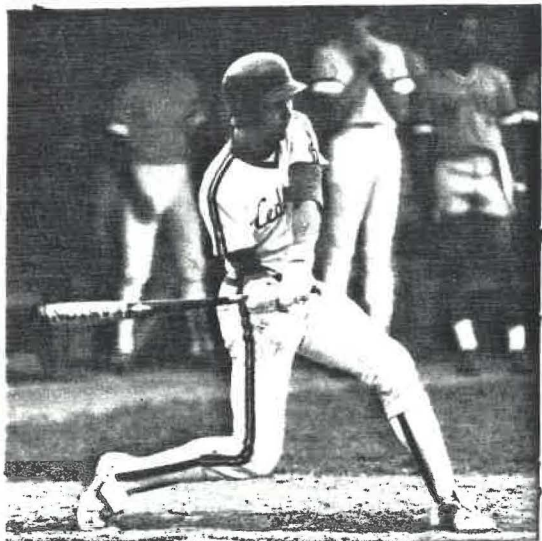

SEASON OUTLOOK



Second-year baseball coach Dan Coomes has 10 of last year's 13 players returning to the squad in 1986. Despite the small roster last spring, the Yellow Jackets managed an 18-11 season and finished as the NAIA District 22 runner-up. Expectations are just as high this year as the ball club should be stronger and contain more depth.

The main thrust during winter workouts was spent on the pitching staff. Coomes' top four hurlers are back including All-NAIA District 22 performer Tom Pratt (7-2, 3.63 ERA). Dan Erlandson (3-1, 1.80) ranked fifth in the NAIA in earned run average a year ago, while Chris Walter (6-4, 5.57) led the team in strikeouts with 51. Sam Springer pitched in eight games but was involved in only one decision with an 0-1 record.

Coomes will seek help on the mound from five newcomers. Righthanders Luis Cruz, Lamar Eifert, and Brent Speas plus lefthanders Mike Rose and Ken Horton will all be vying for pitching duties.

Cedarville's hitting and defense are expected to be greatly improved. The Jackets batted .263 as a team last year and their .954 team fielding percentage ranked them sixth nationally in the NAIA.

The Yellow Jackets should be strong up the middle defensively with captain Finny Rajchel (.303 BA, 24 RBI, 17/18 SB) and Brian Marburger sharing the catching duties. Norm Cox (.306) and All-Mid-Ohio Conference Steve Cremean (.325) will handle the shortstop and second base positions while newcomer Rusty Mock can play at either spot. Danny Olinger (.227, 17/19 SB) will again be in centerfield.

Horton is destined to be a .300-plus hitter and will roam the outfield as will Eifert who returns to the team after batting .250 with five home runs as a rookie two years ago. Brian Montross is a two-year veteran who dipped to .244 at the plate a year ago after a .316 freshman season. Springer will also get a lot of playing time in the outfield.

Erlandson (.256, 8/9 SB) and Walter (.263) will anchor first base. Rajchel and Marburger will switch off between third and working behind the plate.

"I'm counting on this team hitting close to .300," proclaimed Coomes. "We should have a good mixture of line drive and power hitters. We will also be a running team and I expect to do better than last year's stolen base performance (81/100)."

"The schedule is probably the toughest a Cedarville baseball team has ever had to face. We will have to win more than 20 games in order to return to the district tournament."

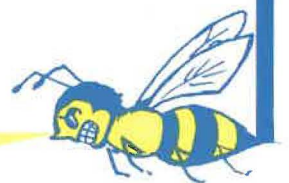
