#8 DAN COOMES Head Coach

Begins third year as Yellow Jacket baseball coach...attended Cedarville College in 1972-76 and was a four-year starter at second base...career .300-plus hitter that was All-Mid-Ohio Conference three years, All-NAIA District 22 twice, and All-NAIA Area once...Cedarville assistant coach for one year during 1977 campaign...was a member of 1984 Stan Musial World Series champion H.H. Morgan of Dayton and made the all-tournament team...hardworking coach that stresses the fundamentals...Dan and his wife Karen reside in Cedarville along with their two children: Nathan, 6, and Ashley, 3.

#17 DANNY OLINGER IF 6-0 185 Sr Fresno, Ohio

Captain of 1987 team...led '86 club in at bats (91), hits (31), total bases (40), and tied for lead in runs (22) and stolen bases (13)...switch hitter who batted .341 last year and struck out only three times in 113 plate appearances...played centerfield last year, but will be used primarily at second base...aggressive player who is quick on the basepaths...had eight multiple-hit games last spring and batted over .400 with men in scoring position...History major.
