Dear Friends:



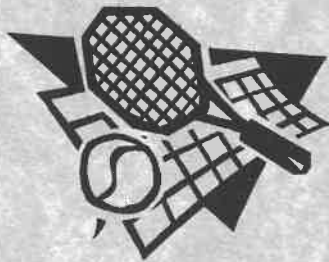
