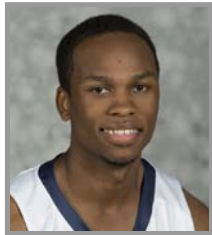

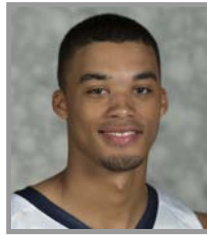

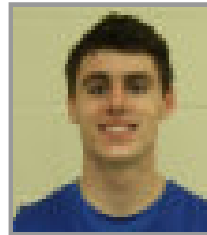

CEDARVILLE, Ohio - J.C. Faubion scored 24 points and fueled a timely run late in the second half to carry Cedarville to a 73-62 non-conference victory over Ohio Christian.

The Yellow Jackets, 1-5, trailed 56-53 with 7:20 remaining and had never held the lead.

CU then exploded for 19 unanswered points over six-plus minutes with Faubion scoring eight of them.

The NAIA Division II Trailblazers, who entered the contest at 7-1, went nearly eight minutes without a field goal coming down the stretch.

The Jackets were slow in getting out of the blocks. They trailed 15-3 before narrowing the gap to 36-30 by halftime.

Cedarville played catch up until a Justice Montgomery basket with 5:27 to go gave the hosts the lead for good, 57-56.

Faubion came off the bench with his 24 points - matching his career-high - to go along with eight rebounds. Montgomery tallied 11 points and Patrick Bain scored all 10 of his in the pivotal second half.

Numbers Game:

- Faubion also scored 24 points in his collegiate debut - a 110-107 double overtime win vs. Saint Joseph's (Ind.) on Nov. 8, 2013.
- The Jackets had not made over 50 percent of their field goals in a game yet this season (.489 vs. Findlay).
- Reep, the lone senior on the squad, scored his first five points of the season in 11 minutes of action.
- Robert Okoro has 10 blocked shots in his last four games.

Looking Ahead



Cedarville will be home for two more non-league games - Cincinnati Christian and Mount Vernon Nazarene - before heading to northeast Ohio for two games. CU hosts the Cincinnati Christian Eagles this Sat., Dec. 5 for a 6:15 p.m. contest. On Saturday, Dec. 12 the Cougars of Mount Vernon Nazarene are in town for a 7:45 p.m. encounter.

The Jackets play at Lake Erie College in Painesville, Ohio on Tuesday, Dec. 15 at 7:30 p.m. Cedarville visits Walsh University on Wednesday, Dec. 16 for 7:30 p.m. tip-off against the Cavs.

GREENWOOD, Ind. – Alderson Broaddus senior guard Malcolm Tatum was named the third Great Midwest Athletic Conference Men's Basketball Athlete of the Week for 2015-16 on Monday.

Tatum averaged 17 points and five assists per game in two contests over the Thanksgiving holiday against an undefeated Ashland program and Le Moyne.

AB participated in the Gary Miller Classic hosted by Gannon University in Erie, Pa.

Tatum was the G-MAC Player of the Year as a junior in 2014-15 while helping lead the Battlers to their second straight conference tournament title run.

He shot 7-of-14 from the field against Ashland for a team-high 20 points to go with three rebounds and two assists. Tatum also sank a three-point basket and made five of six free-throw attempts.

The Battlers had a five-point lead at halftime, but couldn't close out the Eagles in the second half in an eventual eight-point defeat.

AB got back on the winning track the next day in the consolation game against the Dolphins of Le Moyne with Tatum pouring in 14 points and dishing out seven dimes.

He also recorded a pair of steals and shot efficient from the floor against at a 6-for-13 clip.

Through four games played, Tatum is averaging 15.3 points per game and ranks second in the G-MAC in assists per contest (4.3). He's also currently third in free-throw percentage at over 83 percent made (10-for-13).

Head Coach Pat Estep

Pat Estep has been the head men's basketball coach at Cedarville University since the 2008-09 campaign. He has guided his alma mater to an average of 20 victories per season and five national tournament appearances.

The Yellow Jackets' first active season in NCAA Division II resulted in a 22-9 mark in 2012-13. Estep was voted the Great Midwest Athletic Conference Coach of the Year as his team claimed the G-MAC regular season title, the G-MAC Tournament trophy, and placed third in the NCCAA Championship.

Cedarville was 23-9 during its NCAA provisional year in 2011-12. They won the school's first NCCAA Championship banner in convincing fashion after entering the 2012 tournament as the No. 1 seed and winning their three games by an average of 18 points. Estep was tabbed NCCAA National Coach of the Year.

Cedarville finished strong again in 2010-11 by winning eight of their last nine regular season games including the last five in a row. The Jackets were ranked as high as 14th in the NAIA Division II poll and finished at 20-13.

Cedarville won 16 of its last 18 games in 2009-10 to finish 26-9 and 14-2 in the American Midwest Conference as the league runner-up. The Yellow Jackets, who were rated as high as 8th in the national poll, later won the AMC Tournament and advanced to the second round of the national tournament.

Estep's inaugural campaign at the helm was full of memorable accomplishments. He guided the Yellow Jackets to a 27-4 overall record and a share of the AMC title with a 12-1 league mark. Cedarville was ranked as high as No. 1 in the country, finished in a tie for the No. 2 spot in the final poll, and advanced to the national tournament.

The Jackets assembled a number of school records which included a 14-game winning streak. They also wiped out all of the previous marks for defense.

Cedarville led the country in field goal percentage defense with opponents shooting just 37.9 percent. They also ranked second nationally by allowing a stingy 60 points per contest which was 10 points per game lower than the old school record.

Estep's leadership did not go unnoticed. He was voted the AMC Coach of the Year as well as the NCCAA Midwest Region Coach of the Year.

Estep took on his current position after serving as an assistant coach for eight years under former head coach Ray Slagle. He played a key role during Slagle's successful tenure with the Yellow Jackets from 2000 to 2008.

Cedarville won 177 games during that time span, averaged 24.1 wins over the last seven seasons, won three American Midwest Conference titles, and two AMC Tournament championships.

The Yellow Jackets made five trips to the NAIA Division II National Tournament where they never lost in the first round. They advanced to the semifinals once, the quarterfinals twice, and to the second round twice.

This is the first head coaching position for Estep. A 1997 graduate of Cedarville College with a degree in physical education, he was a student assistant at the school during his senior year and went on to acquire coaching experience at all levels of basketball.

Estep was the 8th grade coach at Cedarville Junior High School in 1996-97. He spent the next year at Clark County Christian High School in Kentucky where he was the varsity assistant boys basketball coach and the head coach in golf and tennis.

Estep spent the 1998-99 season as the junior varsity coach at Oak Hill (Ohio) High School. He held the same position in 1999-2000 at South Webster (Ohio) High School which is where he graduated from in 1993.

Estep comes from a rich basketball coaching heritage. His father, Dale, spent 27 years in the profession at Fairfield Union and South Webster high schools.

Estep also has a master's degree in education from Cedarville University that he earned in 2008. Pat and his wife, Melanie, reside in Cedarville with their three children: sons Isaiah, 14, and Grant, 11, as well as daughter, Merynn, 5.

2015-16 Season Preview

CEDARVILLE, Ohio - The Yellow Jackets will play before the home fans 17 times during the 2015-16 men's basketball season.

Head Coach Pat Estep announced his team's 28-game slate plus two exhibitions. Once the regular season gets going, eight of the first nine assignments will be in the Callan Athletic Center.

"Having 17 home games is crucial because we have seven freshmen and a transfer," Estep explained. "We'll be trying to get everyone on the same page especially since we're so young."

Cedarville finished last winter in strong fashion to end up 13-16 overall and 9-5 G-MAC. The Jackets will again be tested from the start this year.

A four-game homestand to open the campaign includes such notables as Lewis (Ill.), Malone, Findlay, and Northwood (Mich.) in succession. Grand Valley State visits in mid-December. Also sprinkled in is a Dec. 29 exhibition at Division I Cleveland State.

"It's another challenging schedule," Estep said. "It involves a lot of teams that have been perennial powers in NCAA Division II."

Twelve (12) G-MAC games are on the docket. Now, the post-season tournament features the league's first-ever automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament for the champion.

Estep added, "The G-MAC will be rugged. It's been kind of top heavy with Alderson Broaddus and Kentucky Wesleyan in the last two years, but a number of teams have improved. Add to the fact our winner gets the automatic bid now and there will be much more on the line."

Estep begins his eighth season as head coach of the Yellow Jackets. His teams have averaged 20 wins per season.

Cedarville, Davis & Elkins Honored Again for Academic Success Rates



INDIANAPOLIS – Cedarville University and Davis & Elkins College headlined the Great Midwest Athletic Conference with Academic Success Rates of 90 percent or higher as released by the NCAA on Wednesday.

Cedarville and Davis & Elkins are among 27 NCAA Division II schools to be honored part of the Presidents' Award for Academic Excellence, now in its fifth year.

This is the third consecutive year that both Cedarville and D&E have received the Presidents' Award for Academic Excellence.

D&E had a reported ASR of 94 with UC-San Diego, Assumption and Seattle Pacific, while Cedarville's ASR of 91 tied four other schools.

For the first time, the University of the Sciences in Philadelphia led Division II with an Academic Success Rate of 99 percent, followed closely by Saint Michael's College, Point Loma Nazarene University and Bentley University, all of which achieved a 98 percent ASR.

For the second straight year, the Northeast-10 led Division II's 24 conferences in ASR rates, with five athletics programs posting scores of 90 percent or more.

The G-MAC ranked fifth among all 24 Division II conferences with ASR's of 90 percent or more.

"We are pleased by the increasing number of Division II schools whose student-athletes are earning Academic Success Rates of 90 percent or higher," said Judy Bense, president of the University of West Florida and chair of the Division II Presidents Council. "These schools and their students demonstrate the utmost dedication to success in the classroom and on the field, and we are proud of their efforts."

The Academic Success Rate is the percentage of student-athletes who graduate within six years of initial enrollment in college and includes virtually all Division II student-athletes, including transfers and those not receiving athletics scholarships.

The Division II ASR also captures about 51 percent more college athletes than the federal graduation rate. Unlike the federal graduation rate, the ASR also counts student-athletes who transfer to a school after initial enrollment elsewhere and removes from the rate student-athletes who leave school while academically eligible. The national ASR is 71 percent for student-athletes who entered college from 2005 through 2008.

Regardless of which measure is used, Division II college athletes graduate at a higher rate than the general student body. The federal rate for the 2008 entering class of student-athletes was 55 percent, compared to 49 percent for the general student body.
