The final Ohio rankings confirmed Cleveland State as the 1974 OCSA Champion. The Vikings garnered 168 points out of a possible 170 in the voting. Bowling Green was second with Akron third.

In tournament action, Cleveland State held St. Louis scoreless for over 85 minutes before succumbing 1-0. The Vikings then went on to defeat Southern Illinois-Edwardsville 2-1 in overtime, but lost to Howard 2-1 in four overtimes in the NCAA Division I Finals. Mt. Union, ranked fourth in Ohio, after defeating Denison in first round action of NCAA Division III action lost to MacMurray 2-1. MacMurray then took fourth place at the Nationals won by Brockport State. In NAIA action Ohio was well represented as Cedarville defeated Asbury (Ky.) 6-1 and Spring Arbor 4-0 to win the Area 4 Championship. At the NAIA National Championships Cedarville finished sixth. It lost to Erskine (S.C.) 1-0, defeated George Mason (Va.) 3-0 before being eliminated by Keene State (N.H.) 3-1. Quincy successfully defended its title, defeating Davis & Elkins 6-0 in the final game.
