Season Outlook

Coach Karol Hunt inherits a team that was 9-9 a year ago and returns three out of its top five players. This year's Lady Jacket basketball team will be characterized by a strong inside offensive game coupled with a man-to-man defense. Coach Hunt says that she intends on using a controlled fast break but may opt for a more disciplined style of play when the situation calls for it.

Yellow Jacket players to watch include seniors Peg Quigley and Heidi Peterson who were both 2nd team All-WBCC selections last year. Both players are expected to carry the majority of the scoring punch as they did a year ago when they each averaged better than 13 points and 7 rebounds a game. Quigley is an excellent shooter from both the field and the line, while Peterson is an effective performer down low.

Also back on this year's squad is point guard Linda Smart who led the Jackets in assists in '82-83. These three players are joined by other returnees Lisa Campbell, Beth Goldsmith, Teri Peterson, and Jewel Schroder. Sophomore Karen Headdings tops the list of newcomers to the team along with other first-year players Sheri Norrick, Vickie Stuiber, and Angie Wilcox.

Even though she is beginning her first year at Cedarville, Coach Hunt looks at the challenge ahead with optimism. "I'm a coach that stresses teamwork and I believe that's how we'll be successful. We simply hope to be competitive in the WBCC and turn in a winning record for the season," commented Hunt.

Dr. Karol Hunt, Head Coach

Dr. Karol Hunt begins her first season as head coach of the Cedarville College women's basketball team. She joins the Lady Jacket program with coaching experience in various sports at both the high school and college levels. Hunt was the girl's athletic director from 1974-78 at the Heritage Christian School in Indianapolis, as well as the varsity coach for the girl's basketball, volleyball, track, and field hockey teams. Her cager squad at Heritage compiled a 32-12 record and they won their own invitational three years in a row.

Following her years in Indiana, Hunt returned to Pillsbury, her alma mater, as a coach and professor in 1978. For the next three years her basketball teams registered a 24-25 slate while capturing two separate tournaments. She also was the varsity coach for both volleyball and softball. Hunt has been at the University of Iowa the past two years as a teaching assistant and intern in the women's athletic department.

Dr. Hunt comes to Cedarville after earning her Ph.D. in Physical Education this past summer from Iowa. She completed her work with a major emphasis in Athletic Administration. Hunt received her Master of Arts in Physical Education in 1978 from Mankato (MN) State University, following the Bachelor of Science degree she earned from Pillsbury (MN) Baptist Bible College in 1974.

Highlights on Top Players

PEG QUIGLEY - 32

5'9" Senior Wing Tecumseh, MI

Led team last season in scoring with a 13.7 average and in free throw percentage at 77.1 percent...Field goal percentage of 52.4 and rebounds per game mark of 7.1 ranked second on the squad...Named 2nd team All-WBCC. "Peg may be our best all-around player. She's intense, strong defensively, a good rebounder, and one of our best shooters. I expect her to be a team leader," commented Coach Hunt.

HEIDI PETERSON - 30

5'11 Senior Post Lehigh, IA *Captain

Pulled down a team-leading 162 rebounds last year for a 9.0 per game average... Scored at a 13.4 per game clip on 50.7 percent shooting from the field...Named 2nd team All-WBCC. Coach Hunt stated, "Heidi is our most aggressive player and probably our top defensive performer as well. She uses her size well and that allows her to be a strong inside player."

LINDA SMART - 5

5'4" Senior Guard New Carlisle, OH

Started last year and led the squad with 60 assists...Ranked fifth on the team in scoring with 133 points for a 7.4 average. "Linda is one of our best players and is the quickest on the team. We expect her to take point guard responsibilities and run the offense," says Coach Hunt.

LISA CAMPBELL - 34

6'0" Sophomore Post Port Charlotte, FL

Led '82-83 team in field goal percentage on 39 of 64 shooting for 60.9 percent. "Lisa shows a lot of potential and she will improve with experience. She will be a key to our inside attack," mentioned Coach Hunt.

KAREN HEADDINGS - 14

5'8" Sophomore Wing Halifax, PA

Transfer from Washington Bible College and is top newcomer on the team despite having no collegiate experience. "We expect Karen to make a big contribution this year," commented Coach Hunt. "She's our most intense player and is a solid shooter with good control. She'll be a swing player for us."
