CEDARVILLE, OHIO -- The Intercollegiate Tennis Coaches Association (ITCA) has accepted six Cedarville College tennis players into the Rolex Regional Small College Championships. The tournament will be played on Friday and Saturday at Southern Illinois University at Edwardsville. The field will consist of players from NCAA Division II, III, and NAIA schools plus junior colleges. It is a singles tournament only and no team scores are kept. The midwest regional is one of eight around the country and the winners will play in the national event on Dec. 7-9 in Ft. Myers, Fla.

"This is a well-respected tournament that will feature some excellent players," stated Cedarville Coach Murray Murdoch. "We've have only had two players that have ever played in it before and I'm really excited that the whole team was accepted. We have been looking forward to this for some time."

Murdoch's team is 3-0 this fall while using an entire freshmen line-up and it is those six rookies that will be making the trip to SIU-Edwardsville. They are Jeff Kohl (Manitowoc, Wis.); Dino Tisbouris (Gahanna, Oh.); Bruce Taranger (Saskatoon, Sask.); Steve Lesko (Perkasie, Pa.); Steve Brumbaugh (West Milton, Oh.); and Scott Poling (Marmora, N.J.). The seedings and draw will be announced on Thursday evening.
