JULIE SWIFT EARNS SPOT ON VOLVO TENNIS/SCHOLAR ATHLETE TEAM

PRINCETON, N.J. -- JULIE SWIFT, a resident of Worthington, Ohio., earned a spot on the 1991 Volvo Tennis/Scholar Athlete Team, which was selected and announced today by the Intercollegiate Tennis Coaches Association (ITCA).

Swift, who just completed her senior year at Cedarville, met the selection requirements of 1) being a varsity letter winner and 2), having a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.5 on a 4.0 scale. Only juniors and seniors are eligible.

A Mathematics/English major, Swift has a 3.62 grade point average and is one of 27 NAIA women on the team.

Swift is a two-time selection to the Volvo Tennis/Scholar Athlete Team

Highlighting the Volvo Tennis/Scholar Athlete Team for Division I players are seniors Sandra Birch of Stanford and Al Parker of Georgia. Birch won the 1989 and 1991 NCAA Singles titles, while Parker won two ITCA Collegiate Grand Slam titles and was a four-time All-America. Both were also named the GTE Academic All-Americans of the Year for at-large sports, as selected by the College Sports Information Directors (CoSIDA).
