## MALONE DOMINATES DISTRICT, JACKETS SECOND

Malone College surprised no one by winning the NAIA District 22 men's track meet once again on Saturday at Rio Grande. The Pioneers rolled up an impressive 309 points to easily outdistance second place Cedarville which had 136. Rio Grande was third with 68 points followed by Bluffton 28, Walsh and Wilmington 19 apiece, and Defiance with 17.

Out of the 19 events, Cedarville grabbed six first-place finishes led by double-winner Phil Hulbert. He won the shot put with a heave of 47'10½" and his throw of 158'11" in the discus was almost 20 feet farther than his nearest competitor there. Scott Hannay won the javelin with a distance of 186 feet.

Three Yellow Jackets were victors in running events including sophomore Rob Moore who breezed to a win in the 1500 meters in a time of 3:57.2. Gary Anderson captured the 800 meter dash in 1:54.5 and Tim Walters won the 110 meter high hurdles in 15.2 seconds.

The Cedarville pole vault trio of Eric Shrum, Dave Moody, and Clancy Cruise placed second, third, and fourth, respectively, with Shrum going 13'6". Senior Dee Smith was second in the 100 meter dash (11.1), Rusty King finished second in the 10,000 meter run (32:58.6), and Cedarville also placed second in both the 400 and 1600 meter relays.

Coach Elvin King will be taking several of his athletes to the NAIA Nationals on May 23-25 at Hillsdale College in Michigan. That list of individuals will be released later on in the week.
