MOORE IS ALL-AMERICAN AT CEDARVILLE

Rob Moore, a sophomore from Allendale, recently wrapped up an outstanding year as a member of the Cedarville (OH) College men's track and field team. He established himself as one of the top small college middle-distance runners in the men's ranks this season.

Rob is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Monty Moore.

Moore's latest accomplishment came at the NAIA national track meet at Hillsdale (MI) College on May 23-25. He became Cedarville's first male NAIA All-American in outdoor track with a fourth-place finish in the 1500 meter finals. Rob set a new school record with a time of 3:49.8 before a crowd of better than 8,000 people. He holds three Cedarville school marks.

"Rob had a strong showing at the NAIA," stated men's coach Elvin King. "I think he would have challenged for the victory if he had not gotten boxed in a couple of times. He was only four-tenths of a second behind the winner."

Prior to the NAIA meet, Moore won two events at the National Christian College Athletic Association meet. He broke his own NCCAA mark in winning the 1500 meters to go along with another victory in the 800. It was the second year in a row that Moore had made the NCCAA All-America squad.
