PAM JOHNSON TO BE INDUCTED INTO NAIA HALL OF FAME

CEDARVILLE, Ohio - Cedarville University women's tennis coach Dr. Pam Johnson will be inducted into the NAIA Hall of Fame on Sunday in Mobile, Ala. She will be honored during festivities at the annual Banquet of Champions prior to the national tournament.

Johnson is recognized as one of the foremost authorities in NAIA women's tennis. Besides serving as head coach of the Lady Jackets for the past 28 years, she has been a member of the NAIA National Tournament Committee since 1985 and, since 1989, has held the position of National Tournament Director.

Johnson has guided the Cedarville women's tennis program to a record of 249-114 for a .686 winning percentage. Her teams own four NAIA Region IX championships, seven NAIA District 22 championships, and seven conference crowns. She has taken 12 teams to the NAIA National Tournament and has coached 24 NAIA All-America Scholar-Athletes.

This year's Lady Jacket squad will be there as Region IX champions. Cedarville, 17-3 and ranked No. 21, will face No. 13 Shorter (Ga.) in the opening round of the 24-team event on Monday at 9:00 a.m. at the Mobile Tennis Center.
