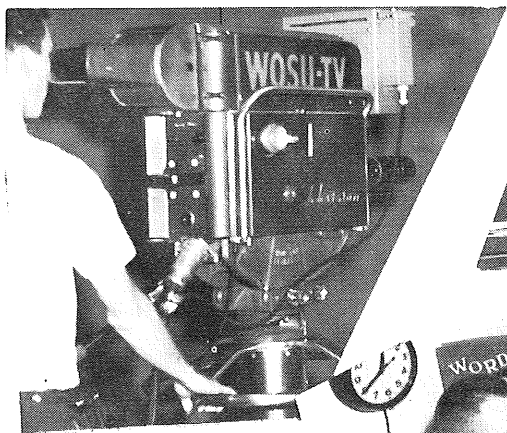

Thinking great thoughts and expressing these thoughts to others has a vital role in the education of the modern student. The Speech Department offers such an opportunity to all the students of Cedarville College. Speech experience is actually education for life.

# SCOPE

The Department offers a major and minor in the field of speech. Courses are included in the following areas: Fundamentals of Speaking, Debate, Discussion, Persuasion, Interpretative Reading, Parliamentary Procedure, Dramatics, Radio, History of Public Address, and Pulpit Speech. The Cedarville College radio station, WCDR-FM, is operated by students and provides a definite opportunity for Christian service, as well as a laboratory for practical experience and training in broadcasting. Opportunity is afforded for intercollegiate competition in Debate, Interpretative Reading, Extemporaneous Speaking, and Oratory.

# OPPORTUNITIES

The field of Speech offers many choices of career opportunities in preaching, teaching, and other diversified professions. The general background of speech training aids in preparation for careers in law, insurance merchandising, sales management, and other executive positions where the requirements of self-expression and communication are considered essential. Broadcasting executives have continually indicated a decided preference for those individuals with a broad speech and liberal arts background with some broadcast training. The rapid growth of Christian radio stations and the possibilities in the field of Christian Television present an ever expanding field of opportunity.

The courses offered meet the requirements for a teaching field in speech for secondary education, and will prepare the student for teaching public speaking, coaching debate and individual speaking events, and directing plays.

The speech training received at Cedarville will equip the superior student to do graduate work in some of the specialized areas of speech.

People with speech training will find many areas of valuable service in the local church regardless of the vocation that they follow.
