council.

O'Brien, a member of the Council since 2010, will succeed Molloy President Drew Bogner, who has chaired the Council for the last two years.

O'Brien assumed his position at West Texas A&M in 2006. He immediately initiated a review of the university's strategic plan and oversaw an academic realignment that, among other things, created a new College of Nursing and Health Sciences.

He came to West Texas A&M from Loyola (Louisiana), where he served as dean of the college of business administration and professor of economics beginning in 1995.

O'Brien started his career in academia as an instructor at Oklahoma State before accepting positions as an assistant professor of economics at Bowling Green State (1974-77) and then at the Alaska Fairbanks.

He remained at Alaska Fairbanks until 1991, leaving his position as professor and head of the department of economics to accept a dean's appointment with the College of Commerce and Business Administration at Jacksonville State (1991-95).

O'Brien is a member of the board of directors for the Council of Public University Presidents and Chancellors.

A native of Tennessee, O'Brien earned baccalaureate (economics) and master's (agricultural economics) degrees from Auburn in 1967 and 1969, respectively. He received his Ph.D. in economics with areas of specialization in monetary economics, public finance and regional economics from Oklahoma State in 1977.

He serves on the boards of the Northwest Texas Healthcare System, Harrington Regional Medical Center, United Way-Amarillo/Canyon, the TEXAS Heritage Foundation and the Palo Duro Reclamation Foundation.








