# Dr. McChesney, Educator, Succumbs

# Fire Rec

Dr. Wilbert Renwick McChesney, 72, Cedarville College professor and Greene County Republican state representative, died early today in University Hospital following an illness of several weeks.

Recently completing his 50th year at Cedarville, Dr. McChesney served as president of the college from 1915 through 1940. He was head of the departments of Greek and philosophy and dean of the seminary.

At the time of his death he was completing his fifth term as Greene County state representative and in the May primary had been nominated for a sixth term.

He was a native of Wampum, Pa., and a graduate of Greersburg Academy, Darlington, Pa.

His first wife, Martha Norton, and two children preceded him in death. In 1943 he married Mrs. Mary Turner, Harlan, Ky., who survives.

At the time of his death he was a member of the Education, Public Welfare and Taxation committees in the House.

The body has been sent to the McMillan funeral home in Cedarville pending completion of funeral arrangements.
