## CEDARVILLE DEFENDS WBCC CHAMPIONSHIP

For the second straight year the Cedarville College women's track team won the Western Buckeye Collegiate Conference crown on Saturday afternoon at Defiance. The Lady Jackets set six meet records and four school marks in route to piling up 222 points as they coasted to victory. Defiance was second with 157 points followed by Findlay with 74, Bluffton 29, and Wilmington 2. All in all, ten new meet records were established in this third annual event.

Three Cedarville winners set meet and school records and they were Sue Vaughan in the 5000 meters (19:13.5), Cathy Watson in the 200 meters (26.4), and Cindy Collier in the 100 meter hurdles (16.6). Collier's second-place clocking in the 400 meter hurdles of 68.1 seconds was also a school record.

The Lady Jackets had six other first-place finishes and three of those were meet records including Beth McGillivray in the high jump (5'1") and Esther Mahr in the 400 meters (59.6). Jane Romig's 11:21.7 run in the 3000 meters was also a meet record even though it was almost a minute slower than her school record. She also eased to wins in the 800 and 1500 meters which marked the second year in a row that Romig had won three events. The 1600 meter relay quartet of Cheryl Rendle, Watson, Mahr, and Kris Parman won that event in 4:13.2.

Coach John McGillivray's squad will be gunning for its first National Christian College Athletic Association crown next weekend at Marion College in Indiana.
