

ABOUT THE ITA



The Intercollegiate Tennis Association is beginning its 53rd year of guiding and supporting college tennis. Founded in 1956 as the National Collegiate Tennis Coaches Association, its initial purpose was to express the wishes of Division I tennis coaches to the NCAA. Since then, the organization has expanded to include

coaches representing more than 1000 collegiate tennis programs from NCAA Divisions I, II, and III, NAIA, and junior/community colleges.

In cooperation with USTA, ITA formulates rules specific to collegiate tennis. These are published yearly in the official "rule book" for tennis, *Friend At Court.* Those rules govern college play at all levels.

ITA is the "voice" of college tennis, and seeks in numerous ways to enhance the visibility of tennis on the intercollegiate sports scene. The fall regional and national singles and doubles championships are a part of that effort.

Cedarville University is represented in the ITA's operational structure by Murray Murdoch and Dee Morris. Dr. Murdoch currently serves on the Board of Directors for ITA. Dr. Morris serves on the NAIA ranking Committee and the ITA Awards Committee.


ABOUT CEDARVILLE UNIVERSITY

Cedarville University is a Christ-centered, Baptist university of arts, sciences and professional and graduate programs. The school is located on a 400-acre campus at the north edge of the village of Cedarville, Ohio, a quiet town with a population of approximately 4,000. The village and its surrounding area have long maintained a reputation for providing a wholesome environment for learning.

Though located in a rural community, Cedarville is conveniently situated in the center of a triangle formed by three interstate highways, I-70, I-75, and I-71, and thus enjoys quick access to Columbus, Dayton and Cincinnati.

Founded in 1887 by the Reformed Presbyterian Church, Cedarville College was established by individuals who had a vital interest in the spiritual welfare of young people. In 1953, the operation of the College was transferred to the trustees of Baptist Bible Institute of Cleveland with the goal of enlarging the Institute's ministry. The name Cedarville College was retained, and the school continues to perpetuate the original purpose of its founders. The school credo, "...for the Word of God and testimony of Jesus Christ," reflects this commitment. The institution became known as Cedarville University in 2000.

Since its founding, Cedarville has coupled a balanced liberal arts program with a conservative theological position in regard to doctrine and patterns of conduct. All classes are taught by dedicated Christian professors who integrate the knowledge of their respective fields with biblical perspectives.



In keeping with the liberal arts concept, the undergraduate curriculum centers on a basic program of general studies including biblical education, communications, global studies, humanities, physical education, science and mathematics, and the social sciences. Following this program, students choose a major field of concentrated study related to their abilities, interests, and career goals. Upon completion, students receive the baccalaureate degree. The University also offers graduate coursework.

The University is known nationally as a leader in campus computer networking and instructional technology, providing networked computers in each of the residence hall rooms, laboratories, and offices. One of the major advantages to the network, called CedarNet, is that students have access to over 150 commercial software packages directly from the residence hall rooms without going to a specialized laboratory.

Cedarville views individual ministry involvement as a vital and necessary part of each student's education and personal growth. The Christian ministries division provides training to the hundreds of students who volunteer each year.

Cedarville attracts students from most every state and nearly 65 percent of the student body comes from out of state, including more than 30 international students.

Residence hall living is considered an integral part of the educational process with approximately 75 percent of the student body residing on campus in University housing.
