JACKET GOLFERS THIRD IN WALSH BLOWOUT

Walsh College used a record 36-hole team score to ease to a lopsided victory in the NAIA District 22 golf tournament over the weekend in Mt. Vernon. The Cavaliers carded a 307-293 for a total of 600 that was a remarkable 28 shots better than their nearest opponent at the Apple Valley Golf Club. Defending champion Malone was second at 628 followed by Cedarville with 632, Tiffin 652, Wilmington 669, Bluffton 670, and Oefiance 718.

"We could have played out of our heads and still not have beaten Walsh," commented Cedarville coach Allen Monroe. "They have the best golf team I think our district has ever had. They blew everyone out on the second day," referring to the fact that Walsh's second 18-hole score was 19 shots lower than the rest of the field. The Cavs now head to the NAIA Nationals on May 28-31 at Grand Canyon College in Phoenix, Arizona.

Cedarville freshman Mark Reed was one of six players to make the all-district team with rounds of 78-75-153. Other Yellow Jacket scores were Tom Greve 78-78-156, Bob Fires 82-80-162, Tom Ewing 86-80-166, and Dave Kalin 81-86-167.
