The All-Mid Ohio Conference Basketball first team is composed of five seniors, three of whom played for league champion Urbana (Todd, Anderson, Plumkett). The other two first team spots went to Jim Underwood (Ohio Dominican) and Roger Bently of Rio Grande. It was announced last week that Underwood and Bently had also made the NAIA All District team.

The second team has two juniors--Jerry Townsend (Malone) and Dave Maurer (Ohio Dominican), two seniors Paul McLoughlin (Ohio Dominican) and Harry Hariston (Rio Grande) and one sophomore Al Morton of Rio Grande.

The Conference scoring champion this year was Jim Underwood of Ohio Dominican with 28.5 points per game; Jim also led in rebounding with a 14.5 per game average. Jon Plunkett (Urbana) led in field goal shooting with a 60% average. Psul McLoughlin (Ohio Dominican) led the conference in free throw shooting.

Urbana led the league in temm field goal shooting and in free throw shooting while Malone won the team rebounding title.
