* Display number 6 is comprised of a glass display case from the Richards Drug Store in downtown Cedarville. Items removed from the display case are stored in Box 10.

* Display number 15 is a drafting table on which were placed a number of items from Cedarville businesses. Items removed from this display are stored in Box 10. The origin of the drafting table is unknown.

* Display number 1 is a work bench made by Dr. Marsh, who preceded Dr. Kyle in Cedarville, and was located in his garage at the Kyle property on Main St. just south of the Cedarville Hardware building complex. The tools were donated by residents of Cedarville. The bench ended up in Dave Strobridge's garage, Harold's father, located behind the family home on Church St.

behind the table belonged to Marjorie Harbison's mother-in-law. Marjorie is Harold Strobridge's sister. The Harbisons owned the Mill at Cedar Falls on the west side of town north of Xenia Ave.

Display number 16 is a floor model radio. This radio was from the home of Charlie Jones, a boyhood friend of Harold Strobridge. Charlie lived on a farm on Grinnell road at the corner of Wilberforce-Clifton Rd. Several local Cedarville items were displayed on the top of the radio.

* The left side of display number 4 is comprised of items from the Morris Bean Company located on Xenia Ave. at the west end of Cedarville. This company made tire molds. The right side of the display represents items from the Hagar Paper Mill which occupied the Morris Bean plant site prior to the use by Morris Bean. The horseshoes were from mules which pulled wagons of wheat straw to the plant to be used in the manufacturing process.

* Display number 10 is comprised of an easel with items mounted on it. The tools were used on a farm in the production of corn. These are from the farm run by Harold Strobridge's parents which was on the east side of Route 72 just north of Cedarville. The old farm house is no longer there. There is no significance to the picture above the easel.
