Rich Otte of Defiance heads the second team. The burly forward returned to the lineup after a year's absence and averaged 15.7 points and 11.4 rebounds. He's a junior.

Bluffton's Bill Elsass was ranked eighth in MOC scoring last week and he has a 16.5 average from his guard position. A junior, he also has ranked among the field goal and free throw shooters all season.

Gary Holbrook, Cedarville's junior forward, is another second team choice. He has averaged about 20 points and 14 rebounds per tilt all season for the Yellowjackets.

Stan Kiehl, Wilmington guard, and Don Atherton, Cedarville center, round out the second five. Kiehl, a senior, has averaged 17 points and led the loop in field goal accuracy all season. Atherton, 6-9 junior, was leading the MOC in rebounding with a 14.4 mark at the last report.
