2013-14 Season Preview

It didn't matter that Cedarville graduated six seniors from last year's 20-win men's basketball team. Head Coach Pat Esteppe maintained his philosophy of facing a grueling test which is evident in the 2013-14 Yellow Jacket schedule.

"With our youth, this schedule will once again be a challenge as in years past," Esteppe proclaimed. "So, we are going to have to learn what it takes to compete at this level quickly. We have one of the best small college atmospheres in DII so we are excited to get to play 15 home games."

The Jackets have won 118 times in five seasons under Esteppe including a 22-9 mark last winter in the school's first active Division II season. The defending Great Midwest Athletic Conference champs will have their work cut out for them.

"We lost about 70 percent of our offense after graduating six seniors including the conference Player of the Year," stated Head Coach Pat Esteppe. "We have some key veterans back, but the young players will have to mature quickly."

Despite the loss of lots of talent and experience, the G-MAC coaches selected Cedarville to finish second behind perennial power Kentucky Wesleyan in the pre-season poll.

Marcus Reineke, a 6-foot-2 junior guard from New Knoxville, Ohio, is the top returning scorer at 7.9 ppg. He sports a career .447 accuracy from beyond the arc.

Brian Grant, a 6-8 senior post from Kingston, Jamaica, averaged 7.5 points and 5.4 rebounds. Jason Cuffee, a 6-4 junior guard from Poca, W.Va., who transferred in from Wright State a year ago, averaged 7.4 points.

Cedarville welcomes Grand Valley State (Nov. 30) plus makes a trip to perennial DII heavyweight West Liberty (W.Va.) on Dec. 17.

The G-MAC doubled in size from four to eight schools thus creating 14 league games. The list of newcomers includes eight-time NCAA champion Kentucky Wesleyan as well as four schools from West Virginia - Alderson Broaddus, Davis & Elkins, Ohio Valley, and Salem International.

"Our schedule is definitely challenging even without Tulane and Texas State," stated Esteppe. "We are playing some traditional powers in our region and our team will have to be ready to go from week one."

"We are really excited to be a part of the Cure UCD Classic that allows us to play two DI opponents. Those will be fun games for our players and our conference is going to be very difficult, too."
