SYNOPSIS

Rehearsing for the College Opera. Three giddy widows. Jimmie meets the girl from Dixie. A College spread, pillow fight and quadrille. "For the honor of old Cedarville!" The discipline committee make a morning call on Jimmie. The fatal frat pin. "Thus doth Marc Antony salute her snaky highness, Cleopatra of Egypt."

ACT. II—Arranging for the faculty dinner. The punch is too weak for the Major. "When one is on the faculty SOME thing must be done sub rosa." The Cedarville faculty arrive. Jimmie's Aunt Jane, a real live millionaire. "Howdy-do, Prexy; isn't this a beamish evening?" Major proposes to Aunt Jane.
