As a graduate of Cedarville University (or perhaps it was Cedarville College at the time), would you be interested in helping raise the national awareness of your alma mater? Each year *U.S. News & World Report* publishes rankings for all colleges and universities in the United States. According to its website, "Choosing a college or university to attend is a major life decision, but it's not one that you have to make alone. *U.S. News & World Report's* Best Colleges rankings can take some of the stress out of the school research and selection process and help students find a college that's a good fit."

The *U.S. News & World Report's* rankings are based on several criteria, including graduation and retention rates (22.5%), undergraduate academic reputation (22.5%), faculty resources (20%), student selectivity (12.5%), financial resources (10%), graduation rate performance (7.5%), and alumni giving rate (5%). 


