Enclosed are the procedures for reporting records, scores, statistics and player of the week nominations for the Mid-Ohio Conference.

Each Sunday, beginning March 26, and concluding May 🚚, each MOC baseball coach. SID or statistican should call Jeff Schwartz at (614) 397-1033, between the hours of 7 and 9 p.m. following the scheduled listed below:

7:00-7:15	Tiffin	8:00-8:15	Rio Grande
7:15-7:30	Ohio Dominican	8:15-8:30	Malone
7:30-7:45	Urbana	8:30-8:45	Cedarville
7:45-8:00	Walsh	8:45-9:00	Mt Vernon Naz

I know games are scheduled on Sunday, but each coach should designate someone to call-in during the time assigned. If there is a conflict, please make arrangements prior to Sunday -- I call Mark Womack, NAIA District 22 Information Director later on Sunday night to report the conference statistics.

Report your overall record, conference record, scores, schedule for the next week-and-a-half, and statistics. The statistics will follow the same format the NAIA National Office uses. Forms are enclosed. Please run off more copies to make sure you have enough to last an entire season.

The player of the week -- recognizing a pitcher and a position player -- will begin immediately. Please have all pertinent statistics from the entire week for your nomination, not just from a selected few games, to help in the selection process.

Several reminders: 1.) games against all four-year colleges and universities count in your statistics, while those against two-year institutions DO NOT; 2. players must play in 75% of their teams games or they will not be included, and 3.) the earned run average is figured by nine-innings.

Send a roster, schedule and program or media guide as soon as possible.
